WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Turn off the "vacancy" sign at the FCC Chairman's office. Reed Hundt sailed through last Wednesday's Senate committee confirmation hearing, and is expected to do the same in the full Senate. Long-time Commissioner Jim Quello has been holding down the fort for several months.

ELSEWHERE

There must have been something in the water this week, as happy brokers have helped to engineer a slew of new duopolies:

Charleston's Dixie Communications has had their eye on their AC competitor, Faircom's WSSX-FM for a while now, but couldn't have it because they're already at the maximum of four stations (WSUY, WTMZ, WTNA, and WDXZ). But there's more than one way to skin a cat, so they swapped (with additional cash) WDXZ for WSSX-FM. So, to the average listener Mix 104.5 (WDXZ) moves down to WSSX-FM's 95.1 frequency, which will be known as Mix 95.1.

This left Faircom owning WDXZ, which they immediately spun off to LowCountry Media, who own WQIZ and WBUB Mt. Pleasant (Bubba 107). LowCountry then blew up WDXZ by changing the format to country, the call letters to WJUK, and calling it Jukebox 104.5.

This arrangement, however, poses a problem because Faircom had been LMA'ing CHR WSSP Goose Creek (Fly 94), and its simulcasting sister WUJM, from Jones Eastern. So, since neither LowCountry or Dixie can take on another LMA, Jones Eastern returns to programming its own station, and drops its CHR format for SMN's Stardust.

An interesting note here, WUJM was technically not part of the duopoly with WSSX, but was simulcasting anyway because it was in a separate LMA with a local group that was doing a very good all news format, but this LMA fell apart some time ago.

In Chicago, Cox Broadcasting will pair its classic rock WCKG with Beasley's AC/album rock WYSY-FM (Y-108) for \$9 million. Beasley intends to get out of the market, as it will sell its sister, WBIG to McNaughton stations, who will have their own duopoly with WJKL/WRMN.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

Several sets of three letter calls have gone by the wayside this year in favor of more "meaningful" monikers, but this week, we get to add a set back in. EZ Communications has announced plans to buy KUSA and KSD-FM St. Louis from Gannett, and will move the two stations into their KYKY location. Gannett will retain the KUSA call letters, so the new calls for 550 kHz will be KSD (AM).

Prism Radio Partners is working on a duopoly in the Raleigh-Durham market. It has closed on its purchase of classic rocker WZZU Burlington NC from the Village Companies, and will soon pair it with CHR outlet WOCG Durham, which it has now LMA'd from the Durham Herald. Prism also has an option to buy WOCG's news/talk sister, WDNC Durham.

In Austin, Clear Channel's KPEZ and KHFI-FM have entered into a sales only LMA with Mercury Broadcasting's KFON and KEYI-FM. The combined 12+ total week numbers for these four stations from the Spring book adds up to a powerful 21.8 share. Over in Corpus Christi, Broad Based Communications' KDAE & KLTG have entered into a full LMA agreement with Coastal Bend Radio Active's KXCC Rockport TX. With the LMA, KXCC turns to classic rock, and blankets the market with an upgrade to 50,000 watts.

In Nashville, Capstar's WSIX-FM combines with Legacy's WYHY through an LMA putting the combo at nearly a 21 share 12+.

Infinity strikes again, this time in Washington DC by buying a fourth station from Cook-Inlet Radio Partners. WPGC-AM Morningside MD & WPGC-FM Washington will combo with WJFK-FM Manassas VA, giving them the most powerful ratings combo in the market. The \$60 million deal may also make it a bit easier to syndicate WPGC-FM's Donnie Simpson through Infinity-managed Unistar, which has been in the works for a while.

Quick as a wink, even though Radio Livingston's brand new WYNQ Avon NY (Rochester) started off last week as simulcasting news/talk sister WYSL, it's switched to easy listening and has entered into an LMA-to-buy with The Lincoln Group's WHAM and WVOR-FM. Lincoln's combo already has about a 20 share. Since the FCC cap is 25.0, adding a new station which, obviously, has no ratings yet will keep the duopoly legal.

EZ Communications is trading up in Sacramento, announcing its purchase of Nationwide Communications country outlet KNCI, which means EZ will have to spin off its young country KQBR Davis CA in order to comply with the duopoly rules. Nationwide's press release on the transaction referred to 3.2 kw KQBR as its "lowpower" FM: both KRAK & KRAK-FM are 50 kw. So is KNCI.

With the onset of fall, it's shopping season for Salem Communications. A couple of weeks ago, Salem announced it was buying Jerry Lee's WBEB (formerly WFIL) Philadelphia. Then CLG Media's KHIH Denver was next to fall. Now Salem has announced they'll combo KHIH with long-time religion formatted KRKS Denver. KHIH's new age/jazz format was rescued by Noble Broadcasting's KHOW-FM this week, which will drop its AC format. Noble also owns KBCO AM & FM Boulder.

The American Sports Radio Network will be broadcasting the Las Vegas, Peach, and Senior Bowls this year. If you're interested in carrying them, call (800) 800-8852. Unistar is offering "Paul Simon, 1964-1993" to air over the Thanksgiving weekend on CD to the top 170 Arbitron markets. Call (800) 225-3270 for info.

THE ANNUAL M STREET FORMAT TRACK

M Street takes a look at the format activity over the past year, tabulates it, and graphs its progress. Over the course of the next three weeks, we'll break out these numbers, and give you some insight into the year's format trends. This week we'll look at how the formats rank among all U.S. stations.

Country continues to dominate the charts, breaking the 2,600 station mark this year. Although AC is second, it has slipped by about 80 stations since 1992. While the biggest gainer of the year is News/Talk/Sports/Business, up almost 250 stations over last year, CHR has slid proportionally, down approx. 140 during the same period. Even though News/Talk, Adult Standards, Spanish, Gospel, Ethnic, and the Pre-Teen formats continue to favor the AM band, almost all of the formats, with the exception of Gospel and Southern Gospel, are picking up more FM stations than AM.

ELSEWHERE

It seems that the sample hike approved by Arbitron subscribers may have to wait till next Spring. Inside Radio reports Arbitron may delay the start of the 70% sample hike plan because, believe it or not, unreturned subscriber contract addenda are holding up the process.

Westwood One, Inc. and Infinity Broadcasting Corporation have signed a letter of intent for the purchase by Westwood One of the radio network business of Unistar Radio Networks, Inc. for approximately \$101.3 million. Mel Karmazin, Infinity/Unistar Chief Executive Officer, will also become the CEO of Westwood One. Westwood One Chairman and Chief Executive Officer, Norman Pattiz will remain Chairman of the Board of Westwood One after the Unistar acquisition. In connection with the transactions, Infinity will acquire 5 million newly issued shares of common stock of Westwood One for \$3.00 per share with the option to purchase an additional 3 million shares at the same price, subject to certain vesting requirements (read performance). Closing of the deal is expected in first quarter of 1994, pending legal matters.

After a little digging by Inside Radio, the Research Group, which has been Unistar-owned since the Transtar days, will become a separate entity owned in part by Infinity and partner Chase Manhattan Bank. Infinity will continue it's "no involvement" policy. Westwood-owned Radio & Records newspaper is still for sale.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

The NAACP's South Carolina branch has settled its license challenge against Ogden Broadcasting's WGSN & WNMB North Myrtle Beach by accepting the legal fees plus a donation of \$1,750 per semester for minority scholarships at two local colleges. R&R reports that Ocean Drive Communications, which is buying the combo has agreed to make an effort to attract minority applications for a 22% minority response to job openings by 1997.

Promomedios Radio Network has announced preliminary plans to purchase Spanish Information Service. SIS is a sub-division of Texas State Networks. Promomedios is a Mexican-based company who owns and/or represents more than 70 radio stations in Mexico. SIS will continue to operate out of Dallas, Texas and has plans to extend to a 24 hour music and entertainment format.

Select Music Systems has purchased SoundServe, Inc., states Radio Business Report. Select operates "MusicLink," which allows stations to market music to their listeners through a toll-free number. Listeners can purchase any "in print" CD or cassette and only need to give a song title to the MusicLink sales rep to identify The service is available to stations on a format-exclusive basis throughout the country. ALL market sizes may apply.

There'll be yet another morning show entering the syndication arena. WFBQ-FM has signed morning men Bob Kevoian and Tom Griswold to a new six year contract starting January 1, which includes syndication. Availability dates were not announced.

The Christmas Music Network has expanded its hours of Adult Contemporary satellite-delivered material in 1993. The AC web is music-intensive and showcases both Christmas "classics" and the very latest releases. It is structured to sound locally originated. Each hour has about 20 songs with only four stop sets--two network and two local. The net is market-exclusive on a first-come, first-served basis. Full details and a demo tape are available by calling them at (800) 423-XMAS.

Don't be fooled by this fledgling network's name. The NewYork Talk Network is now featuring "Upstate All Night," an overnight talk show hosted by Jack Mindy and is available only outside New York City. Call them at (716) 381-3700 for more information.

Week two of the M Street format tally reveals the big increase on AM this year is news/talk which jumps from 13.4 % last year to 17.5 % share of the band this year. Adult Standards moves into the number four slot, overtaking religion. Southern Gospel jumps three notches from #11 to #8 this year on the AM band. On FM, although CHR remains in the number three spot, it's dropped from 9.3 % of the FM band down to 7.1%. Country remains dominant, moving from 20.3 % to 22.1 %. Children's programming made its debut this year on the FM band.

ARBITRON DROPS TV, RADIO TO STAY INTACT If you thought LMA's and duopolies were throwing a few people on the street in your market, imagine how the entire Arbitron television staff of 700 is feeling about now. A handful have been reassigned to the radio division. There is some good news for small and medium sized radio markets out of all of this. Arbitron President Steve Morris announced plans to roll out a new qualitative product emphasizing psychographics and consumption habits in markets 56+. It's currently being tested in five markets, and should become available early next year.

FCC FIELD OFFICE PHILOSOPHY IS JUST FINE Even though Infinity is entrenched in the alleged "selective enforcement" battle with the Commission, the fines you may not have heard about total almost \$60,000 this week. The FCC field offices were busy in Texas and California, and may be coming to a station near you. Complete details start on page 6.

AM DUOPOLY MAKES NEWS IN DENVER After Jacor's announcement this week that the company gearing up to buy more stations with a public offering of 4.75 million shares of stock, its Denver news/talk powerhouse KOA will purchase Genesis Broadcasting's KRZN, which will switch to news/talk from its current standards format sometime after the official start of the LMA on November 1st. WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Infinity Broadcasting drew the line in the sand this week with the FCC, calling their "selective enforcement" of their indecency standards unconstitutional. Infinity faces heavy fines, \$500,000, cited against some of their stations for airing allegedly indecent segments of the Howard Stern show. Infinity pointed to other stations that aired the same programming at the same time, stating that they were not fined for the same alleged infractions of the rule, but made it clear that they didn't point this out so the other stations would be fined. Meanwhile, Al Westcott, the person who made the initial complaints about Stern, has filed another complaint against Infinity, et al, regarding Stern's alleged implied use of the "seven dirty words."

Pine Tree Media may lose its license and be fined up to \$250,000, pending a FCC hearing, for filing a license renewal on behalf of someone who had died three months earlier. Pine Tree won't disclose how or who controls the property. The FCC is also getting tough with those stations that haven't reported being silent. The Commission has threatened both WDTL Cleveland MS and WYNO Nelsonville OH with \$250,000 fines for being dark beyond FCC authorization.

The FCC Field Offices have gone on a "all you can fine" spree and issued Notices of Apparent Liability for violating FCC rules. The reasons included: EBS (equipment missing, weekly test not made or logged, no Authenticator list), Public inspection file missing of incomplete, Remote control operation (equipment not working, meters not calibrated), overpower operation, antenna current meter missing, Antenna base current ratios deviated excessively, operators (not licensed, licenses not posted, & unable to observe the required meters), antenna fence not locked, and equipment performance measurements not made.

ELSEWHERE

Arbitron will discontinue its syndicated local market television and cable ratings service as of January 1, 1994 due to lack of resources and demand. Apparently, it has been losing money on the venture for years. With help from former Birch execs. Bill Engel and Bill Livek, the company plans to redirect its efforts and resources into local market qualitative services for local tv, cable and radio which have already taken effect in five test markets (watch for previews during the January 1994 NATPE convention). Expect availability in up to 25 markets by mid 1994. Although, Arbitron's radio audience measurement remains unaffected, the same can not be said about approximately 733 of Arbitron employees.

Clear Channel has entered into a letter of intent to purchase KEBC/Oklahoma City OK from Independence Broadcasting Company for \$7.5 million cash. The acquisition is subject to signing of a definitive agreement and approval of the FCC. As of the Spring 1993 book KTOK/KJYO/KEBC would have a 24.3 share but the Summer 1993 book brings them to a 29 share. The question now falls to if the FCC will approve at this time.

NPR, as of October 1st, has been providing NPR News programs to Europe via the Astra Satellite by the World Radio Network. "Morning Edition", "All Things Considered", "Weekend Edition/Saturday & Sunday", Horizons" and "Living on Earth" feeds are provided with the possibility for National Press Club and other live news coverage to be added to the schedule.

"The Exxit", a new syndicated modern rock format from Major Networks will be available starting December 1. The 24-hour format was designed and is still consulted by Shawn Alexander - R&R's Modern Rock editor.

Unistar has named Art Salisch new research manager. Art worked for Major Market Radio, Christal, WABC/WPLJ and was senior client service rep for Arbitron before joining Unistar.

Since our annual format track began back in 1989, this is the first year we've been able to give you a five year format trend for both commercial and non-commercial stations. News, Talk, Sports, and Business has jumped over 500 stations in the commercial band, and 180 in the non-commercial band since 1989. CHR has plummeted, and AC is steadily off. Religion, which encompasses teaching, contemporary Christian, and all gospel formats, has enjoyed steady growth in both commercial and non-commercial segments.

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER. Well, it only took ten years, but the Commission has finally adopted an AM stereo standard: Motorola's C-Quam. Actually, this is the second standard they picked after the Magnavox debacle in the early 80's. The decision comes at a point where many believe it is too late for AM stereo to have a meaningful consumer impact. On a sidenote, after Japanese manufacturers have been saying for years that there was no market for AM Stereo radios. In Japan, they've now reversed that decision and begun mass production after their government adopted the same standard this year.

DUOPOLY UPDATE... For those of you keeping score, you may need another legal pad this week. In addition to the Group W/Viacom swap in Houston and Washington DC, Evergreen picks up one in San Francisco, Clear Channel and Metroplex merge, Fuller-Jeffrey and Precision Media Corp each with one in Dover-Portsmouth-Rochester NH, Heritage adds one in Milwaukee, and a two-level LMA in Roanoke-Lynchburg round out the week's activity. WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Infinity has hit the end of the line at the FCC. In 1988, they were fined \$6,000 for Howard Stern's Christmas Party skit, which has been through all of the appeals possible at the Commission. The FCC upheld the fines this week. Now Infinity must either pay the fines, or go to court.

Minnesota Public Radio has been granted a rare waiver from FCC rules for it to air a 35-hour radiothon to help raise money for the Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra. The Commission granted permission to KSJN Minneapolis to lift their non-commercial status for two days on October 29 and 30. The for-profit SPCO has been battered by management problems and labor disputes. The radiothon hopes to raise enough money to help make it through the end of the fiscal year.

The Commission has designated for hearing four separate applications for a new fm on 97.9 MHz in Whitesboro NY. The four are Frank B. Duross, New Horizons Broadcasting Partnership, Kenneth F. Roser, Jr., and Kevin O'Kane.

Three applicants for a new FM on 104.7 MHz in Mansfield LA will go to hearing. They are DeSoto Broadcasting Corp., Cary D. Camp, and Mitchell Tyner.

The NAACP was shot down in its challenge of the renewal application of WYRK Buffalo NY. They alleged the station violated EEO rules and policies. In its decision, the FCC noted the station should ensure its recruitment records are complete, but no facts were found to warrant a hearing.

ELSEWHERE

Now, let's sort out the duopoly action this week.

The fallout from duopoly consolidation continues as a total of 34 staffers, 19 at KIKK Pasadena/KIKK-FM Houston TX and 15 at WCPT Alexandria VA/WCXR Woodbridge VA (Washington DC), are on the streets after Viacom and Group W swapped properties to the tune of \$80 million. In Washington, Viacom now operates WCPT/WCXR and WMZQ Arlington VA/WMZQ-FM Washington DC, while Group W adds KIKK AM/FM to KILT AM/FM in Houston.

Clear Channel Communications announced this week it shelled out \$54 million to put together a non-brokered deal with Metroplex to merge the two companies. This transaction will give Clear Channel 38 stations in 22 markets, spawning duopolies in Tampa (WMTX Pinellas Park/WMTX-FM Clearwater and WRBQ St. Petersburg/WRBQ-FM Tampa) and Miami (WHYI Fort Lauderdale and WAXY Fort Lauderdale, which is currently LMA'd from Ackerly Communications), and an LMA in Buffalo (WWWS and WUFX, both Buffalo).

Evergreen has entered into a letter of agreement to pick up KIOI San Francisco from Bay Broadcasting, which is a division of Fairmont Communications for \$45 million cash. Evergreen will couple K-101 with their recently purchased KMEL.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

In the Portsmouth-Dover-Rochester NH market, Precision Media, who owns WZNN and WWEM Rochester NH, will pick up WMYF and WERZ Exeter NH from Bear Broadcasting for a little over \$1 million. Bear also owned WXBB Kittery ME, but is selling that off to Fuller-Jeffrey Broadcasting, who owns WOKQ Dover, for \$1 million.

Heritage Media will pick up a third station in Milwaukee to combo with WEMP/WMYX. Multimedia's WEZW is in an LMA with them until the sale is approved. Price was not disclosed.

DNA testing may be necessary to identify what's really happening here, but in Roanoke/Lynchburg, the Virginia Network has entered into an LMA-to-buy WXYU and WJJS Lynchburg VA. Interestingly enough, they're also in an LMA-to-buy WVLR Appomattox VA, which gives them a duopoly when it closes, but WVLR is in an LMA with WVRV Lynchburg VA, which will be assumed by WXYU/WJJS creating a two-tiered LMA.

Three out of six stations in Annapolis MD are now under one roof. Sequel Broadcasting, who owns WNAV, is picking up WYRE Annapolis and WXZL Grasonville MD for \$1.9 million. They're in an LMA until the sale is approved.

In the fallout from the announcement last week that Arbitron is getting out of the TV business, they've closed the San Francisco office. Of the dozen or so people there, only two were in the radio division and are moving to the L.A. office. FYI, clients in the Pacific Northwest should now contact the L.A. office.

If you thought next year's fall NAB show (how can we call it the radio show anymore) had too many conferences going on at once, try NAB 1994: the mother of all conventions. The eleven conferences include the Television Bureau of Advertising Annual Marketing Conference, Television Management Conference, Radio Management Conference, Broadcasters Law and Regulation Conference, Broadcast Engineering Conference, Society of Broadcast Engineers Day, Radio Advertising Bureau Marketing and Sales Conference, Broadcast Education Association Convention, the SMPTE Post Experience, and the Digital Transmission Tutorial. The convention is March 20-24 in Las Vegas and will be featuring the latest innovations in communications and will feature the NAB HDTV Production Conference as well as 10other stand alone conferences and over one hundred TV, audio, computer and multimedia exhibits. Will they put in a call to the Shriner's next?

Roy Hampton Park, founder and Chairman of Park Communications, died Monday of cardiac arrest. He was actively engaged in the management of his companies until days before his death. Park owns 22 radio stations, eight TV stations and 144 newspapers. The funeral was held Friday, October 29 at the First Presbyterian Church in Ithaca, NY. In lieu of flowers, those wishing to contribute, should do so to their own favorite charity.

Joshua Fry, WPGC Morningside MD's weekly market advisor and investment host, has been sued by the Securities and Exchange Commission for allegedly mishandling \$905,000 of investor's money. Two days before the SEC filed suit, Fry abandoned his radio program called "Exercise Your Options". Last Friday, 19 investors who said they had invested \$751,000 with Fry filed a class-action lawsuit against him. The class-action suit is separate from the SEC suit. In a Washington Post article dated October 28th, Steve Chaconas, WPGC's program director stated "It's not up to me to be out there checking up on these business people. I rely on the regulatory bodies". Chaconas also said the station has had very few problems, considering it has about 30 hosts.

Vallie/Gallup, the radio consulting and research partnership between Vallie Consulting, Inc. and the Gallup Organization, will add Jay Billie as general manager/radio research starting November 15th. Jay Billie was president of Billie Research and has 10 years experience with the Arbitron Company under his belt.
