#### People-inspired song rushed for Canada Day

Kristine King, Promotion and Publicity for Warner/Chappell Music Canada, tells the story that "When songwriters Wain Routledge and Anthony Vanderburgh found themselves frustrated, watching as their country went through one of the most painful periods in its history... they were moved to write about it." The French/English language rush release of Let It Show (It's Canadian All The Way) and C'est a toi, is the result.

King goes on to point out that the two Toronto-based writers were deterined not to make this "a shallow production . . . they cut an emotional rock 'n' roll street-hip track," which features the vocals of Brooke Palmer, a Toronto singer in his twenties.

Routledge and Vanderburgh then brought Franco-Ontarions Roger St-Denis and Richard Fleury into the picture to adapt the song for French speaking Canadians, "instead of attempting to merge the two languages and cultures into one track," informs King. St-Denis conveys the vocal message on the French-language track.

It took only two weeks, "a frantic two weeks," says King, for the songs to be written, cut, mixed and mastered and finally manufactured and rush-released to the media in time for Canada Day. Both tracks were recorded at the Routledge/Vanderburgh-

# South Fraser gets nod for Vancouver licence

The CRTC has announced the approval of the application by South Fraser Broadcasting Limited for a licence in Vancouver on frequency 94.5 MHz.

The Commission was apparently impressed by South Fraser's proposal of an "alternative Dance and Rhythm & Blues musical format and imaginative spoken word programming," which was designed to appeal "most strongly to an audience of those under the age of 35."

This age group was identified by the Commission, and by four of the six applicants, as being "targeted by fewer local radio services than the group 35 and older." Specifically, South Fraser identified its primary audience as those "between the ages of 18 and 34, with females comprising the majority."

Besides its commitment to broadcast "a minimum of 30 percent Canadian content" in the Category 5 musical selections, the broadcast group indicated it would supply funding for the development of Canadian talent "by direct expenditures of \$315,000 in each of the station's first five years of operation." These will include an "annual contribution of \$150,000 to a Young Artists and Audience Fund," which will be used to "encourage young artists and introduce young audiences to Canadian talent." The fund will be administered by the Vancouver Cultural Alliance.

Those who unsuccessfully made a bid for the Vancouver frequency were Robert Keith Whyte, Jeffrey M. Weltman, Rawlco Communications Limited, Redmond Communications Calgary, Ltd., and Seacoast Communications Inc. owned Kensington Sound studio and mixed at Number Studios in Toronto. Gary Fishman and Vezi Tayyeb are given engineer credits with Kathy Birkett taking mastering engineer credit. Backup vocals were supplied by Maddie Willis and Kent Sheridan, currently charting with Forever Tonight on the RPM A/C chart.

The cassette/CD single, was released to radio on June 27 on the Warner/Chappel label.

#### CRIA and police seize 'bootleg' goods

A number of investigations by CRIA's Anti-Piracy office, working with the Metro Toronto Police Department and the RCMP, have led to the seizure of thousands of sound recordings and video cassettes.

In Mid-June, Metro Police nabbed hundreds of video tapes containing live concert footage of several name artists including Jeff Healey, Rush, Pink Floyd, Rod Stewart and Madonna. In a news release, CRIA stated that a Scarborough, Ontario man was charged with fraud. At about the same time, two owners of a downtown Toronto record store were arrested by police and charged with 14 various offenses. The CRIA release says "seized in the raid were hundreds of alleged bootleg, counterfeit and pirated cassettes, albums and compact discs."

In May, CRIA worked with the RCMP in the seizure of 1,100 audio and video cassettes at a retail store in Montreal. Charges have been laid in this case where the booty seized reportedly carried an estimated street value of \$50,000.

# BMG's Sheree hits big with Japan promotion

BMG Canada reports that Sheree's recent promotional tour of Japan, which wound down at the end of May, was "an overwhelming success".

Sheree was reportedly "enthusiastically received" at two showcases in Tokyo and Osaka. She appeared on a Fuji TV entertainment program which boasts an audience of ten million, and received coverage in more than 20 newspapers and 100 magazines. The single, Women's Work, from her debut album, has received extensive airplay on Japanese AM and FM radio.

Sheree returns to Japan in July for another promotional tour and to participate in writing the score for the Japanese version of the film Top Gun, in which she will also perform an original song. A two-week Japanese tour has been scheduled for September.

Sheree's album is also scheduled for release in 16 other international territories, including the U.K., France, Germany, Hong Kong, Australia and Malaysia.

She is currently bulleting up the RPM 100 Singles chart with Bang On, the latest single taken from her debut album.

#### MIDEM makes moves to stamp out piracy

MIDEM, the International Record, Music Publishing and Video Music Market, has introduced new clauses to its participation contract in an attempt to fight music piracy.

Effective from the next MIDEM, to be held in Cannes, France from January 20 to 24, 1991, participants will be required, as part of their agreement, to refrain from engaging in acts of counterfeiting or piracy. Infringement of the agreement will result in the offender being expelled from MIDEM and not re-admitted for at least two years.

MIDEM's chief executive, Xavier Roy, called the move "an important breakthrough in the struggle against piracy."

#### Diemer to Capitol's National Promotion post

Peter Diemer has been appointed Director of National Promotion for Capitol Records - EMI of Canada. His appointment became effective June 25/90.

Diemer joins Capitol from MCA where he held a similar position. He joined MCA in 1983 as B.C. marketing representative until 1985 when he moved east as Ontario marketing representative, a position he held from 1985 to 1988 when he assumed his post as Director National Promotion. He became involved in the music industry in 1979 when he joined CJAY-FM Calgary as an on-air announcer, moving to Music Director in 1981.

# Cohen to be inducted into Juno Hall of Fame

Leonard Cohen will be inducted into the Juno Hall of Fame during this year's awards presentation which will be televised live from the Queen Elizabeth Theatre in Vancouver by the CBC-TV Network (Mar. 3/91).

Cohen is a well known singer and songwriter who was born in Montreal in 1934. Over his career he has released ten albums, selling more than five million outside of the U.S. He is very popular in Europe and is honoured annually at the Leonard Cohen Festival in Krakow, Poland.

Cohen is currently working on his 11th album in Montreal to be released by CBS this fall.

This just in ... ! Hold the fort. Forget my bitching about Canadian recording artists sitting on their talent and getting fatter and fatter. Well, I shouldn't go that far. Anyway, thanks to Warner/Chappell . . . an American-owned company, I might add, something has been done . . . in fact it might even be a little revolutionary in scope, if you listen to the lyrics very closely. Two Toronto songwriters. Wain Routledge and Anthony Vanderbugh, harnessed the songwriting talents of two Franco-Ontarions, Roger St-Denis and Richard Fleury, to write the French lyrics to Let It Show (It's Canadian All The Way) which came out as C'est a toi. (EC: What about the fat and fatter artists?)

Man... what a promotion! How much do you think that Diet Pepsi Taste Train promotion cost? Well, for obvious reasons, the Pepsi people aren't saying, but the promotional value that came with it far outdistanced any outlay they might have made, for the rolling stock, the talent, which I'm sure they paid for ... and whatever else was necessary to get the train from

The exposure on MuchMusic alone was a bit of a triumph for Pepsi's ad agency. (EC: It's not the taste that sells . . . it's the price. So much for loyal brand fans . . . !)

A new eatery for Brian . . . ! When I mentioned a few weeks ago that Fenton's had closed, and that it was Brian Robertson's favourite lunch haunt, Joanne Smale suggested that I mention The Senator's new dining room to him. As it turned out, Brian was away ahead of both of us. In fact, he invited me to sample the service and the food at the new Sniderman food spa. When we arrived . . . and Brian had made reservations. we were informed the dining room wasn't open on Mondays, so we had to go next door to the restaurant, which is not too conducive to a jawing with "the most quoted man in Canada's music industry", fawh, fawh, fawh fawh . . . and all that Brit stuff. Anyway, rancourous is either spelled with two Us or one which ever is proper. I always felt that Brian took negotiating like a gentleman until I read otherwise elsewhere, (EC: Consider the source! Consider the source! Canada's Music Business Soar Ass!!) Don't be a Dickhead, Ellie!!)

**Short and sweet** ... ! "I am pleased to announce that I have been appointed the President of the Retail Music Association of Canada." (signed) Leonard Kennedy. Now that's getting right to the point. No fluff, no hype, just the straight facts ... right Leonard? He doesn't have to go into detail about how he is probably the most successful, operator in the record servicing field ... he likes to keep a low profile. But I think they should take "retail" out of the name of the organization, unless Leonard's going to open a chain of stores. (EC: Could be ... !)

**Politics in high places ...?** That much fought over battle for the last remaining FM frequency in Toronto is soon to be history. I hear the name of the successful bidder could be announced within the next two weeks. I also hear there was a lot of backroom lobbying going on after the hearings. (EC: How about a public poll of the Commissioners ...?)

Great talent at Ontario Place ... ! My visits to Ontario Place are usually just to catch the odd act at the Forum, but I've really been missing the boat. After the Barry White concert, I ducked into Jamz for a quick beer and what a rockin' joint this is, but I didn't see any A&R people, so I knew there must be talent here somewhere . . . and sure enough out came Joanie Wilson, one of the stars of the Deerhurst million dollar revue, to do a guest set. In fact she did two sets and I stayed for both. What a talent, and in hot pants yet, which drove the crowd crazy. Backing her was an incredibly tight group of seasoned musicians: guitarists Christian Bechard and Joe Mavety, Joe Reynolds on Trumpet, bassist Joe Agnello, keyboardist Michael Fonfara, saxman Steve Dudek, drummer Jim Casson and vocalist Chuck Jackson. They guest a lot of bright new talent and because of the aggressive nature of the band, these acts come off as polished professionals. (EC: Take an A&R person to Jamz for a beer . . . !)

**Canada Day, Up Canada Way!** Says Stompin' Tom, "Let Canada join Quebec and we'll all separate together." There couldn't be a better way, musically, to celebrate Canada Day then to program Stompin' Tom's Canada Day, Up Canada Way. Capitol rushed out a CD copy of the record, and I have it from very good authority that this could be the record of the day ... right across Canada. (EC: Even in Ouebec ...?)

Keeping the country together ...! I heard there was a move underway to harness the talents of some of Canada's top name, and some lesser name recording artists to produce a Save The Nation ala Tears Are Not Enough record. I know Bruce Allen is ready to go, but this one will be tough. Nobody's starving in this country ... recording stars are getting fat and fatter ... and does anyone really care? What a great opportunity to put our music and our talent front and centre for a REAL cause. Of course the country isn't going to break up ... but wouldn't it be nice to re-affirm our belief in this country? (*EC: The silence is deafening ...!*)

Welcome back Bobby . . . ! Highly respected restauranteur Mr. Robert Sniderman, I guess we can call him Bob . . . but never Bobby again, has returned to the business . . . well, sort of. He built a snazzy dining room next to his Senator restaurant/deli in downtown Toronto and topped it with a jazz club called Top O' The Senator . . . quite clever! I'm not much into jazz, but the opener for the club, 60-year old blues/jazz belter Betty Carter stopped me dead. The range and the dynamics of this lady's voice is pure entertainment . . . and her improvisation technique with the trio, kept me on the edge of my seat. After hearing her version of Alan Jay Lerner's little known Why Him and beautiful standards by Cole Porter, Betty had the room of first-niters in the palm of her hand. She recorded an album with Ray Charles a few years ago for ABC Dunhill, and I understand it is still available. By the way, the ambience and decor of the Senator lends itself to the type of act on stage . . . class, all the way, a note of respect for the music genre. I thought there might have been a tie-in with a jazz label for the opener . . . but Mr. Sniderman has obviously noticed a change in the business! (EC: There aren't too many jazz buffs in the industry these days!)



#### Reggae Sunsplash to shine in Canada - June 29/30


Reggae Sunsplash, the world's largest reggae event, rolls into Canada for two shows in Toronto and Montreal June 29 and 30.

Every year since 1978 the Reggae Sunsplash festival has presented the cream of international reggae at the Bob Marley Memorial Performing Arts Centre in Montego Bay, Jamaica. And each year since 1986, a number of performers have taken Sunsplash on the road across North America and Europe before heading to Jamaica for the festival, this year to be held from July 16 to 22.

This year's touring lineup includes reggae veterans Burning Spear and Marcia Griffiths, rising star Freddie McGregor and young artists such as Shinehead and Shelly Thunder who fuse reggae and hip hop styles.

Nick Cumberbatch of Winnipeg's Roots Productions, which with Toronto-based Ideal Promotions is promoting the Toronto show, a 41/2-hour extravaganza, says that the inclusion of the newer acts reflects the crossover between reggae and rap, "Music in general, and reggae music in particular, is always evolving and changing. Rap music is a reflection of street music in America and it's a very popular type of music ... When you look at the history of reggae music and music coming out of Jamaica and the islands, I remember listening to rap music in a certain form. dance hall music, as far back as 20 years ago, before rap as such came out of the black American experience. So one could say it's all an expression of people and street life. I think the crossover will always be there because we're basically talking about people and their. experiences."

This year's Sunsplash tour comes as reggae is enjoying a level of popularity in North America unprecedented since the death of reggae's first international superstar, Bob Marley, in 1981. Rising sales figures for reggae records and broadened interest in events such as Sunsplash, as well as reggae in-



fluences in the music of such international rock stars as Sting, Tina Turner and Tracy Chapman, seem to indicate that reggae is reaching a new audience in North America.

"People always said reggae music had peaked with Bob Marley," says Cumberbatch. "And with the absence of Bob Marley from the scene there isn't that focal point of attention for reggae music. [But] if you look at the audiences now you have people who were introduced to reggae music by the Bob Marley experience, and you also have music fans who were exposed to reggae which has crossed over into rock music."

Cumberbatch is quick to point out that while reggae has been widely influential for rock performers, mainstream radio still has a long way to go in recognizing reggae music's viability. "A lot of the established radio stations seem to resist including reggae in their playlists. They would probably play Eric Clapton's I Shot The Sheriff without thinking, but if it was coming from a reggae artist they might not want to play it...It's time the radio stations liberate themselves from pigeonhole labels and from assuming they know what the listeners want."

# Canada Day at CIGV-FM features 24 hours Cancon

Carl W. Harris, Music Director of CIGV Penticton, B.C. is gearing up for the station's annual Canadian Showcase, an event where the FM station features 24 hours of Canadian country on Canada's birthday, July 1st.

Canadian Showcase '90 however, will be somewhat different this year. "We will be presenting a Portrait of the '80s," says Harris, "That is, recordings released between ouir going on the air, October 19, 1981 and December 31, 1989." He goes on to point out that the music "will not be selected as a best of, because I intend to include releases of a local, regional and national nature that did not make a chart. Songs will be picked that give a cross section of the events, feelings and messages of the time . . . and the announcers will be able to give the month and year after each song."

Harris explains that for this year only, he is looking for "new material of a special nature which RPM has always helped me to obtain in the past." He concludes with "Instead, it will be a retrospect that should be entertaining, interesting and, above all, typically CIGV Radio.

# Moore and 54-40 band make news at Gangland

Among the spate of activity at Vancouver's Gangland Artists recently was the signing of Mae Moore to its artist roster. Moore is scheduled to begin touring this fall in support of her debut CBS album which was produced by Colin Nairne and Barney Bentall. The album is scheduled for a July release.

Gangland has also announced the winding down of Vancouver band 54-40's Fight For Love Tour. The group will wrap things up at the Stein Valley Festival (Aug. 5), before heading back to the studio to begin working on their next album.

# CHUM stations capture six international awards

1050 CHUM and 104.5 CHUM-FM have combined to win half-a-dozen medals at the International Radio Festival Of New York. The winners were selected from among 5,000 entries representing 42 countries, and the awards handed out June 13th in New York City.

The Toronto sister stations garnered two gold, three silver and one bronze award. One of the golds went to 1050 CHUM's Brian Henderson, for Best Editorial Comment Concerning A Local Issue. Henderson recently won a Canadian Radio Award for Best Opinion/Commentary Broadcaster.

# Myles topping charts around the world

Alannah Myles' success hasn't been limited to North America. Worldwide sales of her self-titled debut album are now measured in millions and radio stations in dozens of countries have made the album and the primary single, Black Velvet, big hits.

Black Velvet was a Top 5 hit in at least 12 countries including taking the No. 1 positions in both Norway and Sweden. The single peaked at No. 2 in Great Britain and Germany and reached No. 3 in Australia.

The album has also been a Top 10 hit in at least 12 countries. Her second U.S. single release, Love Is, is in the Top 40 and climbing while the fifth Canadian single, Kickstart My Heart, has just been released.

#### Helix back for another taste of the road

Stalwarts of the Canadian rock circuit, Helix epitomise the hard-rocking, hard-working band. Their raucous live shows and tireless touring demonstrate the Kitchener, Ontariobased band's straightforward, no-nonsense approach: they want to rock and they want their fans to have as much fun as they're having

For some bands, touring is an exhausting necessary evil. But the members of Helix say the road is their lifeblood. "We like being out there," confesses vocalist Brian Vollmer. "I don't like being in one place too long...It's nice when you can get out there, away from the distractions of home. I have a routine when I'm on the road. I get up at 11 or 12 o'clock, I eat, I go jogging...I've got my day planned out. When I'm at home, I've got no routine. I'm running here, running there, trying to get this paid and that paid and this taken care of, and be a dad, and be a friend... I don't mind doing those things, but when you're home that's what you have to take care of "

The fifth and latest Helix album, Back For Another Taste, was conceived on and drew its inspiration from the road. "A lot of the songs were written on the road," says Vollmer. "We tried them out in front of an audience, and then we came straight in off the road and did the recording while the band was still hot ... We'd record two or three songs, and then we'd go back out for a couple of months. So we'd have all that time to sit down and listen to the tracks and maybe change this vocal or change that lyric or change the lead part. So we were always finetuning things as we went along. It was great. because a lot of things were changed, not significantly, but just little things that improved the songs."

The time and care spent on getting the album just right reflects the experience gained

The Association release points out that the program includes "a discount incentive program for members of (the Association) for specific products, exclusive sponsorship of (the Association's) upcoming Date With A Tape songwriting workship/seminar series, as well as sponsorship of the annual (Association) workshop held in conjunction with the Music Industry Association of Canada." by Helix's longevity, experience which gave the band the ability to achieve what they wanted in the studio. "We've recorded a lot of albums, and we're obviously more of a live band than, say, Technotronic," says Vollmer. "So we knew how to record well in the studio, we knew what we were looking for when we went in there...We're looking for a live sound. It's kind of hard to describe, you just know when the track feels right and when it doesn't."

Helix took the same approach to filming the video for their single, The Storm. "(The idea behind the video) was to bring the band out, not to have the band be anything that we're not," explains Vollmer. "Basically, we're a hard-rocking live band, and we tried to bring that across on film. Sometimes on film I've found that people get the wrong idea of what we're all about. There are definitely videos where I have to get sick every time I see them."

Unusually, perhaps, the members of Helix show a keen interest in current music. And not just metal, either; Vollmer admits to listening to and enjoying everything from Tom Petty's Full Moon Fever to the B-52s' Cosmic Thing. "I go in cycles. I'll listen to somehting like that for a while and then I'll go back and listen to metal. I want to get the new Slaughter album. I want to stay on top of things, I want to be constantly learning new material.

Considering their long career, Helix are well placed to comment on the state of metal,

# BCAB honours WX1130 for support of Cancon

A major supporter of Canadian country music in British Columbia is Vancouver's CKWX, affectionately dubbed "WX1130 Real Country," and the station's efforts haven't gone unnoticed. At the recent 43rd annual convention of the B.C. Association of Broadcasters, CKWX was presented with an award "for support of Canadian talent." Ted Farr, Program Manager for the popular country giant, accepted the award.

CKWX put its reputation and organizational ability on the line when, in 1988, together with Nashville songwriter/producer Ralph Murphy, presented a Country Songwriting Seminar. "The first year was such a success," says Lisa DePoe of CKWX that the station "expanded the program in 1989" to include five country music seminars that were featured at the B.C. Country Music conference.

The station hosted four special guests from Nashville, who addressed topics which included songwriting, recording and radio, and music and the law. The conference, which was held in New Westminster, attracted several hundred country music industry delegates.

It should also be noted that Harold "Weird" Kendall, Music Director of CKWX, brought national honours to the station when he was inducted into the Canadian Music Industry Hall of Fame in 1989, for his "contribution to Canadian music." a much maligned but enduringly popular musical style. "I think it has come a long way in the last couple of years." comments Vollmer, "Lyrically it has come a long way. It used to be, if you listened to metal, it was all women and parties... I think Guns'n'Roses have really changed the face of metal, in respect to a little bit of intelligence behind it...And musically it has become a lot more poppy, I find. Even though it's getting heavier, it's more accessible to the masses, You hear Guns'n'Roses on the radio, but it doesn't really sound out of character for where radio's at... It seems like heavy metal bands are just writing better music, and I hate to say it's pop, yet it's becoming pop."

Helix has rejected the difficult, bad boy image of many hard rock bands in favour of a serious approach that puts the music first and treats fans and the people with whom the band deals with respect. "We're pretty accessible," agrees Vollmer. "We've done free concerts and we're on time and things like that which people appreciate...One of the most frequent comments we get is people can't believe what good care (manager Ken Heague) takes to send new product, to make sure everything's cool, having the band readily accessible for interviews..." Easy to see, then, why, as they release their fifth album, Helix is one of the most enduring bands on the Canadian music scene.

# Manitoba's Hart-Rouge to rock in the U.S.S.R.

Roland Stringer, Manager of Canadian rock group Hart-Rouge, has announced that the band will be joining performers like Rod Stewart, Bruce Hornsby and Johnny Clegg at a three-day rock festival in Estonia in July.

Stringer tags the festival as "the most important annual rock music event in the U.S.S.R.," pointing out that the concerts would be attended by "over 200 journalists from the (West)" and by "about 300,000 fans (over) the three days." Hart-Rouge is scheduled to perform July 28th, which will be followed by a concert in Helsinki three days later..

Stringer also points out that the concert site (Tallin, Estonia) is considered by the Guinness Book of Records to be "the largest in the world."

The Hart-Rouge overseas trip is being partially funded by Musicaction and Manitoba's Department of Cultural Affairs.

The popular bilingual band has just completed a heavily dated June in which they travelled across Canada and into the U.S., performing at Vancouver's Festival des jeunes, the Regina Folk Festival, the Detroit International Freedom Festival (with the Robert Cray Band) and in Verdon (with Roch Voisine). Prior to their trip to Estonia, the band will play dates in Brossard (July 19), La Baie (20), and St. Angele De Mericci (21). When they return they will continue their Quebec tour playing St. Jerome on Aug 4 with Karen Young and Michel Donato and Ville St. Laurent with the symphony Comusica (11).

The self-titled debut album, released by Hart-Rouge on the Traffic label and distributed by CBS a couple of years ago, is still available, now through MCA.

A cassette sampler of major Canadian country artists is being mailed to all country radio stations in an effort to help promote the ballot.


# CFGM deals major blow to country radio

In the ten years leading to its sale to the Bertlesmann Music Group, Milsap/Lodge Hall Music, "the pair's first publishing company, had hundreds of covers by artists in the country, pop, international and gospel markets, including twelve number one country singles."

Barnett also points out that the new company has drawn writers Naomi Martin, Tim Nichols, Lise Daniel and Steve Grisham, from Milsap/Lodge Hall and recently signed Tabloid Press, a rock band. The company now boasts a catalogue of over 150 songs, and has already secured several cuts and holds including a Keith Whitley single and album cuts by Shenandoah, Travis Tritt, Ronnie Milsap, Lorrie Morgan and Earl Thomas Conley.

#### Country Connections has Canada Day Special

Alan Brown, producer of Country Connections, a syndicated series distributed by the Seltech Satellite System, is making available a special three hour Canada Day Country Music special for the weekend of June 29th to July 2nd. The show has been picked up by nineteen radio stations already, "with more expected to come on board by the holiday weekend," says Brown.

He goes on to explain that Johnny Gold, of CHFX-FM Halifax will be the host for this "upbeat, summertime program," which will kick off the first long weekend of summer.

Brown has built Country Connections, a Halifax production of CHFX-FM, into a credible and popular series through his aggressive approach to Canadian country music. Most recently he packaged two Country Connections shows on the Big Country Awards, one on the nominees for 1990 which aired the weeks of May 14 and 21, the second, excerpts from the actual Big Country Weekend which was held at Toronto's Inn on the Park May 25 & 27. As in the past, Brown was on hand to cover the Variety Club Salute to Canadian Country Music and the Big Country Awards. message, unique for former logger Fjellgaard. 

Also recognized were JR Country Radio's Dave McCormick, who won as On-Air Personality; JR Country Club's Don Adams, who shared the Country Music Person of the Year Citation with B.C.C.M.A. Vice President Diana Kelly; Bill Buckingham and Larry Wayne Clark as Engineer and Producer of the Year respectively; and Rocky Mountain Boys, who received a Citation for Bluegrass Performers.
