

FRC is actively involved in bills affecting family tax credits, family planning programs, pornography, Americans with disabilities, abortion and child care.

The merger in 1989 of the "Family Research Council" with FOCUS ON THE FAMILY has created a powerful force in our nation's capitol. Gary Bauer, former Domestic Policy Advisor to former President Ronald Reagan, is president of the "Family Research Council" arm of FOCUS ON THE FAMILY.

The work of the Council is crucial in reaching the American people in bringing about change in future policy affecting pro-family issues. As such, it is also a vital source of information for the "Family News in Focus" feature stories and for other programs prepared for FOCUS ON THE FAMILY release.

The Council works actively with other pro-family organizations on both a federal and state level. In Washington, the FRC is a member of a task force that meets regularly with the Under Secretary of Education to promote free choice in education. The FRC has also developed a task force on judicial selection. In consultation with attorneys familiar with the appointment process, the FRC has formed a low-key advisory group to provide pro-family input on the selection of federal judges.

One of the major goals of the FRC is to become a credible voice in the media for the pro-family movement. It has devoted a significant amount of its time during the past year to strengthening ties with the media. In so doing, the organization has successfully represented their position in major newspapers ranging from the Washington Post and New York Times to USA Today, as well as on television news programs such as ABC's "Nightline."

> Development in the White House in October, 1988, Gary Bauer served as Under Secretary of the U.S. Department of Education. As Under Secretary, Mr. Bauer was responsible for the day-to-day operation of the Department.

Mr. Bauer served in the Reagan-Bush campaign as a Senior Policy Analyst and worked in the Office of the President-Elect as Assistant Director for Policy/Community Service Administration.

In June, 1986, Gary Bauer was named Chairman of President Reagan's Special Working Group on the Family. His report, "The Family: Preserving America's Future" was presented to President Reagan in December, 1986.

In 1968, he received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Georgetown College in Georgetown, Kentucky, and Juris Doctorate from Georgetown Law School, Washington, D.C., in 1973.
