### Impressive line-up for Fenoulhet's Palladium bandleading season

AFTER their big success, appearing for eight days with Gracie Fields at the Empress Hall, Earls Court, Paul Fenoulhet and his new orchestra commence another auspicious engagement on Monday next (6th), when they take over for a month at the London Palladium while the Skyrokers Orchestra tours with Danny Kaye.

### ANDREWS SISTERS FORCED TO CANCEL PALLADIUM TRIP

A MOST unfortunate misunderstanding—unfortunate for both the performers as well as the public they were coming to entertain—has forced the Andrews Sisters to cancel their scheduled engagement at the London Palladium and British provincial music-halls this July.

### DATES DILEMMA

Talking to Maxine Anderson and her former husband, the Trio's manager, music-publishing, Lou Levy (writing *Swear! Allez!*), it learnt that everything had been arranged for the Palladium engagement by the sponsors of the tour, but they were unable to fulfil on the air during July.

After the girls had cancelled the tour, the radio sponsors related and said the girls could be free to accept the London engagement. This, however, had already been filled by Val Porter, who they shared for the New York City. Then the Palladium said they would not release them, but their contract.

Since the girls have to date in Hollywood for the autumn series of "Crosby" when they share with Bob Gray and Jerry Gray's Orchestra, they were unable to accept the Palladium booking later in the season. Val Porter, their manager, and Maxine and Paul, their British friends, and the Skyrokers, who they will not now be seeing this season.

### Eric Winstone is welcomed back from Bermuda with 50-minute broadcast

IT IS interesting to note that the Christmas Eve broadcast of the British Broadcasting Corporation, which was the first of an extensive holiday tour of Europe.

Jack Smith, of course, is the popular solo horn whose daily Jack Smith Show is broadcast on the radio. He is also a well-known composer, conductor, and arranger, and was featured on the radio as a soloist on the Christmas Eve broadcast.

Both Smith and De Vol were featured for Capitol records, while Jack conducts the orchestra for the show and arranges all his recordings. While in London the two were to hear as many new British records as possible and to bring many of them back to the States.

During the season at the Palladium the orchestra will be augmented by the string section of the Skyrokers Orchestra, which will not be going to tour.

### STAR SINGERS

The two vocalists with the orchestra, who will not, of course, appear at the London Palladium, are top-line singer Dick James and Marie Moser, top-line crooner Australian girl who has been featured with top-line vocalists.

After their four weeks at the Palladium, Paul Fenoulhet and the orchestra have various dates, concerts and broadcasts scheduled, including two weeks at Green's Playhouse Ballroom, Glasgow, commencing on August 22, and a broadcast in "Band Box" from 1.15 to 3 p.m. each on August 22 and 23.

To save rehearsal and the chance of accumulation errors, Paul Fenoulhet has arranged the instrumentation of the Skyrokers Orchestra to guest-conduct at the London Palladium, July 4, when they return to the London Palladium, and the middle of the short season being played by the famous Dixie band, the Marx Brothers—whose last concert, have been launched there on the recommendation of Paul Fenoulhet's orchestra.

CONSEQUENT upon the departure of Bill Griffith to join the new Sydney Lipton Orchestra, the position of first Fred Berlini has taken over Bill's old position of first trumpet with the orchestra. Fred, who has played with many of the country's most notable bands, has had two previous spells with Stapleton, and recalls his old boss with a great deal of affection and respect.

### HEATH FOR SPANISH HOLIDAY

AFTER a busy season, Ted A. Heath and his boys are to take a well-earned summer holiday following the conclusion of their work in variety at the Kingston Empire (starting June 20).

Currently at Green's Playhouse Ballroom, Glasgow, the band will be touring the country with one-night stands, etc., until the Kingston week is played.

Heath is spending interesting holidays abroad, following the example of their leader, who is spending his time in the States. Heath will be enjoying a motoring holiday in Spain.

The band comes together again, and the Heath Music, as already announced, will be touring the country commencing July 18.

During the Blackpool season, the boys will be spending some hectic hours appearing for concert parties at the Blackpool Grand, and at the Morecambe on the first Sunday, when they will be playing for three nights, a special place is being chartered to fly the whole outfit over to Blackpool.

Back in Town, their first date will be in variety again at the Blackpool Empire (August 22). They are on tour with their new programme and Shepherd's Bush Empire on September 19.

This annual showcase of the profession has become such an institution, because of its opportunity of seeing and hearing Britain's most famous bands, and also because of its genuinely charitable nature, that this announcement will be met with great and widespread interest.

The Musicians' Social and Benevolent Council, the organisers of this great event, make a special point, however, of asking readers to refrain from writing until they are told. No seats will be reserved at this early stage, and full details will appear well in advance of the date that will enable Musicians' Social readers to apply for their tickets in plenty of time.

All the proceeds of the annual Jazz Jamboree go to the Musicians' Union Benevolent Funds, and last year the magnificent sum of £2,498 was handed over by the M.S.C.

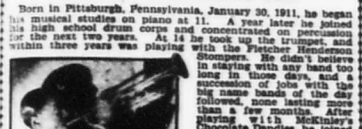
