Germany's VIVA Plans Investments

VIVA, the planned German music and entertainment cable/satellite TV channel announced at last year's POPKOMM, hopes to have its financial plan approved by investors by mid-February. Following months of industry scepticism that the project would ever get off the ground, the service now feels confident that it can meet its stated launch date of August 19, 1993.

Thorn/EMI is now among the companies actively interested in investing in the project. Time Warner and Bertelsmann, whose names have been mentioned as potential investors from the start, are said to be discussing new budget plans for Viva. The channel will have a three year start-up capital of an estimated

DM100 million, which has led to the industry rumours that Bertelsmann and Time Warner had cold feet about getting involved.

Radio/Record Industries Against DMX Launch

The often chilly relationship between the radio and record business might have warmed a bit as the two industries prepare to face a common foe: digital cable/satellite radio.

The potential impact of the emerging technology was one of the main topics of discussion during the

27th MIDEM held in Cannes on January 24-28. The issue, while not new to the industries, took on renewed importance as a result of the European launch of digital cable/satellite radio provider DMX (Digital Music Express). The new US-originated satellite service delivers 30 channels of digitalquality sound into the homes of

cable subscribers and intends to launch in the UK on March 15. DMX is backed by such industry veterans as Bhaskar Menon and Jerry Rubinstein.

Calling such services "an atomic cloud hanging down on us," UK music organization BPI president and former PolyGram UK president Maurice Oberstein said the ability to possibly hear over 100 channels of CD quality stereo radio should force the two (continues on page 17)

Possible Radio Power Shift In France Angers Europe 1

French broadcast regulator the CSA is in heated discussions with the country's three largest radio groups over the proposed acquisitions of ACE net RFM and EHR web Fun Radio.

The CSA is currently reviewing plans at presstime from RTL to buy Fun from publishing company Hersant, while NRJ and publisher Alain Ayache plan to purchase RFM from Crown Communications. Europe Communications is strongly protesting against the proposals, which if approved, could shift the balance of power in radio away from the company. Industry insiders say, however, that a green light from the CSA on both transactions is far from sure. Europe 2 GM Martin Brisac is said to have cancelled plans to attend (continues on page 17)

French Market Figures Show 3.5% Increase

by Emmanuel Legrand

FRANCE French record sales for '92 are "honourable," according to industry organization SNEP president Gilles Paire. With a total wholesale value of Ffr5.8 billion (approximately US\$1 billion), record sales showed a 3.5% increase on 1991's figures. This compares to a 4.6% increase in 1991/90 and 9.9% for

1990 compared to 1989.

Commented Paire in Cannes during MIDEM, where the figures were unveiled, "1992's growth has been less than previous years. If we take into account current consumer attitude and the morose economical climate, it has not been a bad year. But we have the feeling that the market is slowing down, and we forecast that 1993 will be a year of stagnation, if not recession.

million units, while tapes fell to 32 million units (-15%). Singles, all formats considered, registered in at 15 million units. And although vinyl singles have been severely hurt (selling five million units against 14.4 in 1991), two formats are now taking off-two-track CDs (five million units) and two-track cassettes (4.2 million). Paire forecasts that 15 million CD two-tracks will be sold in 1993.

New soundcarriers launched at the end of 1992 have not yet made much impact, with MiniDisc sales accounting for 5.000 units and DCC sales standing at 16.000 units.

With less then 200.000 units sold in 1992, vinyl ablums are virtually dead. In value, vinyl accounted for 4.6% of the total turnover (5.3% in 1991), while long formats-LP, MC and CD-represent 93.4% (92.6% in 1991). CD sales account for 78.8% of the total

In terms of repertoire, classical takes up 10%, French production 40% and international pop 50%. Paire tipped this slight decrease as an "alarming situation." Lack of support from radio stations is cited as one of the reasons of this "col-

Capital Radio Acquires Midland Group For £17.7m

Capital Radio/ London nounced on January 22 its acquisition of group owner Midlands Radio, which operates seven stations in the UK, including its flagship station BRMB in Birming-

The agreed bid of 130 pence per share values Midland at £17.7 million (app. US\$28 million). The friendly takeover will be financed out of Capital's 20 million reserve of cash at hand. The £17.7 million price tag represents almost 40 times what Midland earned last year, which was a pre-tax profit of £67.9 million on a £10.4 million turnover. Commenting on the sale, Capital finance director Patrick Taylor explains, "The operational gearing of the radio station is unique, and the outturn for the Midlands group will be significantly better this year than last."

Midland chairman John Parkinson says, "I am delighted we have reached an agreement and look forward to seeing our stations

flourish as part of the Capital Group. Following the completion of the acquisition, Parkinson will continue as chairman of Midlands in a non executive capacity and will join Capital's board as a non-executive director. Capital is expected to make its own appointments to the Midlands board.

The takeover is Capital's first major investment outside of London. It has minority stakes in several other radio and industry related companies. There are no immediate plans to dramatically alter formats at any of these stations, according to Capital's corporate spokesman Matt Fearnly.

Cope To Sell Cadena 100 Share

Spanish radio SPAIN operator Cope is in advanced negotiations to sell a 2.3% stake in AC net Cadena 100 for Pta1.7 billion (app. US\$15.000) to three Spanish financial institutions and media companies. A decision on who will buy into the Cadena 100 network, which changed its name from Cope FM in May last year, is expected to be announced on Feburary 18.

The cash injection will be used to eliminate a bank debt of around one billion, while the rest will be used for working capital. Cadena 100, which has reportedly been losing money recently, is now said to be operating near a break-even level

The net's MD Rafael Revert says part of the working capital funds will be used to buy new hardware and software, as well as new programming and promotion ideas. As for programming, Revert wants to improve the DJ's on-air presentation style. "I'll be working on 'softening' the sound of the DJs. I want them to sound a little more like the French, and less like the other Spanish DJs. I'm about one or two years from where I ideally want to be.'

Cadena 100 is listened to by some 900.000 people, according to the most recent ICP ratings.

MIDEM AT A GLANCE

The EC is planning to draw up a draft directive on home taping, which will cover audio, video, analogue and digital recordings. The directive, which will require the approval of all member states, will include a levy on hardware and software which is above the average rate in countries which already have such a law.

PolyGram France and SNEP president Gilles Paire has called for the creation of a special fund to support French radio stations playing new French artists. Paire says the fund is needed to help ensure the future success of French artists and to combat increasing sales and airplay of Anglo-Amercain product.

Philips is to embark on the second phase of its DCC roll-out in March. European countries included among the 50 new territories are Austria, Italy, Spain, Sweden and Switzerland. Philips will also increase the number of hardware retailers and software titles. The company targets about 1000 titles for release by year end.

Sony reports that MiniDisc purchases in Japan have outpaced sales of CD in its debut ten years ago. Sony now plans to launch MiniDisc in Scandinavia and most of Europe in February while Spain and Portugal follow in March. Sony hopes to have 1500 titles available by next Christmas. Meanwhile, Warner also plans to roll out MiniDisc titles in Europe over the next three months.

EC laws and promotion/marketing strategies won't stop the flood of parallel imports, according to experts speaking at the International Association of Entertainment Lawyers seminar. Paris lawyer Louis Bernard Buchman estimates that 10% of sales in the top five Europe markets and 30% of the top releases in French hypermarkets are parallel product.

US music publishers group NMPA has joined EMRO, the new European rights organization created last year by UK publishing association MPA to collect mechanical royalties. EMRO's proposed commission rate for administrative costs will be \$4.75—half the levy charged by the leading European societies.

The Europlay project (M&M Jan. 9) has chosen its first "record of the month"—Dutch act 2 Unlimited's No Limit (Byte). The record will get automatic powerplay status on many major European stations including M40/Paris, AKN/Hilversum, Rete 105/Milan and Spanish Cadena SER. Meanwhile, the single is highest entry this week in the Eurocharts Hot 100 Singles, debuting at number 13. Now seriously considering joining Europlay are Finnish pubcaster YLE 2 and Swiss

Founding president of the AER (Association of European Radio) and UK AIRC director Brian West handed over the leadership of the European Association to Alfonso Ruiz de Assin, secretary general of the AERP (Private Radio Broadcasters Association) in Spain. AER representatives asked West to serve a second year, but in nominating his successor, West said he believed the AER post should be rotated annually as had been decided at the AER's launch in Brussels a year earlier. Other offices elected by AER were VP Frank Leysen from Belgium, Javier Gimeno de Priede (Portugal), Benoit Sillard (France) and secretary general Christian Frietsch (Germany). James Gordon from Radio Clyde/Glasgow continues as chairman of AER's copyright group.

MCA says it filed a copyright infringement law suit in French commercial court on January 20 against Charly Ltd., Charly Holdings, Charly Interntational Records and Media Seven. MCA says on January 18 under the authority of French rights organization SCPP that it found evidence of copyright infringement in several Charly Records CDs at various Paris retailers.



1992 was an exciting year for hot AC/EHR French net Fun Radio, whose ratings shot from 5.7% to 6.5% audience cume in the second quarter 1992 as audiences tuned in for the outrageous DJ "Arthur," and then followed him to Europe 1 in the autumn. Ratings settled at 5% in the fourth quarter, leaving them still number two music FM net, after NRJ.

The show very much goes on, however, according to programme director Hervé Lemaire. It is now a

question of doing something very different, he says, citing new programmes "Zapping Fun," 06.00-09.00, with DJ Difool, featuring games and information based on TV programmes, and evening lovetalk programme "Loving Fun" 19.30-22.00, number one in the recent Mediametrie programme

Behind the official format, the idea of the network is to provide the top of today and yesterday, says Lemaire. And this involves bringing classics back into circulation for the upcoming generation of listeners born too late to know the Rolling Stones. And indeed, what distinguishes the net from its closest competitors Skyrock and NRJ, he says, is the effort put into gold programming. When he arrived two years ago, Lemaire noticed

there were loads of classics which the younger audience didn't know about, such as Otis Redding, Eric Clapton and Aretha Franklin.

'I put Clapton's Layla on the Gold playlist, and played it for several weeks. A lot of our younger audiences hadn't heard it, but after a while it was a great success." This approach to programming is not easy, however, and involves being very careful when drawing up playlists. "The most difficult thing is to keep the audiences over 22 happy without losing those under 22," says Lemaire. The station's target audience is 15-30, with a focus on the 15-24 age group.

There is no system of powerplay at Fun, claims Lemaire. "What would be a better idea as far as pleasing the record companies is concerned, would be to promise, for example, to play a track twice a day for so many months. There is the risk with powerplay that listeners get sick of hearing the same song and start zapping to other stations."

Fun's relations with the music industry are now

back on good terms, following bad times around a year ago surrounding the issue of French quotas. "The idea of quotas is fundamentally stupid," he says. "It generally means forcing people to listen to music they just don't want to hear. However, we have now come to an arrangement whereby we play 15% French music. This has not been easy, but all the other nets have the same problem, and I think we will be able to manage."

The programming set-up at Fun is based on a solid working relationship, says Lemaire, who moved up from musical director to programme director in July to replace Bruno Witeck. Having worked for four years with Witeck at EHR Vibrations/Orleans in the late '80s, he was asked to join him (after military service) at Fun in

Can Italian Product Break Out Of The Provinces?

As president of the Ricordi group, Guido Rignano is a key figure in Italy's music industry. The company has an annual turnover of around L250 billion (app. US\$179 million), controls a major publishing firm first launched in the early 1800s, a large record and musical instrument retail chain, a graphic art publishing company, and the record and distribution company Dischi Ricordi, launched in the early '60s. Dischi Ricordi, with an approximate 12% domestic market share, strengthened its position last year by acquiring a 10% stake in the pubcaster RAI-owned record company Nuova Fonit Cetra. Rignano is currently also president of AFT (Italy's IFPI) and vicepresident of the Italian authors and composers society SIAE.

M&M: While many indies are being bought out by the majors, Ricordi is holding its position to the extent of being able to buy shares in Nuova Fonit Cetra last year. How are you competing with the multi-nationals today? GR: In the beginning we distributed and sub-published the majors, but, anticipating harder times, we started offering our services to Italian companies. While indies throughout the world are being bought out by the majors, selling a service allows us to

keep quite an important organization going. We are also dedicated to the development of domestic talent. This combination has allowed us to

compete with the majors. Dischi Ricordi ended with between L85 and L88 billion in 1992-10-20% less than the majors. We have to invest in all our productions, while the majors receive a lot of wonderful product without having to invest, but we are happy. We have the esteem of the Italian industry. M&M: Many record companies on the domestic market claim they are not taken seriously when they try to get internation-

European level. GR: You're right. We used to be much more important. Japan, Germany and South America were

good markets for us, but then disco and dance music arrived and rock came back. We can't compete with those genres. We have another cultural origin and our language is different. Also, let's face it, we're very provincial. We've never been big exporters in anything.

M&M: There's no lack of talent in Italy, so what strategies could be adopted to break it at a pan-European level?

GR: I was privileged having studied English at college. I used to fly to the US and UK and get hold of everything because I was one of the very few Italians who could speak the language. Managers and executives should be able to speak

English easily in order to negotiate and contact other markets. The situation is improving, but the lack of communication and creative product are the two main reasons why we are absent from Europe. At an artistic level we need to be careful in the selection of talent for the local market. The next step is to convince our artists and ourselves that this market is too small, then we must invest a great deal of energy in export drives.

M&M: What are your industry predictions for the coming year? GR: I'm not optimistic. I think we will suffer from the general economic trend. I also think the market will be slightly disturbed by the introduction of the MiniDisc and DCC as people wait before buying until the new media are on the market. In Italy home-taping is becoming a greater problem and piracy is booming. A lot depends on the level of interest rates in Germany and on the new economy with the new US president. My budgeting is certainly going to be very cautious.

Station Operations

10 Ways To Improve Sales Massively In 1993

by Tony Grundy

The start of a new year always brings the chance of a fresh beginning, something radio sales managers should take advantage of in putting the final touches to their training programmes for

What topics, if covered correctly, would almost guarantee success for your station? With my nearly three years' experience training people throughout the UK to get better results, I have nominated the top 10 items to cover in any training programme.

Back To Basics

All salespeople should be reminded regularly of the basic sales process, those things that make them successful. Far too often, during the course of the year, salespeople get into bad habits. The start of the new calendar is a good occasion to break the sales process back down into its component parts and re-practise the correct skills: prospecting, attitude, setting up the first interview and closing a deal.

It may make it easier for people to understand the need for this type of work if you use a sporting example, like Nick Faldo at golf or Gary Lineker at soccer—players who spend hours at the basic skills of their sports to become experts. Very often we in radio end up practising our skills in front of the client. Yes, of course, the basic skills are common sense, but you know, the trouble with common sense is that it isn't all that common!

Business Ratios

Contained in those basics is the need for sales executives to be analytical about their own performance. Sales executives often see the call reports as "the enemy" and only hand them in to the mines their potential to earn money, they start to listen. If the reporting system is seen as something the sales manager imposes upon them, they are never going touse the ratios to help them plan their business. Review your reporting systems with your teams to see if they work—for both sides.

Industry Knowledge

Advertising is also the area radio people are operating in, not just radio. So their knowledge of their industry needs to be detailed and kept constantly up to date. The sheer volume of information being generated by just the radio industry in Europe at the moment means that real effort is required to keep up. The sales manager has to take the lead in creating an easy-to-read summary or cuttings book of the headlines; AIRC provides one of radio news in the UK. In a competitive selling environment, knowledge equals

Product Knowledge

It is obvious we should know our product of radio well. But how often do we either fail to present to the client all the benefits available, or, worse yet, find out the client knows more about a station than the sales executive does! Regular quizzes might help; get the programme controller to set a weekly one for your sales meetings.

Competitor Knowledge

Again, far too regularly I find sales executives who know who the competition is but don't even know, say, the circulation figures of their main newspaper rival or its readership. If you want to call yourself a "sales consultant," then it is your responsibility to keep informed. You con only success-

manager if pressed. They are not accurately filled in and, in all honesty, serve no useful purpose at all. What are important are the three basic but vital ratios: how many presentations you have made on-average in the week, what your average order value is and what your closing ratio is (how many people you need to see to close a deal).

Once sales executives realize that the combination of these three pieces of information deterfully recommend an airtime proposal to a client by understanding its value in relation to competitive media.

Knowledge shouldn't just include newspapers. All areas that take any money from radio should be known and understood. Never sell down the opposition, but do know its every strength and weakness. If you buy airtime from competitive media get them to come and present to you and your team. It's very interesting

and if you have been a bit complacent about competitive media, it may come as a bit of a shock: many of them are gearing up for the fight against radio, seeing it as a competitive threat.

Client Knowledge

I could write a very thick book on what you need to know about clients. In many ways it is the single most important area to know and understand. Most sales executive knowledge, from my experience, is purely superficial.

The reason I feel so strongly about this is that I was once a marketing director of a motors group and therefore do know how the client's mind can be changed by good salespeople who work at their job. I also set up my own business two years ago and it frightened me how much I didn't know about the whole system, the business structures and their legalities. Although I had ran companies for a number of years as managing director, I had other people doing the basics. I believe that it is a very important area of knowledge to understand thoroughly. It makes the possibility of your establishing a rapport with your leading clients that much more likely. Read their trade magazines, understand their business cycles, budgetary processes and media choices. If you are sincere about it, the dividends paid back in "locking in" client loyalty will be very great indeed.

The Consultant Interview

I have seen sales executives at a first meeting with a new client chatting happily away without making a single point. There is no structure to the meeting and, therefore, in most cases very little chance of a successful outcome in business terms.

To be frank, if you have salespeople going out spending their expensive time with clients when there is no hope of a successful business outcome, why are they working for you? Create a "consultant" interview sheet which acts as a sort of questionnaire, although it should never be used that way. It obtains essential information from the client that becomes the basis for future proposals.

It will be accurate and take into account the needs established at this vital first meeting. A sales executive who doesn't even make notes either has a fantastic memory or is missing vital points for the next meeting.

I have never known a client object to the fact that you are interested enough in him to make notes

Questioning And Listening Techniques

Salespeople are usually very poor at either asking good questions or listening to the answers. In some horrible cases they are poor at both. What you get is the salesperson who says, "No problem. I always list out my questions in advance, so I don't miss any." What generally happens, though, is that they are so busy waiting to ask their next fabulous question that they don't listen to the answer to the last one.

Above this, the questions asked are often the wrong sort. The problem is that we are all highly skilled in asking closed-probe questions which evoke a yes/no response. They fail to get

rect." The more positive responses you get, the nearer you are to an order. This is not rocket science, but it works.

Control the presentation, keep a logical structure to it, answer objections as they are raised and keep track throughout the meeting. Give people three options in your proposal; make the lowest option 10% higher than your normal average order, the next 20% and the third 25% higher and I'll bet you will take more money more regularly. Try it.

Presentation Skills

You can create a wonderful proposal and still lose the business if you don't practise presentation skills. I make my clients

the client to "open up" and the meeting becomes peppered with lots of questions from you and lots of short replies from the client. The worst egocentric TV interviewers do it all the time. Does this ring a bell? "Tell me, in your long, distinguished career, which as we know has covered some 112 films, three books and gained you 34 Oscars and £5 million, do you still enjoy it?"

Because radio is such a fantastic medium to sell, it's easy for sales executives to get excited about their product and rattle on endlessly about how wonderful radio is. The goal is to listen first so you can select only the most pertinent radio benefits to "marry up" with his needs and ultimately move more quickly to the close.

Proposal Writing

If you asked, "Which area you would improve first to increase our revenue?" chances are I would say proposal writing.

Many stations hardly do any Some only create computer-generated GRP sheets (Gross Rating Points), and they are awful. Others produce masses but all about themselves. For those people who never use them, I find it difficult to believe they are serious about selling radio professionally. There are so many benefits, it should be written into your contract of employment. It helps you to add credibility to your presentation at the follow-up meeting. Clients, amazingly, respond well if you quote back to them things they previously imparted to you. They say things like, "That's a good point," or "Absolutely corwork very hard at this aspect because in a more competitive marketplace it is vital to look sharp at all times. Rehearse or role-play with your colleagues before you make an important presentation. The difference when you get in front of the client is staggering.

During 1993 we can return to some of these headings in more detail. May all you orders be big ones in this new year!

Marketing The Music

Covermania Rules Airwaves

The old adagium in pop music "name me your cover, and I'll tell you what kind of band you are," seems to be more applicable than ever. Numerous pop and dance acts, such as Undercover, Rage, Take That and Sunscreem, are currently flooding the charts with cover versions of proven '70s classic songs. Above all Whitney Houston is the uncrowned queen of the cover with her version of Dolly Parton's "I Will Always Want You." M&M asked Europe's experts in the field for their explanation of the phenomenon.

Leading cover connaisseur BRTN Studio Brussels programmer and author of the essential DJ handbook "The Originals," Arnold Rypens notes, "At the moment I see more covers than in the last two years, but covers are timeless. The nature of the songs covered these days is different, that's for sure. In the '30s, '40s and '50s labels put 15 to 20 various artists on one song simultaneously. That was in the days of sheet music. Times have changed, with artists covering well-known classics or forgotten songs. The fact that you see so many '70s covers these days is due to the fact that the younger generation doesn't know the originals and apparently has no fantasy to come up with anything better. I am constantly surprised by youngsters telling me they have never heard of Creedence Clearwater Revival."

BMG UK A&R director Mike McGormack, who recently enjoyed two cover hits with Take That, thinks, "A good song never dies. Why shouldn't they be covered and covered again? It's not a sacred thing. People like to buy them, as the charts show."

When McGormack analyses the A&R procedure behind the "covered-up" charts, he sees a great similarity with the '40s and the '50s, when everybody released versions of Cole Porter and Leonard Bernstein songs. "It was a matter of finding the stars and the right songs behind them. Current A&R policies reapply these old tricks. People like to hear classic songs presented by a star." He adds, however, that "This is a pop rather than a rock phenomenon. In the '70s A&R managers looked for rock bands who wrote their own songs, no matter if they pinched whole chunks out of Willie Dixon blues tunes."

Because of his past at Virgin Music Publishing, McGormack, responsible for signing original songwriters such as Terence Trent D'Arby and the Stereo MCs, points to the changed quality of songwriting. "Unfortunately, I must say that a certain style of songwriting is lacking now. There are probably only a handful of classic songwriters left, like Diane Warren and Desmond Child. Apparently there is no new team of songwriters coming up, but hopefully the cover craze will inspire young songwriters. They have to understand that you can no longer get away with songs which are only half good. Covers can set the standard for new talent."

PolyGram Music Publishing professional manager John Fishlock sees a "massive infiltration" of covers in the charts, but is quick to distinguish the pros from the cons. "There's a high density of revamped '70s songs, which is good on the one hand, because they are good songs which should be heard again. It marks a gradual return to real songs, which is important for us, because we base our entire business on songs. On the other hand I think this development is bad for the image of publishers. It looks as if publishing is drying up now, which isn't true at all. On the contrary, our catalogue is getting better every day."

Another negative point for Fishlock is that "people are jumping on the bandwagon. They're all looking for the easy way to get a hit. What we need now is an exceptionally good band or singer to break through with all original songs. The best example in our own catalogue is probably Omar, who had a big hit in many territories with *There's Nothing Like This* in 1991. He's a very versatile writer with a cross-format appeal."

Fishlock regrets that his company is not very lucky with artists revising songs, but he is very hopeful for the future, since PolyGram has a big catalogue of currently popular '70s disco. "On top of my 'pitching list' of songsin-search-for-a-cover are Gloria Gaynor's I Will Survive, Richard Harris's MacArthur Park and Don't Take Away The Music by Tavares."

Looking at new material to be published, Fishlock concludes he is after real songs. "We're in the game of publishing. Songs should still work 25 years later. Most of the dance hits have a life of only one year on the shelf. Rave tunes will never be covered in my opinion. It would make no sense to cover sounds and rhythms. I would be very surprised if there would be a rave revival in about 15 years or so."

EMI Music Publishing UK MD Peter Reichardt is currently in a good mood because his company owns the rights to "earning songs" such as Gerry Rafferty's Baker Street and KC & The Sunshine Band's disco classic Please Don't Go, both all-time hits on compilations and in new versions massive hits for KWS and Undercover respectively.

Underneath this he remains sceptical, however. "Songwriting talents at the moment are not on par with the past," he says. "Artists have to look for covers to get hits, which is a huge benefit for the publishers. Artistically seen, however, the music business is not very exciting at the moment. Happily there's still a lot of good original material out there, like **Crowded House** and **Simply Red.**"

Ironically, the *Stars* album, which sold three million copies in the UK, is the first ever by Simply Red featuring nothing but own compositions. **Mick Hucknall** used to be a great plunderer of soul music archives in search for ideas.

Continues Reichardt, "The bulk of hit songs, however, are producer's records. A production team looks for a good song and the right act to perform it, and bingo! It's nothing new, covers will always be there; it goes in cycles. But it's slightly worrying when the ratio goes up like now."

The current covermania proves to Reichardt that everything in pop music still comes down to the strength of the song, rather than a pretty face or a clever image.

"It's a publishers' dream at the moment, and you won't hear me complain," expresses Warner Chappell Music UK MD/senior VP international Robin Godfrey-Cass. "Especially in the UK charts there's a huge amount of cover hits. Seven songs out of the top 20 are covers, of which we publish four, West End featuring Sybil, Sister Sledge, Go West and S.O.U.L S.Y.S.T.E.M.

"Young bands are looking for the obvious single to sell the album. If they can't write this song themselves, they have to look for it in the back catalogue. It's hard enough for a new band to happen these days. When Warner merged with Chappell, we hoped that this big treasure trove we had would be constantly explored. It's a sure-fire launch path. You get the airplay almost automatically because of the history of the song. We're also doing well with freshly written material by the **Shamen**. What I find most curious, however, is the cover of **An Emotional Fish'** *Celebrate* by Italian arena filler **Vasco Rossi**, which immediately shot to number one in all Italian charts."

In the world of publishers the tidal wave of covers is generally regarded as exceptional, but not by everybody. MCA Music International senior VP John Brands is more low key. "I neither see any explosive growth of covers, nor a diminishing quality of new, original material. We are in the charts with Bizarre Inc, Shai, PM Dawn and Madonna, all original songs. You can't tell today which song will be an evergreen tomorrow. Ten to 20 years from now you will see which songs have really stood the test of time. Some of them will have lived on in commercials or in an other way, while at the time they were written, everybody considered them as ditties."

A case in point, he says, is the 1970 hit single *Hair*, by the group Zen, of which Brands was the lead singer. The song proved to be a classic, because it is still a strong recurrent on Dutch radio.

That didn't stop Tom Waits from dueting with Bob Forrest on Adios Lounge, a song with the same radio appeal as Waits' own In The Neighbourhood. The rest is more the type of guitar-driven pop as was made popular in the mid '80s by a band like the Beat Farmers at their more serious moments. Blood Is Thicker Than Water and Body And Soul are a must for rock radio, which will hopefully forgive them for covering Joan Armatrading's Weakness In Me.



POPKOMM OPENS UP TO INDIES: German record industry trade fair POPKOMM is opening its doors, albeit slightly, to the rest of the world. The organization will allow foreign independent music companies to participate in the event but only via umbrella groups. Foreign majors will be allowed only through their local operating companies.

MORE POPKOMM: BPW chairman Thomas Stein, president of mechanical rights organization GEMA Reinhold Kreile, president of the German PhonoAkademie Gerd Gebhardt and IFPI chairman Helmut Fest are all members of the newly created POPKOMM Advisory Committee which is to help with decision making and planning for the next POPKOMM. The first meeting takes place this week.

ILR RATINGS DOWN, BBC UP: Preliminary RAJAR survey indications reveal UK independent local radio audiences will dip, while BBC networks will gain. However, national commercial network Classic FM is expected to do well, as is Dublin-based EHR/ACE Long Wave Atlantic 252. The complete survey was not available at presstime.

CROWN CALLS IN RECEIVERS: Crown Communications, parent company of Newstalk LBC/London, has called in the receivers at presstime following the block by French regulators of the sale of their loss-making subsidiary RFM. ITN is rumoured to be making a bid for LBC. Crown officials have emphasized LBC is not in receivership.

CH-CH-CHANGES: Major restructuring at EMI Electrola, now that EMI Germany MD Erwin Bach has been named MD Marketing of the record group, while also assuming "initial" responsability for the day-to-day operations of Electrola, as of April 1. The MD post, overseen by EMI Music GSA president Helmut Fest, has been vacant since mid-91 following the departure of Holger Müller to Bellaphon. Director product management Michael Golla has been appointed director/GM at EMI Germany while Winfried Ebert will be promoted to director promotion. More news next week.

MIDEM to be involved in the discussions. Spokespersons for RTL and Europe 1 were unavailable for comment at presstime.

NRJ president Jean-Paul Baudecroux—keeping track of the latest developments while at MIDEM—confirms the negotiations are taking place, but declines to comment in more detail. "I'll tell you more when I hear from the CSA," he says. "The main thing is that we are trying to grow while my competitors are trying to slow us down. That's about all I can say for

now."

If the deal goes through, RTL would add Fun's 2.3 million listeners (5.0% national cume share) to the eight million listeners on its flagship full-service network RTL. RTL parent CLT also owns a 35.7% stake in EHR Web M40, which had a less than 2% cume share in the latest Mediametrie ratings.

NRJ would add RFM's under 2% share (app. 800-900.000 listeners) to the 5.5% share that tune into NRJ (4.3 million people, 9.4% share), Cherie FM (1 million, 2.3% share) and Rire Et Chanson (0.5% share, 227.000 listeners).

the project, Fest is among those who are a little sceptical VIVA will debut on August 19. He agrees that two things have contributed a large part to delays so far: under-estimating the time needed to gain approval by the large media companies, and Bertelsmann's involvement, which complicates matters because the government is concerned over the company's control over German TV.

However, MD of German pro-

duction company VAP Michael Oplesch—one of the initiators in the VIVA project along with DoRo Productions and Me, Myself & Eye—who is overseeing discussions with investors, says the political hurdles have been cleared and that the channel will launch on schedule. "The major problem is not raising the money, but getting the approval of investors," he says. "That should be solved soon."

Fest concurs, "It was never the [amount of] money. It's just that getting these things through layers of management at those types

of companies takes a lot of time."

With the legal and political problems solved, POPKOMM's role in the project has significantly diminished. "PopKomm has done it's job," says one insider. "We have worked with the government to get approval for the cable licences and to win the support of key music related companies. Our role was never to raise the money or be actively involved in managing the channel. And people understand that."

by Sound Solutions at the show. The company, part of the **Phonomatic Group**, admitted it did not hold a valid licence for the compilation, despite it carrying the imprint of Germany's rights body GEMA.

Sound Solutions was one of the largest advertisers at the show, with its name and logo emblazoned on identity tags and promotional cases given to registrants. Several trade papers, including MIDEM News, took advertising from the company.

The high profile of Sound Solutions annoyed many of the exhibition's senior members, who made their views known to MIDEM. On December 25, Sound Solutions was one of eleven Phonomatic-owned companies ordered by Dutch court to cease manufacturing and distribution of its material after a dispute with the country's mechanical rights body STEMRA. The society is alleged to have not paid royalties and Phonomatic's appeal will be heard in February. STEM-RA's group manager of legal and business affairs Sylvia Brandsteder says the society is "delighted that Phonomatic has to leave," but she expressed regrets that the stand was left intact with the company's name on it.

Tring International lawyer Nigel Davis said MIDEM's request for Tring to leave "Was not necessarily connected with either suit." Tring complied with MIDEM's request and struck the stand completely, although, says David, "We contend that there is no justification for MIDEM's action."

On the fourth day of the show rumours were circulating that MIDEM was about to take further action against exhibitors. Such stories were fuelled by very real fears that product on some stands was in breach of other exhibitors' copyrights. One antipiracy expert suggested up to 30% of all repertoire on one stand infringed record companies and possibly authors rights.

IFPI's director general Nic Garnett commented, "A lot of members were expressing concern about what they saw on the stands." Garnett hopes that next year MIDEM will take measures to avoid the problems of this year's show. "If MIDEM wants to remain a showcase for legitimate

business, it has got to address some of the problems which have surfaced."

Garnett also said that IFPI would be prepared to assist if asked by MIDEM. He described the events as "disappointing."

Phonomatic Group MD Wilhelm Mittrich justified Sound Solutions issuing of an unlicensed CD. "We compiled with GEMA's instructions and offered to pay them in advance. They didn't get back to us within 20 days of the application. It is quite customary that record companies start manuafter application. facturing GEMA usually takes two to three months to issue an invoice and a licence. A record company should not be punished for the inefficiency of collection societies.'

One record company executive confirmed that it was normal for major record labels to manufacture and ship before a licence is granted, but only because they are covered by blanket agreements. Phonomatic is not covered by such a deal.

Editor's note: at presstime M&M learned that the French court has ordered Tring to be reinstated to the MIDEM exhibition on Thursday, January 28.

nevik. After several months of negotiations, the last details were finalised on January 22, giving the Kinnevik concern a minority share-holding in the station and a stronger position in the Danish

market

MD at Kinnevik's media company Medvik Jorgen Widsell says, "We own a minority share in the company, but we have a 50% influence. It is our intention to get a bigger grip on the Danish market and this will help us to do that."

With a 20% share in Norway's first national commercial radio station P4 and a stake in The Voice, including the satellite network The Voice Of Scandinavia, Kinnevik has now positioned itself ready to set-up a Pan-European network. Widsell comments, "We are in a unique position. There is so much that is happening right now with radio and in the future I believe that the Scandinavian radio market will increase its marketing importance."

The Voice MD Otto Reedtz-Thott is content with the deal and comments, "We were looking for a strong economically stable partner and we feel that we've found that with Kinnevik. Both parties have made a good deal and we will be co-operating fully with our new partner."

The deal follows a troubled year for The Voice. Besides the many legal battles the station has had for breaking the Danish ban on networking, in early '92 Klaus Petersen, a 50% shareholder in The Voice, filed for bankruptcy. media companies Several expressed interest in buying Petersen's share, including the owners of Radio Uptown--Egmont. Industry sources say that following Petersen's bankruptcy, the authorities seized his assets, leaving The Voice Group with a cash problem. The Group decided to extend its capital, resulting in Reedtz-Thott becoming 98% shareholder of the Voice, leaving Petersen with just 2%

The Voice is also rumoured to have huge debts, including around Dk12 million and over 10 times that amount in long-term debts.

industries to work more closely together. "This may be the event that wipes out all [radio] programmes."

UK concert promoter Harvey Goldsmith agrees especially with regards to the technology's impact on the record industry. "We are witnessing the death knell of the [music] industry, and DMX is the first straw," he said. "Forget radio; forget records. All you need is the technology."

The launch of DMX in Europe has also prompted music industry trade group **IFPI** to step up its activities. Director general **Nic**

Garnett has scheduled a London meeting to discuss royalty payments with DMX. IFPI wants to begin the negotiations because there currently is no law covering the digital transmission of music by such services.

On the radio side, Europe 1 director of programmes Patrice Blanc-Francard was more simple but direct. "Satellite and digital radio will change the playing field," he said.

Despite some of the doom and gloom scenarios about digital cable/satellite radio's impact, Tim Blackmore, programme director at pan-European radio syndicator Unique Broadcasting stressed that the value-added aspect of

local radio is a potent weapon in combatting DMX and similar services. That focus on specialized, local markets is something Oberstein agrees on as well. "Record companies are exactly like radio companies in this very important aspect. We are both looking for targeted niche audiences."

Attendance at MIDEM '93 was claimed to be at 8700, 340 more than last year, representing 2285 companies (compared to 2159 the year before) and 69 countries. UK company participation was the biggest with 1674 registered firms, slightly ahead of France with 1664.

EHR Embraces Jagger

Since the beginning of this year, Whitney Houston's I Will Always Love You has continuously been breaking its own records and this week is no exception as she books a total of 136 stations (128 last week), including 111 A lists (107 last week)—yet another set of M&M records.

EHR treats Mick Jagger to a very warm welcome. Added onto 36 playlists at the same time, his Sweet Thing qualifies as this week's Most Added. Jagger's new song also tears into the EHR Top 40 with a vengeance, arriving at number 8 in one go! This makes it a serious candidate for the highest entry of the year—last year's winner, Madonna's Erotica, also entered at 8. Sweet Thing is being played throughout all European countries, but performs its best penetration in Austria and Sweden (88-100%), followed by Denmark, the UK and Holland (57-62%). No less than 12% of its roster concerns "powerplay" exposure, a quite remarkable proportion.

Another high entry this week (at number 15) is booked by the Beloved, whose Sweet Harmony, their first single to chart on this page, is already top 10 in the Regional EHR Top 20 in the Northwest and the South.

The biggest chart jump of the week, both in terms of chart points and positions, is achieved by **Duran Duran**, who storm into the top 10 with a 16-position leap, grabbing the number 9 spot. Closely following Jagger with 35 first-time reports, their *Ordinary World* is also the second most added record of the week. In the Northwest, the song is already number 2, thanks to a very high penetration in the UK (86%). Other territories where the record is faring well include Denmark, Switzerland, Sweden and Austria (50-67%). The rest of Europe is next in line; only France hasn't joined in yet. **Faith No More**'s version of *I'm Easy* is also moving fast; it crashes into the top 10, just below Duran Duran. *I'm Easy* is expanding its roster with 23 stations, notably in Belgium, Norway, Denmark, Portugal and Germany. Currently, it enjoys its best airplay in Portugal, the UK, Holland, Norway and Sweden (50-100%).




Marrying Music & Marketing

On March 1 1993, **Creastars Europe - one of** Belgium's most active and creative production units - will have seen three years of experimenting and pioneering, three years of scanning the market's possibilities and restrictions, three years and eight Top 3 hits in Belgium as a part of their three-year deal with EMI Belgium as their dance label.

Creastars Europe was founded by Peter Vanderhallen and Jean Bosiers, combining artistic back-grounds with sales and marketing expertise. Vanderhallen worked as a club DJ before he actually owned a club, started producing records and founded the band Confetti's, Belgium's million-selling ambassadors of New Beat. Bosiers achieved high repute as marketing manager in the fast-consumer goods field (Maes Pils beer, Pepsi Cola and 7-Up)."I had the feeling that things in the record industry weren't going like they should", remembers Vanderhallen, "and when eight times out of ten a record failed to catch on with large audiences, artists found themselves in a situation in which they had to find the cause of the failure. Vanderhallen wanted to be sure that people at least had the chance to listen to what he released. "We wanted to create a buzz, make the record jump out of the

The record companies Vanderhallen worked with before hardly did anything more than releasing records. In search of financial support for the shooting of Confetti's *The Sound of C*-video, he came in touch with Bosiers, and after a short, tough discussion, Bosiers agreed to spend his first music sponsoring budget on the project. return we would generate for the 7-Up brand," says Bosiers, "and we continued to work out campaigns with multinational brands like Pepsi, Panasonic and BiFi (Unilever) to support Confetti's."From that point, Vanderhallen and Bosiers knew they had to create their own record company, picking up the work where most other record companies ended the job. Instead of the regular pep talk in the weekly promo meeting, where sometimes promising talent is hidden between some 17 other releases, Vanderhallen and Bosiers were determined to update the whole process. "Today we see that the regular policy sometimes worked out well in the recent hoom-period in Belgium, but with single sales dropping, one definitely needs new strategies," explains Bosiers.

THE FIVE KEY PRINCIPLES TO SUCCESS

1) Although they operate under one roof, the artistic department, headed by Vanderhallen, works completely separate from Bosiers' marketing and administration section. "The reason is very simple," explains Vanderhallen. "When I talk to an artist, we discuss his 'baby', his song. My office very often is a messy situation where artists run in and out and call for numerous reasons. We created a 'team spirit' working environment," he adds. "The artist, producer and manager have to feel at home with our company. We try to 'create' music by handing over a demo of a song to different Creastars production teams, each specialised in their

harmony of the target audience. Belowthe-line and advertising campaigns are set up and detonated both with record retailers and clubs as well as with the sponsoring brand's own specific sales network. "For us, those companies are the only possible way to achieve full attention to the products created by our artists," explains Bosiers. Vanderhallen adds,"We want to be able to look straight in the artist's eyes if something should go wrong, prooving that we have done everything possible to break his record."

3) In full co-ordination with EMI Belgium, Creastars Europe also kicked off its own promo department - enthusiasts who have time to work thoroughly on new artists' single releases, who during the weekend work as DJ's and thus can position the company's new releases within today's music scene. On top of this job, those staffers have to be able to deal with a wide variety of sponsorship campaigns. National media and retailers are not accustomed to driving to a French "château" in the champagneregion of Epernay to witness the presentation of a new artist's debut single, to be invited for a

weekend in a Dutch "Gran Dorado" holiday resort for an introduction to a new album or to share delicious tropical Passoa cocktails while at work listening to a new Creastars product.

4) "Moreover, sales-teams have to be given something extra to stimulate record sales: giveaways, merchandising and collector's items help retailers boost their sales.

These below-the-line campaigns should bring back fun into the record stores," advocates Bosiers. He's also convinced that those activities will strengthen the ties between media, retailers and Creastars

Europe: he wants to rebuild confidence between the parties involved and thinks that, in doing so, a platform could be created to solve imminent problems such as the dropping singles market.

5) Creastars Europe also secures touring sponsorship in clubs and supports club dates for its artists, international brands like Safari (United Distiflers). Lucky Strike tobacco and Martini. In 1993, Creastars Europe ignites the first Coca mega-disco Cola ideal shows. an opportunity for the

company's artists, producers and dancers to proove themselves in front of club-DJs, club-owners and their audiences. The current collaboration also allows producers to write and compose show music for the sponsoring brands, for use in commercials.

BELGIAN TALENT WITH AN INTERNATIONAL FUTURE

BB JEROME & THE BANG GANG were the first successful act to be signed by Creastars Europe - promising young rappers, street kids from the Brussels ghettos, for whom Bosiers arranged a sponsorship deal with L.A.Gear. "Their 'streethiking'line perfectly matched the idea behind BB Jerome & The Bang Gang" explains Bosiers, adding that Creastars were also instrumental in launching identical campaigns in different European countries. The band had three Belgian number 1 singles and their debut album outsold material from Vanilla Ice there. Abroad their single Shock Rock sold extremely well in Canada, Japan and Scandinavia. A new album is set for release in the summer of

Today, one of Belgium's top-selling bands are the **DINKY TOYS**, launched in the summer off 1991, when EMI Music Publishing Belgium general manager **Guido Janssens** handed over a couple of the band's demos to Vanderhallen. After having it remixed the single *My Day Will Come* took the Belgian charts by storm./Bosiers then teamed up with Lucky Strike to sponsor some 30 Dinky Toys gigs. "The single was released in midsummer of 1991, not the best timing, indeed," admits Vanderhallen, "but we had the shows backing the record."

To prevent the Dinky Toys from becoming a "one-day wonder", Bosiers signed a worldwide sponsorship deal with jeans manufacturer **Lois**. "The band's second single *One More Try* was backed by a huge campaign with both leisure wear retailers and record shops which boosted the band's image. In addition,

and under the impulse of the band's manager Luc Standaert, Creastars Europe concluded a deal with internationally known Belgian fashion designer Walter Van Beirendonck to create a Dinky Toys clothing collection, based on Lois leisure wear."After three Top 3 singles and the band's debut album The Colour of Sex going platinum in Belgium, Creastars Europe worked out a deal with Italian independent New Music to release two Dinky Toys singles in Italy (featured on the soundtrack of the country's major film-production "A Lupo A Lupo"). This deal inspired Lois to set up a brand-new distribution network there.

BUTTERFLY & BASTIX are one of the newest additions to the Creastars Europe team. In addition to the preparation of the release of an album in their own right (full of jazz, latin, funk and hip hop influences), the two all-round artists have had a huge success as pioneers of the acid-jazz scene in Belgium. Their live gigs got rave reviews and their

'TBX's debut album *Delirious* was launched during an impressive threeday stay at the Gran Dorado holiday resort on the Dutch coastal side in October 1992. The album, written by Belgian dance music innovator Jo Casters and produced by Ludo Camberlin, includes a number of guest appearances and became an immediate radio-must on the national stations. The band's single *Inspire Me* cracked the Belgian Top 15.

BAD INFLUENCE is to become one of the first highlights on the recently launched Crea-Rock label. The band's first single included a Harley Davidson competition and the idea to link up the band with the famous motorcycle created a substantial extra audience broadening the market. "But THE NILE, a group headed by soulful Eric Baranyanka, is aiming at yet another target audience. Creastars Europe is currently on the lookout for the right producer to translate Baranyanka's energy as a live performer on CD.

Ready to sign a worldwide sponsorship deal with a major company for BC, Creastars Europe is preparing the international launch of this "master of the beats". As a writer, composer, excellent dancer, producer and studio wizard, BC is undoubtedly heading towards a platinum future.
