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Dave Marsden going to the "edge" on the Internet

Canada's leading edge Internet entertainment broadcaster, Virtually Canadian, will be over hauled and re-launched in the first weeks of October with CFNY groundbreaker and Rock-n-Roll Hall of Fame inductee David Marsden leading the way.

Always known for taking risks, Marsden said "I see the Internet as the new platform. In 1968 I moved from AM to FM. Everyone was saying 'no one has FM radio. Why are you doing this?' I see this in a similar way. Now people are saying to me 'No one is listening on the Internet. You can't have the Internet in your car.' Well you can if you can see the future."


Marsden noted that many new genres of music aren't being played on the radio today. The new entity, name undisclosed at this time, will have four channels to provide an outlet for this style of music.

"The development of audio presentation over the last couple of decades has gone from an AM to an FM Progressive to an FM Modern Rock. As each different era presented itself there was an adjustment in the form of delivery. That adjustment was brought forth simply because there needed to be a new platform. Each time there was a revolution in music there was a new platform invented."

To play the revolutionary new music like Drum'n'Bass, Industrial-Metal, Ambient, Dark Wave and what ever else comes along, is, according to Marsden, the Internet. "What we have now is a lot of music not being played by radio because that's the way it is. So now there is another new platform. The Internet is the new platform." To prepare for this, the Internet broadcaster is moving into the state-of-the-art studio built by Rawlco Communications for CISS-FM in Toronto.

The four planned unnamed 24/7 channels to

be broadcast from this station are, a non mainstream dance music format, with former CFNY DJ Hedley Jones as the Musicmaster (think music director), an as of yet unnamed live music channel with guests performing in the studio or pre-recorded concerts, a

channel for overall music presentation and a very top secret channel. Marsden will only say "it will probably generate much excitement. It's an area that has never been touched by public broadcasting."

More channels will likely be added six months after the broadcaster goes to air. "The advantage we have with the Internet, is that we have an opportunity of presenting all these different services specifically designed and targeted to a particular community."

Club DJs, or NJs (net jocks) as they will be known, from around the world will be spinning for the Global Groove channel. "The best club DJ in London. The best club DJ in Amsterdam. The best club DJ in Los Angeles, New York, Vancouver, Montreal and Toronto will each have a performance." This is needed because club music fans from around the world have very different tastes.





Radiosonic broadcasts John Southworth live

CBC's Radio Two program Radiosonic, hosted by Leora Kornfeld and David Wisdom will be broadcasting live-to-air on Sunday June 13 for the launch of eccentric pop songwriter John Southworth's new album Sedona Arizona, released by Outside Music.

The live performance by Southworth and guests Martin Tielli of the Rheostatics and Hawksley Workman can be heard across Canada at 7 PM with the exception of the maritime provinces which can tune in at 8 PM and 8:30 PM in Newfoundland.

A new three album contract with Japanese label Quattro Records will result in Sedona Arizona and his debut album Mars Pennsylvania being sold in Japan. Southworth is expected to tour Japan in support of the releases in the fall.

Bros. because she doesn't want to renew with anybody," explained McKennitt's press agent Richard Flohil of Richard Flohil and Associates.

"It was a three album deal and she has fullfilled that obligation. Where we go in the future is unknown. She will decide at some point on what she wants to do," said Warner Bros.' senior vicepresident Dave Tollington.

Warner Bros. expressed interest in renewing the contract but also respects her decision to not sign with them at this time. "Certainly we would like to continue the relationship but we are respecting her present situation," Tollington says.

Signing a new contract would require her to make a commitment on the number of albums she would have to release in the future. "At this point in her life she's not making that commitment," Flohil

stated.

When McKennitt is ready to return to recording albums for major record labels, Warner Bros. will be there to convince her to sign with them. "It's been a long relationship. We would like to continue the relationship. We're here," Tollington stated.

The two time Juno Award winner and multi-

The two time Juno Award winner and multiplatinum artist is taking some time off to determine what she would like to do as an artist. She has already released a double CD Live in Paris and Toronto through her own label Quinlan Road, which is selling the CD on her website and mailing list. Proceeds from the album sales will be donated to The Cook-Rees Memorial Fund for Water Search and Safety.

McKennitt started this fund after her partner Ronald Rees died in a tragic boating accident on Georgian Bay. McKennitt was remixing the album at the time of his death and has since dedicated this album to him.

Gordon Lightfoot Songbook released by Warner/Rhino

Warner Music/Rhino has targeted a June 15 release date for the Gordon Lightfoot Songbook. The treasure trove features 88 tracks from 19 original albums beginning with his recordings for United Artists, Reprise and Warner Bros. Records. Also included are rare singles.

The package was produced with Lightfoot's direct participation including a track-by-track history which Lightfoot penned himself.

"By the time the sleuthing was done," said a surprised Lightfoot, "We had uncovered a number of rarities that surprised even me."

Lightfoot's first charted single, 1'm Not Saying, peaked at #12 (June 28/65) on the RPM 100. The track was released on the Compo label. His first #1, If You Could Read My Mind, topped the chart on Feb. 20/71. His second #1 was Sundown (June 15/74), which of course led up to his chart-topping The Wreck Of The Edmund Fitzgerald (Nov. 20/76).

Lightfoot won his first Juno (which were called the RPM Gold Leaf Awards) in 1966 when he was voted Canada's top folk singer.

The elaborate and eye-catching 5" X 5" brickstyle package includes a deluxe book and what is described as "an exhaustive biography" plus neverbefore-seen photos from Lightfoot's own archives.

Included in the package are 16 previously unreleased tracks, two of which are Lightfoot's very first recordings from 1962. The other 14 tracks were

never available before.

In 1974, Lightfoot was recognized for his

contribution in furthering Canadian culture with the Order of Canada. He was awarded the Governor General's Award, in 1997.

developed and made stars for the label, and who had one of the best radio connections in the business, has been touting a new artist. Much to his surprise, calling on some of the stations he serviced over those years, he found he couldn't even budge the door. Even the guys who had moved upstairs to cushier jobs wouldn't see him. 
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

The first single, Look At Me, broke into the Top 30 of the Hit Tracks chart and was supported by a brillant video and a multi-media single that included the full video. Obviously there is a hint of the Spice Girls on every track, However Halliwell's vocals and lyrical style are guaranteed to attract the attention of an older audience as well. Credited with co-writing all the tracks on this effort Halliwell hits home with uptempo CHR single contenders like Bag It Up and You're In A Bubble. Goodnight Kiss should be an instant add at A/C radio which adds to EMI's choices of follow-up singles. A must for die hard Spice fanatics and non-believers.

- Rock/alternative A Place In The Sun BMG 07863 67775-2

The So-Cal punk sound on A Place In The Sun is radio friendly and rock solid. Lit are already number one on the US Modern Rock charts



for the Green Day inspired and riff heavy My Own Worst Enemy. Like other popular punk bands the music is explosive with catchy lyrics and has minimal guitar soloing. Also of note is the punk ballad Miserable which has the band slowing their sound down without becoming wimpy. Opening song Four sets the tone perfectly with its brash intense style which continues throughout the album.

MAE MOORE - Adult Contemporary SelfTitled

Big Hip Records 0694 90378J

The relaxed nature for Mae Moore's fourth album has a more focused fun vibe. Working with producer and label owner Jann Arden has helped Moore create good contemporary song structures. First single Free to Love Me (Warm Song) is just that, with emotional soft vocals, pleasant guitar strumming and drumming that keeps perfect time. The chorus is powerful with a much louder sound with vocals coming through after the sleepy parts. An almost perfect song for adult contemporary radio. The music is perfect to listen to when one is working, played at the RPM offices while we all attempt to work. Another stand out, is track three What Jimmy Said to Me. With it's



countryish-vibe and twangy guitar strumming the song is uplifting and fun. Arden does indeed have a wonderful ear as producer as she has ensured Moore could stretch her style to fit this song.

- Pop/Hop

PATRIA My Rules Black Market-9732-F

Tough and cagey with a bittersweet vocal delivery that gives Patria a competitive edge over her peers. Toughness aside, Patria has a unique soulful methodology with her lyric interpretation, making the vocal property fit like a glove, not to mention her leathered persona (check out the "hot" photos). Not too many



artists have a five-octave range which Patria uses to the max, a nice asset when it comes to stroking the blues. Although the magic here is Patria's delivery and her material, the Domenic Troiano producer touch has obviously added that extra professionalism. He coproduced the album with Howard Ayee. Baby Feel My ... has been taken as the first focus single and is now at radio. The song is hot and it's sexy, tailored to the club scene. Patria's firey delivery captures the very essence of love. "When I love someone," says Patria, "I love them completely and passionately." Also key is First Love, co-written with Troiano, My Flow, co-written by Howard Chen and Passion where the title says it all. But don't overlook the title track, a poignant take on relationships. The video for the first single was shot in Mexico. Doug Chappell, not too shabby when it comes to discovering and signing stars, Shania Twain and Terri Clark, to name a couple, is working Patria's single at radio. He says Patria definitely has star potential. A nice endorsement from someone who's been there and knows the territory

LAURA MacDONALD -Vision

Wicklow-09026-63270-N

One applauds Miss MacDonald for her juxtapositioning of traditional and contemporary expression of music by marrying her keening voice with instrumental sounds that owe much -- perhaps too much -- to technology. It's right and proper that music should be pushed to the limit of its capacity. Now, regrettably we risk raining on her parade by suggesting that this programme of her own almost psychedelic compositions, while



exciting, isn't new in its impact. The same impact was evident in the 1950s and '60s in coffee houses across Europe and North America. That's not bad you understand but short of what we believe she intended. Produced by Philip Strong and Paddy Moloney. 100% MAPL.

MORETEARS FROM HEAVEN - Classical Various Artists and Ensembles RCA Victor Red Seal-09026-63450-N


For us it's well nigh impossible to describe adequately the musical worth of this follow-up album to Tears From Heaven featuring reissued material of the ethereal. One need only list the composers, orchestras, choirs, soloists



and conductors that are here to be enjoyed. They include but are not limited to Bach, Mozart, Handel. Rachmaninoff and Verdi; New Symphony of London, Royal Philharmonic and Chicago Symphonies; the Robert Shaw Chorale, the separate Choirs of Trinity College and Bavarian Radio; Leontyne Price and Dame Janet Baker; Leopold Stokowski and Norman Luboff, Sirs Georg Solti, Thomas Beecham and Colin Davis. One hesitates to haul out the hoary "best of best" descriptive, but who would gainsay? Especially after being thrilled by -BW Verdi's Requiem Lacrymosa.

THE JIMMY BRUNOTRIO - Jazz Live At Birdland II Concord Jazz-4810

Recorded on the same evening as Volume 1, guitarist, Jimmy Bruno, bassist Craig Thomas and drummer Vince Ector present a tasty and



tasteful programme of jazz and pop standards. In this set, saxophonist Scott Hamilton replaces alto saxophonist Bobby Watson and the trio provides the same excellent and seemingly seamless collaboration. The fourteen tracks are each like a well groomed woman's skirt; long enough to cover the important parts but brief enough to be interesting. Best tracks? Tough call, but our two preferred are the Latin flavoured Poinciana and the appropriately dreamy Darn That Dream. Good album.

SONGS OF ERIC CLAPTON - Blues Various Artists

House Of Blues/Platinum-51416-1449

Eric Clapton fans are well aware of his love of the blues, punched home by his admittance that "the blues are what I've turned to, what has given me inspiration and relief in all of the trials of my life." Well, the House of Blues, in their This Ain't No Tribute series, which was launched in 1998, zeros in on the great Clapton with 12 of his songs, which pay "homage", but are not a "tribute" to his blues offerings. The ear-soothing entertainment is exceptional as Joe Louis Walker with James Cotton sashays along with Roll It Over, and Honeyboy Edwards, again with James Cotton, brings out a very cleverly programmed Crossroads. And



With the four channels, listeners won't have to scan the dial to find something they are interested in. If however, what is being broadcast doesn't appeal to listeners at that time, they can go further into the site to find specialty programs based on the channel they are interested in. "If you are into hiphop or swing you can find it on the sub channels," Marsden explained.

The new broadcaster is expected to go-live-to-Internet on October 1st, although Marsden says that date could be pushed back by a week or two. Virtually Canadian will have a new name and new outlook. Instead of creating a new Internet broadcaster the present site is used because Marsden says "it's the perfect model to build on."

Virtually Canadian was founded about a year and half ago and has been Internet broadcasting since that time. "They've gotten it this far. The rest of the world has caught up with these people. Now we go forward with a whole new look. A whole new logo. A new website. It'll be huge! I predict it will be the most exciting music site globally."

Marsden will move from his Vancouver home back to Toronto to oversee the Internet broadcaster's day-to-day activities. "As I did my research it occurred to me it was now time to get involved. I don't mind saying that the financing that has been injected certainly encouraged me to come forward."

While he won't give exact details on the financial backing to support this grand project he did say there are plans to have a public offering allowing people to buy shares in the company which will also raise more capital.

The personal challenge to make the company profitable and gain listeners is something he is looking forward too. "I like the new. I like the refreshing and I like the opportunity to bring forward new concepts and ideas which are going to deliver music to the people that may not hear it on a mainstream service. And it's time to open up the world and say listen here we got a lot of stuff.'

Although it will be open to the world, Cancon will still play an important role even though the CRTC doesn't require it after they decided they

wouldn't regulate the Internet. Those fearing that the new Canadian station will not have Cancon, Marsden has this to say, "My record stands pretty much public on that. Even when I was programming radio, I rarely programmed to the percentage. I would often with CFNY hit 45 percent. It's all based on me believing that this country's music is good or better than anywhere else in the world. So I play the music because it's good."

The Internet broadcaster also does not require a broadcasting license from the CRTC. Competition from the new station will only improve traditional radio. "Every time a new license comes up, people say 'do we really need another radio station?' All the other stations get better (when a license is

Marsden doesn't believe the Internet

broadcaster will force traditional media out of the marketplace. "I don't see it as we're going to take everything away. It's a complimentary source."

The broadcaster will put Canada on the cutting edge of Internet broadcasting technology. About 15 tech people are working on the project now ensuring the broadcaster stays up to date. Many more are expected to be hired. "Every day the audio and video presentation improves on the Internet. We're taking it (Internet broadcasts) to the next step. We're taking it to the next edge."

Along with playing music, the website will have reporting on the different musical and club scene happenings. "If you're traveling and you happen to like clubs and club music, you go to our site and we'll tell you what's happening in London (UK) or Bonn (Germany)."

AV Preservation keeps the Masterworks safe

In an effort to preserve Canada's rich film, television, radio and music heritage a new project by The AV Preservation Trust.CA entitled Masterworks will ensure that Canadian classics are to be taken care of for the enjoyment future generations.

Masterworks has two mandates, explained Brian Robertson chairman of Preservation Trust and president of CRIA, one is to identify Canadian classics such as an early Gordon Lightfoot or one of the first sound recordings made in the early part of the century. The ten classics chosen each year will be restored and preserved digitally. "Naming these every year will draw attention to the archives."

Which is the second part of the mandate."Draw attention because they are not being properly archived. A lot of these works because they are not properly archived are deteroriating and disappearing. Colour film for example has to be stored at zero Celsius or below. It has to be kept in the cold vault."

Even when they discover a lost video tape,

end up with something that is unusable." Masterworks has received seed funding from the federal heritage ministry to start the program but is relying on corporate donors to ensure a long and

healthy life. "We are looking for an overall sponsor to donate money to the program which we don't have yet. Possibly sub-sponsors for each of the categories in film, radio and television. Those are the other parts of the funding to make this a long term relationship."

Some of the necessary funds have been donated already by MoviePix, a Pay-TV network owned by TMN Network. The National Archives of Canada has offered the use of its vaults for storage of the selected classics.

A study is being undertaken to determine how Canadians will be able to have access to the Masterworks so they don't just end up in a vault collecting dust. Possibilities include "a master database which would include all these rare works." Research is under way to check the copyright issues.

Prominent Canadians will determine which albums are to be selected each year. Sam Kula former director of the moving image archive at The National Archives of Canada is chairman of the Masterworks project. The jury is well on its way to choosing this year's ten classics.

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

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
