Ross Carlin on home stretch for a revitalized anthem

It was reported in RPM's Feb. 2/91 edition (Walt Says) that DC103.5 (Orangeville, Ontario) on-air personality Ross Carlin had pledged to play Canada's national anthem every day on the station until the conflict ended in the Gulf war. Carlin wanted to raise the awareness of his listeners "on how lucky we are to live in this country."

In his small way, Carlin created a stir among his listeners. "It's such a small simple thing to do, but it means so much that phone lines are jammed with thanks following each playing."

There was a problem however. The only recorded versions of Oh Canada were likened to funeral dirges. In the Feb. 16/91 issue of RPM (Walt Says) Carlin expressed a desire to get Canada's top recording artists into a recording studio for a session of Oh Canada "sung with feeling", as only these professionals could do.

Carlin's idea met with only "polite interest". However, armed with the support he had received from his listeners, he persisted and with the help of Gord James of CTV he has opened the door to what could be the fruition of his dream.

The revitalization of Oh Canada is finally on the drawing board. However, there will be two recordings, a contemporary version using a collection of several of Canada's best musicians and recording artists backed by the Orpheus Choir, and an orchestral versions utilizing an all-star symphony (long and short version). The new versions are being arranged by Toronto songwriter Eric Robertson. Haywood Parrott

Construction begins on Toronto's Molson Place

There will be no more rain outs at the Shipdeck Stage at Toronto's Harbourfront. The Stage has begun to be dismantled and construction begun of Molson Place. A glass roof will provide weather protection and an open concept will retain the ambience of an outdoor venue.

Located on the south west corner of York Quay grounds, the Shipdeck Stage has been the principal stage for the Molson Canadian Summer Music season at Harbourfront. Since 1978, the Shipdeck Stage has showcased a diverse range of musical performers including Billy Bragg, Blue Rodeo and the Staple Singers. Molson Place is scheduled to open July 1, 1992.

Kuczkowski to Sunrise as Director Sales/Operations

Malcolm Perlman has announced the appointment of Dan Kuczkowski to the position of Director of Sales and Store Operations for Sunrise Records & Tapes. Kuczkowski has a wide and varied knowledge of the record retail business. He was in charge of A&A's superstores and just prior to joining Sunrise, was the Regional Manager for Saturn Distributing.

Kuczkowski will be based in Sunrise's head office, but he will spend most of his time in the field, checking store operations and reporting directly to Perlman.

There are currently 29 Sunrise stores in Southern Ontario, including the flagship store on the downtown Yonge Street (Toronto) strip. will produce.

In view of the fact that English and Frenchlanguage recording artists across Canada are being asked to take part, and as a means to control costs, producers are considering utilizing Vancouver, Toronto and Montreal recording facilities. It's hoped that most, if not all, of Canada's popular recording artists will take part in this sprucing up of Canada's national anthem. With 57 French and more than 100 English language recording artists being asked to take part, some as lead singers and others as part of an all star-chorus, the project is expected to be completed well before next Canada Day.

The revitalization program is being directed by Bryan Lyon, who, together with Ross Carlin, are acting as executive producers.

Drabinsky group to stage Webber's Joseph musical

Garth Drabinsky, Chairman of The Live EntertainmentCorporation ofCanada (LIVENT) has announced a \$4 million Canadian staging of Andrew Lloyd Webber's new London production of Joseph And The Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat. LIVENT will coproduce the production with The Really Useful Group Ltd. (RUG), to premiere at Toronto's Elgin Theatre June 20, 1992. As well, a two to three year tour is planned to take the production across Canada and to certain US border cities.

Four different children's choirs, each comprised of 25 young people aged nine to 15, will be required for the initial Toronto engagement. Two choirs (50 singers) will rotate

Thunder Bay's Nancy Doetzel adds realism to video

Thunder Bay freelance journalist/broadcaster Nancy Doetzel fulfills a promise she made to her father and brother the last time she saw them before they left this world. They asked her to "keep singing" and to promise that she would someday record a song with lyrics that communicated hope.

After working as an entertainment reporter for the past ten years, Doetzel was constantly reminded of the problems that go with alcoholism and drug abuse. She moved into the freelance journalism/broadcasting field and as a certified alcoholism/drug abuse counsellor, developed a unique understanding of the entertainment and addiction worlds.

Doetzel fondly recalls the nickname "Patches" applied to her as a child. "I was viewed by others as a ragged looking street kid, always running." With this in mind she wrote Patches, How Far Can You Run, which she describes as her story "of picking up the pieces of the past, letting them go and coming to live a healthy, hopeful life. Throughout my life, music has been a thread that stitched the fragments of my life together."

Doetzel's song will be a significant part of an educational autobiographical video she is producing about living with a mother and brother who were "hooked on drugs". The autobiography ends with the playing of the song along with visuals of places she returned to visit in the town where "Patches" was born. Line producer is Virginia Gibberd and Gordon James is looking after the supervision for CTV.

Michael Burgess, who plays Jean Valjean in the Toronto production of Les Miserables, will host the one-hour TV documentary. The special is being produced by the Oh Canada Foundation in association with CTV. Peter Pearson, who helmed the production of Ken Dryden's Homegame special, has been named as producer/director.

All copyright ownership and monies raised from the project are assigned to the O Canada Foundation. Newly formed, this private foundation will oversee the distribution of the CD and cassette configuration and booklet to every school, library, television and radio station, theatre and sporting facility in Canada.

The TV documentary and contemporary video will follow the audio recording schedule.

Casting for the new Canadian production is now underway and is expected to be completed by the end of this year.

A similar educational program is currently being made available by LIVENT for students attending the Canadian production of The Phantom Of The Opera and Aspects Of Love.

The song and the video will be released during Drug Awareness Week (Nov. 17 to 24). The song will be released as a cassette single on Thunder Bay's Star-Pac Records and on an RDR CD compilation.

Sphere Clown Band releases third album

The Sphere Clown Band, one of Canada's most popular recording/performing clown acts, has released a new album, entitled Kid Stuff. Distributed through Whitman Golden Ltd., the new album, the third for the band, contains the same high-energy, kids-oriented songs that have made them popular-on the tour circuit.

Produced by Robert Rettberg, the album consists of ten new songs written by the band's "Patty" (Patricia Silver Erlendson) and "Bumper" (John Erlendson), with James Love and Jack Preobrazenski. The album is described as "a catchy, playful and very entertaining collection, specially designed for audience participation. Key are Fiddling Riddler ("Patty" is a fiddle virtuoso), the rap-like Stuff ("Junk's the stuff you throw away, stuff's the junk you keep!"), and an ode to Peanut Butter, to such environmentally friendly trackslike Garbage and the anthem-like Imagination and If You Can Dream it, You Can Do It.

Besides "Patty" and "Bumper", the Sphere Clown Band comprises "Gizmo" (Allan Baedak) and "Pooky" (Larry Potter), all multiinstrumentalists. The band members perform on a variety of instruments including bass, guitars, keyboards, kazoo, drums, fiddle, flute, banjo, accordion, and noise instruments including whistles, duck calls and "lyrannosaurus Rex Roar" and computergenerated effects and music.

Whitman Golden, distributor of the band's product, is a leading producer, manufacturer and distributor of children's audio tapes and considered the largest publisher of children's books in the world. The new album/cassette has been issued under the Golden Music label for distribution in department, music, book and toy stores across North America. The distribution agreement was a major coup for the Torontobased band.

I Can Do Anything, the first album released by the band earned them a Juno nomination, and the follow-up, Sharing, gained them an even wider audience, which led to the Golden Music signing.

Having just completed around of fall fairs, including Milton, Georgetown, Caledonia, Brampton, Bolton, Foley and the Quinte Exhibition in Belleville as well as many private corporate functions, the band is now into a hectic fall schedule. Included are performances at the Bala Cranberry Festival (Oct. 19 & 20), the Woodbine Centre, Rexdale (Toronto), Sphere Monster Band Halloween Show (27), and the Oakville Place, Sphere Monster Band Halloween

Anthem looking to sign new acts

Anthem Entertainment in for "the long haul" - Roper

"I've seen it all kid." No doubt many a manager has used that line when trying to sign up a band. But in the case of Bob Roper, newly appointed Vice President of Anthem Entertainment, it's a true statement. He has seen it all.

In his 20 years in the music industry, Roper has been tour manager for Supertramp, done concert production work with CPI, was A&R Director at Warner Music Canada for eight years, and most recently was the manager for Sharon, Lois & Bram.

It was that kind of experience that Ray Danniels, President of Anthem, was looking for when he decided he needed a right hand man to sign new bands to Anthem Entertainment. "Ray and I have known each other for years, so it's a comfortable arrangement. Ray is so busy with Rush that he wanted somebody to handle the other acts like Gowan, plus to sign two or three

other acts that have potential."

Roper says that Rush has been one of the most consistent top draws on the concert scene for the last 10 years. "So when Ray calls Atlantic in New York, you know he won't have any trouble getting Ahmet Ertegun (President of Atlantic) on the phone. Those kind of connections you can't buy."

Roper says that out of the hundreds of tapes that cross his desk every month, it's not surprising, that it's the most professional packages that stand out. "When I do marketing seminars I always tell them, 'you've got to be professional. Make sure you'demo is on a first rate cassette. Make sure you've got a decent picture and bio.' It sounds obvious but you wouldn't believe how many bands go about it wrong, then think that a label can't wait to sign them. Wrong!"

As to what he's looking for, Roper says he's wide open for anything that's good. "One thing we're looking for is a band that's good at playing live. It took Rush several years of paying dues in bars before it started to pay off. Touring is often the only way to break a band now. I was at a showcase for the Crash Test Dummies and you could just feel the buzz of excitement that went through the crowd after they performed."

Roper knows the grind of being on the road but he says that Anthem is in for the long haul as long as the band is. "Sure, sometimes things don't work out. It can be just a one album release deal and go your separate ways, those things happen all the time. But what we really want is a band that are talented, can play live, and are committed. Nothing gets me more excited than when I hear a good tape. It's a business, but it's still a lot of fun."

Joining the more than 23,000 other music publishers represented by CMRRA in Canada are: II Pepper Music, Modern Groove Publishing, Tokyo Kyoko Music, Sunnyridge Publishing, First City Productions Inc., and SRJ Music.

CMRRA is Canada's leading music licensing agency, issuing the majority of mechanical licenses granted yearly to the country's major and independent record companies. The agency also issues synchronization licenses to film, television and advertising producers.

Montreal student wins Henderson/SOCAN nod

Benoit Toupin of Montreal has received the 1991 Gordon F. Henderson/SOCAN Copyright Award for a paper titled Moral Rights in Canadian Copyright Law: In Search of Their True Nature (written in French).

Toupin is a graduate of University of Montreal and is currently articling with the Montreal firm Martineau Walker. His paper examines the evolution of moral rights and inquires as to their nature and, by necessary implication, the nature of authors' rights in general. The object of the paper is to arrive at an objective criticism of the June 1988 modifications of the Copyright Act. His paper was a unanimous winner in the competition.

The competition is sponsored annually by the Society of Composers, Authors and Music Publishers of Canada (SOCAN) and offers a cash award of \$2,000 to law students for a paper dealing with copyright as it relates to music.

Blame it on Holly Cole's youth and voice

"Relentless pursuit." That's how Holly Cole describes how Alert Records President, Tom Berry, came to signing the Holly Cole Trio to his label.

"We weren't even looking for a deal because we thought they'd say, 'we love your music but we think you should sing pop songs...' But Tom never said that, he just wanted us exactly the way we were."

But Berry's instincts were bang on the mark as the Trio's debut of loving interpretations of old jazz standards, Girl Talk, sold over 30,000 in Canada. Now with a strong second release

Adams No. 1 again. It won't last as long at the top as his previous song, and it has a very narrow lead, but Can't Stop This Thing We Started becomes the second straight No. 1 song for Bryan Adams from his current album, Waking Up The Neighbours. The album climbs into the No. 2 spot behind Guns N' Roses' Use Your Illusion II.

Staying power... Of the songs in the Top 20 on the Hit Tracks chart, eight are from artists who have been around 10 years or more. There are many artists who had withstood the test of time, but a rare few have had continuous success over a long period. Name an artist who has had a Top 20 song in the 60's, 70's, 80's, and 90's. Hint: both are currently on the chart.

Could become his biggest! Tom Cochrane's Life Is A Highway moves up to No. 3. It surpasses Big League which peaked at No. 4 in 1988, but it hasn't become his biggest hit yet. Good Times reached No. 2 in 1989.

Year of the ballad. Bryan Adams' (Everything I Do) I Do It For You drops out of the Top 20 after spending the last 15 weeks there. CFTR Toronto Music Director Rob Farina reports I Do It For You is still No. 1 on their chart where it has been for the past 10 weeks. Of the 41 weeks so far this year, ballads have been at No. 1 for 27 of them and non-ballads only 14. Compare that to last year when it was basically a 50/50 split.

Fast facts... There are four songs on the Hit Tracks chart that mention cry or tears in the title but none mention smile or laugh. The Top 11 albums all come from artists listed in the first half of the alphabet (and 10 of the Top 11 on the Hit Tracks). Five of the Top 15 albums don't even have one song on the chart. Just scanning the charts I see: sex, bitch, hooker, decadence, slave, psychotic, blood, apocalypse, cult, EMF, and sex again.

Many are close! There are a dozen artists who could still achieve a Top 20 song in each of the last four decades with one in the 90's including Neil Diamond and the Bee Gees who are currently on the chart. Robbie Robertson and Burton Cummings have done it in a combined group/ solo effort. However, the only two artists to have had a Top 20 song in the 60's, 70's, 80's, and 90's are Cher and Bob Seger. called Blame It On My Youth, the Cole Trio are scheduled for a worldwide release through the Manhattan/Capitol label come early next year.

The album title comes from too many reporters asking the 27-year-old Ms. Cole why she sings old jazz standards instead of pop/ rock? "Blame it on my youth," Cole grins. "Plus, I love that song and it just missed making the record."

It was as a youthful, 16-year-old that the Halifax native went down to see her brother at Berklee College in Boston. "That's when I really heard jazz and at first I thought it all sounded the same. But when I got home I found myself buying the records I had heard. Then, when I heard vocalists like Sarah Vaughan and Betty Carter I was hooked."

Cole studied music for two years at Toronto's Humber College but she says it was sitting in at jams at the legendary Grossman's Tavern, where the Jeff Healey Band also came together, that gave her the courage and chops to perform live.

"Girls ask me for advice on how to get started and I tell them to sit in on jams as much as possible because it's a real audience. It was really nice to see Jeff again at last year's Juno's. We both found it sad that the scene at Grossman's had gone down hill. I saw a band the other week and when I mentioned to the bass player at the set break that the drummer was awful he said, 'yeah, his idea of time is a magazine'."

It was a stunning Juno performance of Peggy Lee's Don't Smoke In Bed that drew a rave in a US trade, which in turn, led to a signing with the Manhattan/Capitol label in New York. Blame It On My Youth was produced by Greg Cohen, upright bass player for Tom Waits and the band that Woody Allen sits in with on clarinet at Michael's Pub in New York.

"I had always been a huge Waits fan. So it was kind of like high school where you tell

PolyGram and Motown sign distribution deal

Alain Levy, President and Chief Executive Officer of PolyGram, and Motown President and Chief Executive Officer Jehryl Busby have jointly announced a distribution agreement whereby PolyGram Distribution Group will distribute Motown product in the US. PolyGram Records of Canada will distribute Motown in Canada.

Under the terms of the multi-agreement with Motown, PDG will devote a team exclusively to the US marketing of black music, with a senior executive to be named at a later date.

The first Motown product to go through the new distribution system from beginning to end will be Shanice Wilson's debut album to be released in November. Also coming up is the release of a new Diana Ross album entitled The Force Behind The Power. When You Tell Me That You Love Me, the first single taken from the album, is currently making gains up the RPM AC chart. your friend to tell someone that you really like him, when I told Greg that I'd love to do a Waits song. "Growing up out east, all we got was Canadiens games so I'm a huge fan. But it's got to be at the old Forum. But I've been told that they don't let professionals sing the anthem there, so I'm hoping they'll bend their rules for me."

Toronto's Warren Hill home for rave reviews

Ace alto sax man Warren Hill says he once wanted to be an engineer but he's too hip looking to be anything but a jazz musician. And now the Toronto native is bringing his hot horn playing to Ontario as the warmup act for Natalie Cole.

Hill is touring behind his just released debut album, Kiss Under The Moon. Recorded in Los Angeles with the cream of the city's top session players, the release showcases Hill's raging talent on the alto sax.

After one year of studying engineering physics at the University of Toronto, Hill opted for music and enrolled at the Berklee College of Music in Boston. Upon graduating, Hill headed for L.A. where he has played sessions for the likes of Chaka Khan, C.C. Diva, Lisa Taylor and La Rue. He is also a featured soloist on an upcoming recording by actress Kim Bassinger and on the soundtrack for FXII.

Hill isn't a jazz purist. He enjoys playing all kinds of styles, just as long as the music has some passion, Hill will play it. "I set out to represent myself as a composer, saxaphonist and producer on Kiss Under The Moon. I didn't want to pin myself down to any one style just to suit what's big on the charts this week. I wanted to do something honest. The tunes fluctuate between R&B, jazz and rock, but there's always that edge, that passion coming through."



KENNY LOGGINS - Pop Leap Of Faith Columbia - CK-46140-H



The success of the title trackalone points out the feeling among programmers for her loss. McEntire's version of the Vicki Lawrence classic The Night The Lights Went Out In Georgia will go down as a McEntire classic. Also key: If I Had Only Known and Bobby. Produced by McEntire and Tony Brown. (CD reviewed) - WG



NORM BRUNET - Country Me And My Guitar Brunetunes - BTCD-001

Norm Brunet, a country artist from Aylmer, Quebec, makes an impressive debut with the release of this 10-song CD. Brunet was the 1990-91 Bud Country Talent Search finalist. This release is a joint venture of Q-Country 101-FM Ottawa, Schadillac Ranch and Brunet's Brunetunes label. This is flatout country with a unique infusion of blues, cajun and pop that only Quebec artists seem to be able to deliver. Brunet should be given a very close listen. He has been on the charts before, back in 1987, but with the release of, I'll Sing You A Song, one of the best on the set, Brunet should establish himself on a national scale. Also key are Helping Hand and Take Care Of My Heart, but don't overlook Stranger To Love, which Brunet co-wrote with "Ai" Produced by Brunet and Victor James Nesrallah and recorded at Ottawa's Free Flying Sound Studios. Great fiddles by James Stevens and steel by Danny Artuso. That's producer Nesrallah on national steel and harp. (CD reviewed) - WG



VARIOUS ARTISTS - Country A Tribute To Elvis K-tel - 60202

Yes, another tribute to Elvis Presley. This one should attract those stations wishing to make their library of Elvis tributes complete. Great stuff from several musicians and vocalists who grew up with an obvious deep respect for Presley. Ronnie McDowell's The King Is Gone, Roger McDowell's Statue Of A King, Memories Of The King by Elvis Wade, Leon Everette's Goodbye King Of Rock 'N' Roll, and J.D. Sumner's Elvis Has Left The Building, to name just a few. (CD reviewed) - WG



MOTLEY CRUE Decade Of Decadence Elektra - 61204-P - Rock

As greatest hits packages go, the Crue offer up a pretty good package. There's the hits, Girls, Girls, Girls, Smokin' In The Boys Room, Dr. Feelgood, etc., plus a live cut of Kickstart My Heart. Rock n' Roll junkie is from the Ford Fairlane soundtrack and Teaser is from the charity album, Stairway To Heaven, Highway To Hell compilation. Three new bonus tracks are Primal Scream, Angela, and a cover of the Sex Pistols' Anarchy In The U.K. Essential Crue for the truly decadent. (CD reviewed) - DP

BABY ANIMALS - Rock Baby Animals Imago - 7287-21002-2-N

The Baby Animals have a lot of animal in them, with no baby traits. It's a dynamite debut album from the quartet that come from the land down under. The band gets its energy from the tough, cool vocals of the lead singer/rhythm guitarist Suze DeMarchi and the ferocious drumming of Frank Delenza. DeMarchi co-wrote all 11 tracks and they ring true with none of the sentimental drivel that pervades so much of the female vocalist market of today's music scene. (CD reviewed) - DP

Garth Brooks continues to hold down the No. 1 position on the RPM Country 100 with Rodeo, the fastest moving single in his history. His album, Ropin' The Wind, continues to make good moves up the RPM 100 Albums chart. The album has now shipped over 123,000 copies and should match the double platinum status of Fences in the next couple of weeks.

Cori Brewster's fifth single, Country Station (Rescue Me), has picked up good programmer comments and playlists. The action began with the KIX network of four stations in Newfoundland, all the way to her home province of B.C. The song, which is included on Roto Noto's Border deFences, was written by Brewster and Stephen Lester-Smith. Dan Donahue produced.

Cassandra Vasik could have a hit out of the box. Several major programmers jumped on Vasik's track, It Comes Back To You, her debut on the Einstein Brothers label, distributed by Sony. The first to add were Chuck Reynolds at CHYR Country 710 Windsor/Leamington, Weird Harold at Vancouver's WX1130 Real Country, Danny White at New Country 1270 CHAT Medicine Hat, Bill MacNeil at K94FM Sydney, and Paul Kennedy at CHFX-FM Country 101 Halifax.

BMG's Lassoes 'N Spurs, a new series carries a suggested list of \$8.98 for CDs and \$3.98 for cassettes. The initial release comprises 15 titles, including Family Brown, Alabama, Keith Whitley, Hank Snow, Earl Thomas Conley, Juice Newton, Lorne Greene, Bobby Bare, and more. These are all new compilations featuring many of the more popular releases by the individual artists.

Joan Kennedy makes it two. The title track of Joan Kennedy's Candle In The Window, taken as a single, has moved onto the charts. This is the follow-up to I Never Met A Liar (I Didn't Like) that scored a No. 9 on the RPM Country 100.

Gilles Godard has another charter. Canadian producer, Gilles Godard, now based in Nashville, adds another chart mover to his record. This one, I Want To Grow Old With You, is by Janie Fricke, released on the Intersound label. The track was taken from her self-titled album.



From Grant Avenue Studios to 820 CHAM, Lisa Logan rushed the Just completed song We're Singin' to the Hamilton station for a premiere run (it or) CHAM's Sharon Caddy, Logan and CHAM's Mark LaPointe.

Big chart jumpers this week are McBride & The Ride's MCA release Same Old Star, up to No. 25 from No. 52, and Lorrie Morgan's RCA track, A Picture Of Me (Without You) which moves into the No. 26 position from No. 57.

Billy Dean continues to make good moves up the charts. His latest, You Don't Count The Cost (No. 28) was taken from his self-titled Capitol album. He is getting good AC chart action on Somewhere In My Broken Heart which was taken from his previous album release, Young Man. A bit confusing, but nevertheless, this bright young talent has successfully bridged that very lucrative country/pop gap.

Michael Peters' new single is titled I Won't Love Again, not Little Old House, as reported in the Albums section last week. He has seen chart action on each of his releases since going solo from the Cole Younger Band.

Kim Doolittle signs UK deal. Gerry Knight, Kim Doolittle's manager, reports the signing of an agreement with Cottage Records of London, England. The signing came about through the extensive airplay in Europe of two of her singles, He's Gonna Break Your Heart and Love Breakdown. The UK release will include the ten songs on Doolittle's cassette Something Old, New Borrowed And Blue plus eight others. A follow-up single, What In The Name Of Love is included on Roto Noto's most recent CD compilation Border deFences.




