GREAT COVERAGE. In an apparent turn-about, the FCC has approved plans to go ahead with Digital Audio Radio Services (DARS), a satellite-delivered national radio service. Auctions for the two available satellite channels are expected to be held by April 15. In a recent speech, FCC Chairman Reed Hundt was leaning toward opening up the bidding on the channels to more than the four companies who have fought for the service since day one. It now looks like only those four will be able to bid: CD Radio, Inc.; American Mobile Radio Corp.; Digital Broadcast Satellite Corp.; and Primosphere, L.P. Bidders have been put on notice that they may be subject to discounted political ads and other public service obligations if they win the channels.

GREAT SONGS. Jones Satellite Networks debuted it's tenth 24-hour music format "Classic Hit Country." The format concentrates on the hits from the '70's and '80's and includes artists such as Willie Nelson, Charlie Pride, Dolly Parton, George Strait, The Oak Ridge Boys, Merle Haggard, Conway Twitty, Hank Williams, Jr., Waylon Jennings and Alabama. Lew Jones has been named Operations Manager for the format. Jones will handle 11am-3pm shift for Classic Hit Country with Jim Murphy, 3pm-8pm, Mark McColl 8pm-1am and Cherokee Wells overnights. All times are eastern.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Justice Department reached a settlement with American Radio Systems that will allow the company to move forward on its \$655 million merger with EZ Communications. The settlement requires ARS to spin off two stations--in Sacramento, ARS will divest jazz KSSJ, Shingle Springs, CA, which will leave them with five FM's and two AM's and approximately one-third of the advertising pie there. In a like-kind exchange, it will swap WRFX, Charlotte for SFX Broadcasting's country WDSY-FM, Pittsburgh to satisfy DOJ requirements in Charlotte (see story in last week's Journal). ARS will have five FM's in Charlotte, as well, controlling about 40% of the revenue.

Joel Klein, who has been heading up the Department of Justice's efforts on looking at radio concentration and ownership, has been nominated by President Clinton to take the position for good. The nomination is for the position of Assistant Attorney General, Antitrust Division. Klein has been acting in the position since last October.

FCC Chairman Reed Hundt is under fire from several Senators after rumors that the Commission is working on a competitive analysis of the impact on the radio industry since deregulation. New Hampshire Senator Judd Gregg, who is Chairman of the Commerce and Judiciary Appropriations subcommittees, is upset that the FCC is doing the job of the Justice Department. Louisiana House Member Bill Tauzin is also curious. Both have fired off letters to Hundt asking him to explain if it reviews competitive impact on deals and mergers, how long it takes to approve transfers that are obviously within the new rules, and how it coordinates its efforts with the DOJ.

The license for Charles B. Moss, Jr.'s KRKE(AM) in Aspen, CO was canceled this week after being informed by Moss' counsel that Moss "will not appear and present evidence" in the proceeding to show cause why the license should not be revoked. KRKE has been off the air since May, 1993.

The Renewal grant for KCFX-FM, Inc.'s KCFX in Union, MO was rescinded by the Commission this week. No details were given.

Quality Broadcasting, Inc's WNEX(AM), Macon, GA was granted renewal of license by the Commission after a hearing to determine whether WNEX has the capability and intent to expeditiously resume broadcast operations and whether they intentionally violated the Commission's rule as applied to silent stations. WNEX(AM) suspended operations sometime between Aug. 1994 and July 1995 due to fire destroying the studio and several attacks of vandalism. Quality returned to air on Nov. 22, 1996 and has filed application to assign the license of the station to TM Communications, Inc.

Several applicants for mutually exclusive construction permits have requested waivers of the Commission's main studio rule this week which may conflict with other station applications or upgrades. The following applications have been designated for hearing to determine (a) the number of other reserved channel noncommercial education FM services available in the proposed service area of each applicant, and the area and population served thereby; (b) whether a share-time arrangement would result in the most effective use of the channel; and (c) which of the proposals would best provide a fair, efficient and equitable distribution of radio service:

--Public Broadcasting of Northwest OH, applicant for a new non-commercial educational FM station on 91.9 MHz in Defiance, seeks a waiver to operate as a satellite public radio transmitter from the existing studio location of WGTE-FM in Toledo, OH while Maranatha Christian Fellowship, Inc., applicant for 91.9 MHz in Howe, IN is requesting an upgrade from 3000 w, 298 ft to 6000 w, 305 ft.

--Pataphysical Broadcasting Foundation, applicant for 91.7 MHz in San Ardo, CA requests a waiver to operate the facility as a satellite repeater of KUSP, Santa Cruz, CA while Central Coast Educational Broadcasters, is an applicant for 91.3 MHz in King City, CA.

--Positive Alternative Radio, Inc., is an applicant for 88.1 MHz in Point Pleasant, WV while the University of WV on 88.1 MHz Huntington, WV, is requesting an upgrade from 1150 watts, -56 ft to 9000 w, -39 ft.

--American Family Association seeks a waiver for it's proposed facility on 88.1 MHz, Marksville, LA to operate as a satellite station of commonly-owned WAFR-FM in Tupelo MS while Educational Radio Foundation has a CP for Jena, LA at 88.1 MHz.

--Greater Washington Educ. Telecomms. Assoc. proposes to operate it's CP on 91.7 MHz in Leonardtown, MD as a satellite station of commonly owned WETA-FM, Washington, DC. while Columbia Union College Broadcasting's WGTS-FM, Takoma Park, MD has requested to change from 29500 w, 164 ft to 25000 w, 492 ft.

The Commission denied Petition for Reconsideration and motion to stay, filed by William Rogers' North Jefferson Broadcasting, Inc., licensee of Station WLBI(FM) in Warrior, AL proposing reinstatement of the dismissed allotment of 98.7 A to Cloverdale, AL. Opposition to the petition was filed by Deep South Broadcasting Co., licensee of station WBAM-FM in Montgomery, AL.

The Commission dismissed petition for partial reconsideration filed by LifeTalk Broadcasting Association of the Report and Order that allotted 97.1 A to Ukiah, CA. LifeTalk sought to have the allotment reserved for non-commercial use.

Near the middle of March, the Commission will be mailing renewal booklets for renewal of licenses of AM, FM, and FM translators in Arizona, Idaho, Nevada, New Mexico, Utah, Wyoming and translators only in Oklahoma and Texas. Corrections should be submitted no later than March 14. For more info, call Claudia Patterson at (202) 418-2784.

ELSEWHERE

American Radio Systems is picking up two more stations in the Bay Area by merging with Alta Broadcasting Company. It's spending \$4 million in cash and \$20 million in stock for hot AC KEZR, San Jose (serving San Jose and San Francisco) and AC KLUE, Soledad, CA (serving Monterey Bay/Salinas). The stations are sitting on real estate worth \$3.2 million. In San Francisco/San Jose, ARS owns standards KKSJ, soft AC KBAY, and rocker KSJO, all San Jose; and classic rock KUFX, Gilroy which serves all three markets.

Clear Channel Communications is spending \$20 million for Pinnacle Broadcasting's Raleigh-Durham properties. The stations are urban oldies WDUR, Durham, NC; and urban AC simulcast WFXC, Durham and WFXK, Tarboro, NC. The purchase will bring CCC's count to five there, as it owns urban WQOK, South Boston, NC and classic rock WZZU-FM, Fuquay-Varina, NC. Paul Leonard of Star Media Group was the broker.

Jacor is adding another station in Portland, OR to its three other stations it owns there. It's buying EXCL Communications' talker KOTK, Portland for \$8.3 million to combo with gold-based AC KEX; AC KKCW, Beaverton, OR; and CHR KKRZ. EXCL just purchased the station from Embarcadero Media.

Jacor Communications will get \$9 million by selling off another non-radio asset. It's agreed to sell its interest in Australia's Wonderland Partnership amusement park operator to Hartford Lane Pty. Limited. The money will be used for pending acquisitions.

Dick Harris is selling his last two stations to Saga Communications. Classical WFMR, Menomonee Falls, WI and jazz WFMI, Brookfield, WI, both serving Milwaukee, will fetch \$5 million for Harris, who is the former president of Westinghouse Broadcasting. Tony Rizzo of Blackburn & Company brokered the deal. Saga owns classic rock WKLH and rock combo WLZR-AM & FM.

Crawford Broadcasting is buying a second station in Detroit. It's religionformatted WEXL (AM), Royal Oak to combo with its FM, WMUZ, which also programs religion. Sparks Broadcasting will pick up \$3.5 million for the station.

MAK Broadcasting is getting back into the radio business on Long Island, NY. It's buying Joe Sullivan's soft AC WBAZ, Southold and country WLIE, Bridgehampton for \$1.65 million. Sullivan's Peconic Bay Broadcasting Corp. is one of four applicants for a new station on 92.9 MHz in Southampton, NY.

The Katz Radio Group has signed an exclusive long-term agreement to represent all 21 radio stations owned by ABC Radio. Katz will form an exclusive sales rep company for ABC with billings in excess of \$70 million projected for 1997. Bob McCurdy, most recently president of Sentry Radio, has been named president of the new division. Mitch Kline, most recently vice president, GSM for Banner Radio in Detroit, has been named vice president, GM for the new division. The new company will open it's doors April 1 with offices in Atlanta, Boston, Chicago, Dallas, Detroit, Houston, LA, Minneapolis, NY, Philadelphia, San Francisco and St. Louis.

The ban on gaming advertising has been overturned by a San Francisco Appeals court. The Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit, in a 3-0 decision, written by Judge Diarmuid O'Scannalain, ruled with plaintiff Valley Broadcasting, calling the law "an unconstitutional infringement of the broadcasters' First Amendment Under the new law, casino advertisers will be permitted to refer to rights." specific gaming attractions such as slot machines and black jack tables. Interep had filed an Amicus ("Friend of the Court") brief in support of plaintiff Valley Broadcasting, contending the law's restrictions were arbitrary and restricted broadcasters' ability to compete with newspapers and other media. Under the law, broadcasters could accept casino ads provided that commercials did not mention or show specific games of chance. The appeals court will soon hand down its formal order in the case, after which the government will have 90 days to file an appeal. The ban will remain in effect during the 90 day period and for the duration of the government's appeal, if any.

CBS Radio owns news KCBS, oldies combo KFRC-AM & FM, modern AC KLLC, new rock KOME, San Jose, talk KPIX (AM), and country KYCY, all serving San Francisco. Paul Leonard from Star Media Group represented Bonneville in the transaction.

Major League... The One-On-One Sports network plunks down \$45 million for the purchase of three major market AM stations. Spanish Broadcasting System is selling 620 KHz, WXLX, New York; 1540 KHz, KXMG, Los Angeles; and 1210 KHz, WCMQ, Miami. All three currently broadcast Spanish-language programming. An LMA and format change is anticipated soon.

is spinning urban WEJM-FM, Lansing, IL (Chicago) to Crawford Evergreen Broadcasting for \$14.75 million. Crawford also owns black gospel WYCA in Hammond, IL. The station must be sold as a result of the Chancellor/Evergreen/Viacom merger. WEJM-AM will stay with Chancellor/Evergreen.

ABC Radio is increasing its stake in Minneapolis by purchasing Cargill Communications' new rock trimulcast of KREV, Lakeville, WREV-FM, Cambridge, and KCFE, Eden Prairie. An LMA will begin immediately with a format flip to rock. The three stations will join ABC's other properties: rocker KQRS, new rock KEGE, and children's KDIZ. Cargill will keep standards KLBB. No terms were disclosed. For a look at the coverage of the stations, see page 12.

Caribou Broadcasting is buying a third FM in the Honolulu market. It's buying Loew Broadcasting's new rock KDEO-FM for an undisclosed amount. Caribou owns new rock KPOI and CHR KOMQ-AM & FM there. KDEO-FM will flip from alternative to modern AC. Kalil & Co., Inc. was the exclusive broker.

John Lynch's Lartigue Multimedia Systems, Inc. flips directions in Boise and decides to drop its proposed purchase of standards KGEM, classic rocker KJOT, and new rock KQXR owned by Boise Viking Associates, LP and alternative KCID-FM from American General Media. Instead, Lartigue will pick up AC KCIX and soft AC KXLT from Contemporary Media Corporation for an undisclosed amount. KXLT is currently operated by KCIX under an LMA.

Entercom is picking up a combo in the Longview/Kelso, WA market with the purchase of AC/talk KEDO and CHR KLYK from Longview Broadcasting Company for \$1.8 million. Entercom owns classic rock KGON, new rock KNRK, and sports KFXX in nearby Portland, OR.

The Department of Justice has stopped Gulfstar's plans to purchase Demaree Media's talker KFAY, country KFAY-FM, and rocker KKEG, in the Fayetteville-Springdale, AR market. Gulfstar already owns AC KEZA, country KKIX, and rocker KKZQ. The deal would have given Gulfstar 62% of the revenue in the market.

The Country Radio Seminar included more than 2,237 attendees this year. A record number of participants were included in the CRS Artist Radio Taping Sessions feature. Joe Diffie, Epic Records, won the Artist Humanitarian Award. Radio Humanitarian Awards went to WAXX in Eau Claire, WI for small market; KASE in Austin, TX for medium market and KFKF, Kansas City for large market. Radio promotion awards for small market went to KDMG, Burlington, IA, medium market WJLM, Roanoke, VA and large market to WPOC in Baltimore, MD. DJ Hall of Fame Inductees were Dugg Collins, KDJW in Amarillo, TX for living inductee and Posthumous receipient was Honest John Trotter of WJJD, Chicago, IL. Gene Dickerson, KRMD, Shreveport, LA was elected to the CRB Board for the 97-98 term, and incumbent Gary Krantz, VP/GM, MJI Broadcasting will serve a second term as Agenda Committee Chairperson. The 29th annual Country Radio Seminar is scheduled for Feb 25-28, 1998 at the downtown Nashville Convention Center. The CRB is currently preparing for its fourth regional event CRS-West, set for Oct. 24-25 in Sacramento.

Interep Research released the results of a 1996 spending analysis on the Top 25 National Radio Advertisers. Overall, these 25 companies increased their radio spending 10% over last year. Sears & Roebuck topped the list with \$52,154,000, General Motors was second with \$43,147,000 and the US Government was third with \$42,732,000. While the advertisers spent over \$637 million on radio last year, shifting just 1% more of their total spending into radio each year would mean an annual increase of \$100 million for radio.

SFX Broadcasting, Inc. announced that it has entered into an agreement to purchase privately-owned Sunshine Promotions, Inc. and related companies in the concert and live entertainment business. Based in Indiana, Sunshine will continue to operate as an independent entity and will retain its current name, management and corporate location. The transaction will be exclusively funded through a drawdown of SFX' existing bank credit facility. Included in the purchase are Deer Creek Music Center, a 21,000 seat amphitheater just outside of Indianapolis, and the Polaris Amphitheater in Columbus, OH, a venue with a capacity of 20,000. Sunshine also operated the recently renovated Murat Centre in Indianapolis though a 99-year lease of the 2700 seat theater and 1800 seat ballroom. As part of the transaction, SFX will also acquire Suntex, Inc., an advertising specialty company producing promotional items, tour support services, concert tour and entertainment ads.

Arbitron has re-issued the Fall 1996 Denver-Boulder Radio Market Report. A household which participated in the survey may have been influenced by contact with media-affiliated individuals. Revised client tapes and Maximi\$er estimates have been mailed.

According to a story in Inside Radio, talk show host Dick Cavett has been accused in a \$35 million lawsuit of breach of contract and fraud. Cavett, under contract for \$500,000 a year, left the syndicated show after only two weeks on the air. Producer James Moskovitz was given explanations of the flu, pneumonia and then manic-depression, which was ultimately confirmed by Cavett's attorney. There will be a hearing on the suit next Monday in State Supreme Court in New York.

In the recently released Radar 54 - Fall 1996 report, six of the fourteen networks went up, seven went down and one (ABC's Platinum) had no change from the previous survey. The Advantage Network, ABC's new young adult network, targeted to Adults 18-49 had the largest audience increase (45.9%) persons 12+ of any network in the survey. ABC's Galaxy network was second, with an 8.3% increase. The American Urban Network had the third largest gain, up 6.9%, followed by ABC's Genesis, up 3.4% and Westwood's Adult Contemporary, up 2.6% and Variety up 1.5%. Paul Harvey continues as the #1 ranked personality.

"AirPlay Analyst" is a Windows program designed to break down the results of your auditorium or callout music research and allow you to rank your test by any criteria or score, or create "filters" to isolate songs based on specific criteria such as era, burn, etc. For more info, call (205) 987-7456.

Strategic Media Research announced the release of AccuTrack, a proprietary tracking system designed to measure and follow audience size, perceptual dimensions and marketing awareness. The new service features weekly audience tracking data such as cume, share and cume conversion across each major demographic and daypart. Image tracking is provided monthly on ten key perceptual images serving as a virtual rolling perceptual tracking. 

JACOR GETS A RUSH... Jacor Communications, Inc. announced the acquisition of E.F.M. Media Management. E.F.M. Media owns and distributes highly-rated syndicated talk radio programming including Rush Limbaugh and Dr. Dean Edell. The purchase price was not disclosed but was probably north of \$100 million, the amount ABC offered for the company a few years ago. Limbaugh has agreed to extend his contract into the next century. E.F.M. President John Axten and VP Stu Krane will remain and Chairman/CEO Ed McLaughlin will continue to serve the company in a consulting capacity. Jacor just started syndicating Dr. Judy Kuriansky's "Lovephones" program.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

For the third time, the Commission has revised the AM Expanded Band Allotment Plan, and has extended the filing window for eligible stations. 19 stations have been reassigned to different frequencies, nine stations have been dropped since the second revision, and ten stations have been added to the list. 59 stations are unaffected. Eighty-eight stations are eligible for the move to 1605 to 1705 KHz, which will have until June 16, 1997 to file an application for a construction. permit. Applications must be filed on Form 301. Expanded Band licensees will receive authorizations permitting dual frequency operations for a period not to exceed five years. The new list, in its entirety, is reprinted on page 10.

Renewal applications for Davidson County Broadcasting Company's WLXN(AM) and WWGL-FM, Lexington, NC were granted, subject to an admonishment by the Commission. A Petition to Deny the renewals was filed by the Southern Region of the National Rainbow Coalition for violation of EEO rules and policies. The Commission found no evidence that the licensee engaged in employment discrimination, but admonished the licensee for failing to self-assess its EEO program adequately.

Knox Broadcasting sought review by the Commission of a Sept., 1995 letter denying the extension of the construction permit for unbuilt station WJRZ(AM) in Toms River, NJ, and dismissing as moot a modification of the permit application. Knox cited the loss of a loan commitment and difficulty in obtaining zoning approval as causes for the delay of construction. Knox undertook certain construction efforts after the CP expired and claims to have now nearly completed construction of its technical facilities at its proposed, but as yet unauthorized, site and has spent more than \$400,000. Knox's list of claimed expenses submitted to the Commission totaled only \$198,000. Although the Commission found no intent to deceive, Knox was cautioned for its violations and instructed to ensure the accuracy and completeness of its representations to the Commission.

Chester P. Coleman was denied an application for review of a Feb. 1996 letter decision denying Coleman's application to replace the expired CP for new commercial FM broadcast station KEEN, Palmer, AK. The staff notified Coleman more than ninety days after the expiration of his permit that it had canceled his CP and deleted the call letters. The staff noted that Coleman had not filed a license application nor had he filed an application requesting an extension of time within which to construct his proposed station. In fact, Coleman had filed an application to replace his expired permit on Aug. 29, two weeks before cancelation of the permit but almost two months after the deadline for filing such an application. Coleman indicated the lack of construction progress was due to a delay in receiving commissions from another sale to fund the construction and that he inadvertently neglected to file the extension.

Joseph D. Jones' application for review of a staff decision dismissing a Petition for Reconsideration filed by Jones which let stand a grant of an application to assign the license of KMET(AM), Banning, CA from Ray M. Stanfield, Receiver to Robeson/Suttles Broadcasting, Inc was denied. Jones asserted that the staff failed to consider his pending application for review of a prior assignment of the license to Stanfield, it failed to consider a Petition for Review of the grant to Stanfield that Jones filed in the US Court of Appeals for the DC Circuit, that prior grant to Stanfield and the instant transaction are contrary to Commission policy because the staff acted upon assignment applications prior to the adjudication of pending legal matters in state court and finally, that the staff treated the parties differently by dismissing his late-filed Petition to Deny while allowing opposing counsel to make late filings.

Assignment applications for WQBJ(FM), Cobbleskill, NY, and WQBK-AM & FM, Rensselaer, NY, from Maximum Media, Inc. to Radio Enterprises, Inc. and assignment of license application for WXCR(FM), Ballston Spa, NY from DJA Media, Inc. to REI were granted by the Commission in addition to a temporary waiver of the one-to-amarket rule. The waiver is subject to the outcome of the television ownership proceeding. Should divestiture be required as a result of that proceeding, Radio Enterprises will have to file an application to sell the necessary stations within six months from the release of the Orders.

FCC Chairman Reed Hundt has asked for another \$30 million to move the Commission to the Portals. His proposed 1998 budget of \$219,079,000 represents an increase of \$30 million over the 1997 funding.

Unity Broadcasting Network surrendered its license for silent WERA(AM) in Plainfield, NJ this week. The station was canceled and call letters were deleted.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

Fatima Response, Inc., licensee of KZRO (FM) in Dunsmuir, CA, has been granted a modification of their license to change from noncommercial educational to commercial status.

The license for Electronic Industry Association Consumer Electronics Group for experimental broadcast station KEIA in Sausalito, CA was canceled on 3/10/97. Call letters were deleted.

ELSEWHERE

In addition to EFM Media, Jacor also purchased three Santa Barbara stations, extending its reach up the California coast. Criterion Media Group will sell talk KQSB, soft AC KTYD, and rocker KSBL, Carpenteria, CA for an undisclosed amount. Jacor President, Randy Michaels, commented in the press release, after the obligatory "corporate strategy" verbage, "We are confident that Santa Barbara's lush locale will not discourage our corporate staff members from making frequent and perhaps unnecessary station visits."

Guardian Communications is giving up three large-market AM stations to Salem Communications for \$3 million. Salem gets religion talk WCCD, Parma, OH (Cleveland) to combo with recently purchased WHK; religion WTSJ, Cincinnati; and oldies WITH, Baltimore.

Jerry Zimmer's Zimco, Inc. is picking up news-talk WJPF, Herrin, IL and AC WXLT, Carterville, IL for \$1.25 million from Egyptian Broadcasting. The two stations cover the Carbondale, IL market where Zimmer owns country WOOZ-FM, Harrisburg, IL; news WCIL; and hot AC WCIL-FM, both Carbondale. Bill Lytle of Media Services Group, Inc. brokered the deal for Zimmer.

John Lynch's Lartique Multimedia Systems, Inc. picks up three stations in the Monterey-Salinas market in two separate transactions. It's buying oldies KOCN, Pacific Grove, CA from C.R. Pasquier Properties, Inc. Then, it gets country combo KTOM-AM & FM, Salinas, CA from California Broadcasting Company, L.P. No terms on either deal were disclosed. Austin Walsh and Tom McKinley of Media Services Group brokered each transaction.

In Northern California, Redwood Broadcasting expands its reach with the purchase of Siskiyou Radio Partners, Inc., which owns news/talk/oldies combo KMJC-AM & FM, Mount Shasta/KSYC, Yreka, CA; and country KSYC-FM Yreka. Siskiyou operates KMJC-AM & FM under an LMA-to-buy. No terms were disclosed.

Communications Corporation of America becomes a radio group owner this week with the purchase of KTSM and KTSM-FM, El Paso. The purchase includes KTSM-TV, the NBC affiliate in the market. COMCORP owns five radio stations in the Lafayette, LA market and six other television stations.

Broadcasting, L.P. will soon own seven stations in Macon, GA. Ocmulgee Broadcasting Company will sell its oldies WAYS and talk/sports WMWR for an undisclosed sum. U.S. owns country simulcast WDEN-AM & FM, AC WPEZ, and gospel WDDO, all Macon; and CHR WMGB, Jeffersonville, GA.

In the Coos Bay, OR market, Bay Broadcasting is buying news/talk KBBR and AC KACW, North Bend from Big Bay Radio, Inc. for \$450,000. Bay also owns standards/talk KHSN and country KOOS in the market.

SFX BREWS A LITE DEAL IN MILWAUKEE. . . SFX Broadcasting is buying up almost all of Hearst Broadcasting's radio properties. It enters the Milwaukee market with the purchase of talker WISN and soft AC WLTQ, "Lite 97.3." In Pittsburgh, it will combo Hearst's news/talk/sports WTAE and AC WVTY with rocker WDVE, jazz WJJJ, and new rock WXDX. Price tag for the four stations is \$35 million. Hearst's only radio properties left are news-talk WBAL and rock WIYY, Baltimore.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Notice of Apparent Liability issued for \$105,000 against Greater Los Angeles Radio, Inc.'s KLSX(FM) in Los Angeles for indecency was dismissed after a settlement agreement was reached. Without any admission of wrongdoing or liability on the part of KLSX, the settlement "would beneficially conserve the time, energy and resources of the parties." The Commission agreed not to talk about the settlement and will expunge it from the record, "including, but not limited to, any future qualifications issue, future licensing proceeding or future also agreed it will neither initiate nor prosecute any action against KLSX or its officers, directors, shareholders, agents or employeees which is based upon or relates to the NAL. KLSX agreed to "(a) promptly issue a policy statement to all on-air personnel directing them to be cognizant of the prohibition against broadcast of indecent speech and apprising them of the intention to take appropriate disciplinary actions against persons in violation of the statute, (b) establish a program designed to educate and update on-air personnel regarding FCC indecency actions, and (c) make two "contributions" of \$52,500 to the United States Treasury."

The Commission granted license renewal applications filed by Maumee Valley Broadcasting, Inc. for stations WONW(AM)/WZOM-FM in Defiance, OH and dismissed a Petition to Deny filed by the National Rainbow Coalition. The stations were admonished for failing to adequately self-assess its EEO programs to address the absence of Hispanics and other minorities from its applicant pools.

Newport Broadcasting, Inc.'s WADK(AM) in Newport, RI and Perry Communications' WOTB(FM) in Middletown, RI were ordered to pay a \$3,500 forfeiture for failing to comply with the Commission's EEO rules. The stations failed to pursue adequate EEO recruitment efforts for specific vacancies and failed to maintain sufficient records for meaningful self-assessment. Newport and Perry failed to respond to the Notice.

The construction permit for Kintronic Lab, Inc.'s experimental station on 1680 KHz was reinstated by the Commission. The station is licensed to Bluff City, TN and will operate at 400 w days. The Commission returned the license to cover as premature but granted replacement of the expired CP.

The license renewal application for Torrance Unified School District's KNHS in Torrance, CA was dismissed this week and call letters were deleted.

The FCC has amended its rules governing ex parte presentations in proceedings before the Commission. Ex parte presentations are communications directed to the merits or outcome of a proceeding which, if written, are not served on the parties to the proceeding or, if oral, are not preceded by Notice to the parties. Unlike the former rules, in which the ex parte status could change, the new rules provide that the status is fixed from its inception. In all proceedings, a certain period (called the Sunshine Agenda period) is designated in which all presentations are prohibited. The Commission has created a limited exception to the Sunshine period prohibition, for the public discussion of items adopted at open meetings but not yet released. In order to clarify its rules, a mere listing of the subjects discussed will not be sufficient, and more than a one or two sentence description of the views and arguments presented is required. This rule will be strictly enforced. Notices must now be filed by the next business day -- rather than the same day -- as the presentation. Public Notices listing ex parte presentations will be released at least twice a week instead of the current once a week and the responsibility for reviewing alleged ex parte violations moves from the Managing Director to the General Counsel.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

There have been several personnel changes at the Commission in the Office of General Counsel, Administrative Law Division this week. Suzanne Tetreault is being named Deputy Associate. She joined the Commission in 1995 as Assistant General Counsel, managing the Office's agenda review program. Joel Kaufman and Maureen Duignan will take over duties as Assistant General Counsel. Sheldon Guttmann, Chief of the Administrative Law Division for the past 15 years, will move to the General Counsel's front office as Associate General Counsel for Ethics. Patrick Carney has been named Sr. Ethics Counsel, he previously served as an attorney-advisor specializing in employee standards of conduct. Susan Steiman has been appointed Acting Associate General Counsel/Acting Chief of the Administrative Law Division, Office of General Counsel.

Back Bay Broadcasters is buying its LMA partner in Providence. Full Power Radio of Narragansett, Inc.'s soft AC WPJB will partner with business news WPNW, Pawtucket and dance WWKX, Woonsocket, RI. WPJB will begin simulcasting WWKX this week. Full Power Radio will keep country WJJF, Hope Valley, RI and AC WBMW, Ledyard, CT. No terms were disclosed. Robert J. Maccini of Media Services Group, Inc. brokered the deal.

Former Crescent Communications CEO Allen Shaw and Summit Communications Gordon Gray, Jr. have formed Centennial Broadcasting and will buy AGM-Nevada's oldies KQOL, Boulder City, NV (Las Vegas). Centennial will spend \$12.5 million for the station and plans more acquisitions soon.
