"CRTC responding to failure" - Znaimer

In light of the recent CRTC decision that would allow cable "speciality" channels to apply to have their services carried on basic cable, MuchMusic's Moses Znaimer says, "While at first blush it is good for MuchMusic, it is not that good for the system overall, and therefore ultimately not that good for MuchMusic - certainly not that good for CITY-TV and, in my opinion, it's downright dangerous for CTV and CBC, and I think it's lethal for First Choice/Superchannel."


Znaimer goes on to point out that the station may be applying for the basic route, "but it's not a preferred route." MuchMusic has informed the CRTC what their position is, concerning the decision and that, "we will go that way if the regulator insists."

Black Music Association holds talent finals

Norman Richmond of the Black Music Association (BMA), reports the finals of their First Annual Talent Search, will be held at Toronto's Horseshoe (Sept. 11) at 9 pm. Sandra Whiting and MuchMusic's J.D. Roberts will emcee the show which will also feature the performance of Changing Faces.

The winner of the Toronto competition will be flown to Miami, compliments of Eastern Airlines to perform at the BMA 1986 Convention, to be held at the Fontainbleau Hilton (Oct. 1 through 5). Besides Toronto, winners of local talent searches represent New York, Philadelphia, Washington, Memphis, Cleveland, Los Angeles, and Miami. The winner of the Grand Finals will receive a contract with RCA Records, and an oncamera television appearance in a major commercial.

Judges for the Toronto run-off are CFTR's Music Director Bob Saint; Jim Fotheringham, Director of A&R for RCA; Mello Music's Michael Lym; Diane Liverpool, Secretary of the BMA; Milton Blake, co-founder of the Toronto Chapter of BMA; and Norman Richmond, President of BMA's Toronto Chapter.



Don Kollar, Vice President & General Manager RCA Records Canada with Whitney Houston and her impressive collection of 7-times platinum (700,000 units sold) awards for her self-titled Arista LP, presented prior to her CNE "sold out" show in Toronto. The album has now closed in on the 800,000 mark, and expectations are that the album will reach the 1 million mark by Christmas.

He also suggests that the CRTC is being driven by the difficulties some of the "other" speciality services are encountering and points out "it's hard to argue whether the benefits the so-called Life Channel can bring to the country would outweigh the damage that might be sustained by the national broadcaster," if the applications are granted.

"One of the reasons they (CRTC) put us on discretionary in the first place," continues Znamier "was quite deliberate . . . it was to protect the rest of the system. Now, instead of penetrating 25 percent, you're penetrating 100 percent and," he concludes, "you've got to do damage. It's the classic Canadian thing: do you reward success or do you reward failure? The CRTC is once again responding to failure."

New single and tour for Anne Murray

Anne Murray is currently in the midst of her Now And Forever tour, where she will play one-niters over the next 3 months. Included in the 30-city tour are Cincinnati's Riverbend Music Theatre, the Irvine Meadows Amphitheatre in Southern California, and 2 soldout concerts at Expo's 4000 seat Amphitheatre (Sept. 27 & 28).

The tour kicked off in Birmingham, Alabama (Aug. 20), and will wind down with 2 dates (Oct. 25 & 26) at The Fox Theatre in St. Louis.

Murray is currently on release with her Capitol single, My Life's A Dance, which was produced by Jack White, and is included on her Something To Talk About album. U.S. country and A/C programmers have been quick to pick up on this single, which is the follow-up to Who's Leaving Who, which was also produced by White. The first single taken from this album was the David Foster production of You And Me (Now And Forever).

RCA pacts licensing deal with Jive Records

Cathy Hahn, who recently returned to RCA in the capacity of Manager of Press & Publicity, reports the pacting of a licensing deal between RCA/Ariola and Jive Records. The deal involves North America, Latin America, France and Spain.

In view of the interim arrangement struck between Jive and CBS Records Canada, the latter will retain distribution rights to 4 catalogue items, including recent titles from Billy Ocean, Whodini, Johnathan Butler, and Flock Of Seagulls, until July of 1987.

Therefore, under the new agreement, RCA/Ariola becomes the new distributor for Jive effective immediately. Heading up the Canadian operation for Jive is ex-Quality label manager Larry Macrae.

The agreement was jointly announced by RCA/Ariola President Elliot Goldman and Jive Executive Clive Calder. Initial releases from Tangerine Dream, Samantha Fox. Ruby Turner, Precious Wilson, and Millie Jackson are expected.

Music marketing included in West Coast Ad meet

Sponsorship Strategies: The Essentials of Evaluating Corporate Sponsorship will be the theme for the 3-day West Coast Advertising Conference, to be held in Vancouver's Robson Square Media Centre (Sept. 17, 18 & 19). Of particular interest to the record industry will be the 3rd day (19) when, from 9 am to 10:30 am, a panel of experts in the field will discuss Hitting The Right Note: Marketing With Music.

Presentations will be made by Bruce Allen, President of Bruce Allen Talent; Don Shafer, Program Director of CFMI-FM; Don Antle, Manager, Promotion Sports and Entertainment Properties, Molson Breweries; Gary Kawaguchi, Product Manager, Pepsi Brand; and Paul Mercs, Producer, Special Attractions, Expo '86.

Music has been effectively used by breweries and soft drink companies over the last couple of years - in communicating their message to the all-important 18 to 49 age group. They have also sponsored tours by Cancon rock and pop groups - and in many cases - brought top name acts to medium and small markets that wouldn't ordinarly have been included on the tour schedule

The conference will cover the wide spectrum of advertising with heavy emphasis on sponsorship from TV commercials, the Calgary Winter Olympics, Motor Sport, Expo '86, Fundraising, and professional and amateur sports.

CIRPA General Meeting set for Sept. 10

A General Meeting of the Canadian Independent Record Production Association (CIR-PA) will be held at Toronto's Club Bluenote (128 Pears Ave) on Wednesday, Sept. 10th at 5 pm.

On completion of the meeting there will be an A&R panel discussion with Bernie Finkelstein of True North Records, acting as moderator.

The panel will comprise, Brian Allen (Attic Records), John Alexander (MCA), David Bendeth (CBS Music Products), Adrian Heaps (Duke Street Records), Merck Mercuriadis (Virgin Records), Bob Roper (WEA Music Canada), Tim Trombley (Capitol Records-EMI), and Gerry Young (Current Records).

Here's to the sudster who lost!



Iron Maiden - "We made it without radio . . ."

Iron Maiden's follow-up to last year's Live After Death album is titled Somewhere In Time, and once again, the band have taken off on a world tour. This tour is expected to rival their previous World Slavery tour, which saw them play over 300 concerts in 28 countries.

Currently touring several Eastern bloc countries, Maiden are expected to begin the North American leg in January. The band will be utilizing their own custom built sound system and at 173,000 watts, is touted as the biggest in the world.

The Somewhere In Time album was again produced by Martin Birch and recorded at the Compass Point Studios in Nassau, and Wisseloor Studios in Amsterdam. Certainly, the band hasn't "commercialized" their sound any - and realistically - realises they won't be getting radio assistance, again.







tions will then come crawling . . . asking, 'please, can we have the show?' Actually, we're thinking of giving it to the college stations, . . "

Dickinson explains why Iron Maiden doesn't need radio. "Heavy metal's got this very large cult base, and every few years, it goes through an expansion in public consciousness - and after they've run out of their Madonna's, they say 'let's re-invent heavy metal', and I think we're due for one of those now.

"I think what's going to happen in the next year is that the forthcoming months are going to toughen up because I think kids are really bored with today's radio. I get the impression from talking to them, that they're fed up with listening to all oldies or really soft tracks. They want radio to get back to rock 'n' roll - they're not really interested in buying that 'new muffler' or barbeques or whatever the advertisers are trying to sell. I mean, radio has become orientated around selling advertising rather than selling music and that's actually a sad state of affairs. I wish they'd come clean and not pretend that they're interested in music."

Dickinson goes on to point out "There's a station in Los Angeles (KNAC) that has just started an all heavy metal format - 24 hours a day - and it's doubled its Arbritron ratings. Can you imagine . . . doubled," he emphasizes.

"Sure, they're getting the 15 to 25 age group," he continues, "and probably a lot more males than females. But, even so, they're the people who essentially keep the music alive in the cities . . . because the opposites sit in their 'yuppie' factories, with their BMW's and their stereo TVs."

Continuing, Dickinson punches home his point, "You have to keep music alive, and in order to keep it alive, you've got to have concerts and personal contact," concluding with "That's why radio stations are so desperate to get the credibility of live concerts - because that's the only credibility they've got left - to claim to be in touch with the people."
