Sony Music has shown particularly impressive growth in 1998 compared to 1997, with album chart share increasing in every territoryin some cases, such as France and Switzerland, by up to 10 percent.

Warner Music's recovery—1998 is described as its best ever year for its European operations-is also reflected in the chart share figures. Almost every Warner company across Europe increased chart share in 1998, contrasting with a very weak performance in 1997.

M&M gets CIN chart

The U.K. album and singles charts appearing each week in Music & Media are now being sourced from Chart Information Network (CIN), the company which produces the official charts for U.K. labels' body the **BPI and the British Association** of Record Dealers.

The CIN data, compiled from sales in more than 5,500 U.K. retail outlets accounting for 99 percent of the singles market and 96 percent of the albums market, is also being used in the compilation of M&M's Eurochart Hot 100 singles listing and our European Top 100 Albums chart.

"I'm very happy to have resumed our relationship with CIN," says M&M editor-in-chief Emmanuel Legrand. "The use of these official charts, which was requested by many in the U.K. music industry, strengthens and enhances M&M's European charts, and improves our service to our readers."

For the past three years, M&M has been using U.K. music charts supplied by ChartTrack. The latter continues to provide the official charts of the Irish record industry.





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During the past decade, Sweden-celebrated at this year's Midem-has emerged as one of the most important sources of repertoire, not only in Europe, but for the rest of the world.

Robyn, Emilia, Eagle-Eye Cherry, The Cardigans, Lutricia McNeal, Kent, Ace Of Base, Roxette and many more have been regulars on Music & Media's sales and airplay charts, chalking up more hits than countries such as Germany (whose population is nine times bigger) and France (six times bigger). Amazingly, seven out of the top 10 acts in this week's Border Breakers chart are Swedishsigned.

How does such a small country manage to produce such a consistent and outstanding string of international hits? Long winter nights don't explain it all! It takes a combina-

tion of the right infrastructure (recording studios, venues), a pro-active local industry and, most of all, sheer talent.

Swedish producers and musicians certainly have an unerring ability to capture the sound of the time, and Swedish composers show obvious songwriting skills.

Furthermore, because of the country's size (how many times do you want to tour the same few cities?), Swedish artists have naturally developed a propensity to look for other geographical areas in which to express themselves.

And because Swedish is not the most popular language in the world, most Swedish artists sing in English, instantly putting themselves in a much more difficult league, in competition with the Madonnas and the Elton Johns. But, crucially, it also means borders can be crossed more easily-Big Big World is a catchy song, but it's hard to imagine it having the

LONDON - The structural details of the merger between PolyGram and Universal in Germany, the Netherlands and the U.K. have been unveiled.

In Germany, Universal Music Group (UMG) is folding PolyGram and Universal's operations into a five-label, genre-based company.

Motor Music, home of rock act Rammstein, will focus on "progressive and alternative" repertoire; it also takes on marketing for Geffen and Interscope from Universal, and for A&M from Polydor. Local and international repertoire from MCA moves to Polydor Germany, which will specialise in pop, schlager and comedy. Universal Germany, meanwhile, groups dance, R&B and hip-hop repertoire, taking on Def Jam from Mercury, and Motown from Motor. Mercury Germany will house pop and rock, with additional responsibility for material on Island.

The changes will result in about 80 lay-offs, and Universal Music Germany's music group president Tim Renner says the new company's roster of more than 200 artists will be "reviewed" after the restructuring.

In the Netherlands, UMG Holland president/CEO Theo Roos has announced that two of the three current operating units will remain (namely and Polydor), while Mercury Universal will cease to exist as a separate company.

All the existing Dutch A&R units will be merged into one A&R division, which will also oversee international exploitation. Additionally, the two company's sales forces will also be combined.

Polydor in the Netherlands, which will continue to be headed by Niel van Hoff, will consist of the Polydor, A&M, Geffen, Dreamworks, Interscope, Barclay, Motor and Stockholm Records labels. In addition, Polydor will continue to supervise the worldwide marketing of Italian singer Andrea Bocelli (Sugar Records).

Mercury's Dutch operation will be helmed by former Universal Benelux managing director Kees van Weijen. It will represent Mercury, London, Universal, Motown, Def Jam, MCA and MCA Nashville.

In the U.K., Universal Music U.K. chairman John Kennedy has also opted for a reduction in the number of operating units, in the shape of Mercury, Polydor and Universal/ Island. The new structure combining Island (currently headed by Marc Marot) and Universal U.K. will handle marketing for U.S. labels MCA, Universal and Motown, previously with Polydor in the U.K. The head of this new label is yet to be appointed, but it is assumed that the position has been offered to Marot. It was not known at presstime whether he had accepted the job.

Mercury U.K., headed by Howard Berman, will continue to handle repertoire from Mercury U.S. and Def Jam, as well as the marketing for Island's U.S. repertoire. Polydor U.K., whose managing director is Lucian Grainge, will see its U.S. source of repertoire strengthened with the arrival of Interscope, Geffen and Dreamworks.

PARIS - French CHR network NRJ is already benefitting from the programming alterations it made towards the end of last year, which included dropping rap music and increasing rotation levels (M&M, December 26).

At 12.1 percent, NRJ has scored its highest ever daily reach figure in the official Médiamétrie ratings for November and December. It compares with 10.3 percent in same period last year, and 11.1 percent in the previous (Sep-Oct '98) ratings sweep.

Zumkeller exit prompts Warner re-think

LONDON — Retiring Warner Music Europe president Manfred Zumkeller says he'll be taking a break before returning to "something in the wider entertainment industry."

"What I'm not going to do," he tells Music & Media, "is work for BMG or Universal or anybody like that in Germany. I don't want to end up sitting in somebody else's office again."

Warner Music International (WMI) chairman Ramon Lopez describes Zumkeller as "undoubtedly one of the great record men of the music industry" who has made "an immense contribution to our European performance over the past eight years."

Zumkeller explains that he will be moving from London to his native Germany at the end of Febuary . "I've been in the record business since

Febuary . "I've been in the record business since 1961 and I'm turning 55," he says. "You can run round the world and fly across Europe and that kind of thing, but there are other things in life."

The executive's departure has offered Warner Music International (WMI) an opportunity to re-define its upper tier of management. Zumkeller is not expected to be replaced and, according to a WMI statement, "the organisational management arrangements for WMI's European operations will be announced in the near future." One idea being

widely touted in the industry is that former PolyGram Music Group president Roger Ames could join WMI with the intention of succeeding Lopez within the next couple of years. Ames, who has also been in discussion with EMI, would bring into the fold London Records, a compa-

Noordzee junks schlager tunes

HILVERSUM — Dutch repertoire specialist Radio Noordzee Nationaal has changed its name—to Noordzee FM—and has dumped schlager music from its programming.

"What we previously suspected has been thoroughly proved by extensive research conducted by Ad Roland Media Services—namely that a mix of populist [schlager] music and pop music doesn't work anymore," says Noordzee FM head of communications Jerney Kaagman. "As a radio format, it's

"As a radio format, it's much too wide," she continues. "You can't mix pop acts such as Marco Borsato, Skik and Van Dik Hout with populist [schlager] singers such as Frans Bauer any longer. Since we started in the early '90s, Dutch music has developed so much that we had to keep up with the times."

Radio Noordzee has seen its ratings high of 10.5 percent achieved in the mid-'90s diminished recently to a mere 6.5 percent. A further programming change to stop the ratings slide will see less talk on the station—the research also demonstrated a desire amongst existing and potential listeners for a more music-intensive service.

The schlager music ousted from Nordzee FM's playlist will find a home on Radio Holland's Glorie, the Dutch schlager sister station launched by Radio Noordzee in February last year. Radio Holland's Glorie broadcasts to some two million households via the country's cable radio networks.

FIMI ELECTS LEGAL PRESIDENT

MILAN — Music copyright lawyer Alberto Pojaghi has been elected the new president of Italian music industry federation FIMI. Pojaghi replaces Warner Music Southern Europe & Italy president Gerolamo Caccia Dominioni in the role. A spokesperson from Pojaghi's office comments: "His election highlights the priority which the music industry is placing on copyright protection in this era of new electronic distribution technologies." FIMI's newly extended board (including independent label executives) was also confirmed at the organisation's January 18 meeting.

OLDIE RADIO ON TRIAL



BRUSSELS — Belgian CHR cable station Radio Flandria is in the process of setting up a second service, Oldie Radio, offering a gold format to Flemish-speaking cable subscribers. Playing 70 percent '70s and late '60s music, combined with what Radio Flandria managing director Peter

Van Dam (pictured) describes as "the highlights of the '80s and '90s," Oldie Radio began trial broadcasts in September last year, although Van Dam is still negotiating access with a number of Flemish cable operators. "We have already signed a deal with two cable companies, giving the station access to 40,000 households, but I'm confident more will follow very soon," he says.

NEW OWNERS FOR ZFM

OSLO — Aller, the media conglomerate which owns Norwegian AC station Radio 1, has acquired Sandvika-based CHR station ZFM from Sweden's Kinnevik/Modern Times Group (MTG). ZFM replaced MTG's classical station Klassisk Radio last spring. Radio 1 managing director Pål Thore Krosby says that Aller plans to "utilise synergies with Radio 1," in a move which we could see programme sharing and networking between the two stations. Krosby suggests that ZFM could also undergo a complete change of format. "We're not excluding anything at this stage," he says.

ITALY MOURNS FABRIZIO DE ANDRE

MILAN — Italian singer/songwriter Fabrizio De Andre (pictured) has died at the age

of 58. He had been treated for cancer after being diagnosed midway through a national tour of Italy last September. Considered one of the greatest singer/songwriters to emerge from his home city of Genova. De Andre carved out a 19-album



career on the back of insightful songs with an anarchic bent inspired by literature. His last release was 1997's *Mi Innamoravo Di Tutto* (Ricordi/BMG Ricordi). BMG Ricordi President Franco Reali described De Andre's death as "a tragic loss for Italian music."

MOVING CHAIRS

MADRID — Journalist Fernando Orgambides is the new director of SER's Radio Valencia, following the retirement of Ismael Mascarell. Orgambides, 44, worked for the top-selling El Pais newspaper between 1980 and 1997.

PARIS — French artists/performers collecting society **Adami** has a new president, actor **Pierre Santini**. He will be flanked by a new general manager, Adami's director of legal affairs **Pierre Noguier**, who was promoted after former general manager **Patrick Boiron** left the organisation at the end of last year.

LONDON — Veteran presenter **David Hamilton** is joining the GWR Group to present a Sunday afternoon show on GWR's **Classic Gold** network.

French music market 'steady' in '98

PARIS — The French music market posted a better-than-anticipated 2.9 percent growth in value in 1998.

In wholesale prices, the market was worth Ffr 7.65 billion (euro 1.17 bn), while the overall increase in units reached two percent, according to figures released by French trade body SNEP.

"It's a mature market, very competitive, but all in all, it has been quite steady," says SNEP president Paul-René Albertini.

Most of 1998 was difficult for the French industry, with particularly low sales in June/July during the World Cup, which took place on French soil. However, this was offset by double-digit growth during November and December—the last two months of 1998 accounted for some 30 percent of the year's total turnover.

CD album sales accounted for most of the growth, with a three percent rise in unit sales to Ffr117.7 million (compared with Ffr114.3 m in 1997). Sales of singles, which in recent years have enjoyed annual increases in the region of 30-40 percent, fell to 40 million from 42.6 in 1997.

Albertini attributes the drop in singles sales to the availability of CD-R players, which enable private individuals to make CD-quality copies of original recordings onto blank CDs. To counter the effects of this technology, SNEP is planning a Ffr1.5 million ad campaign targeted at schools and colleges, warning that "selling CD copies can lead to jail." National production represented 54.4 percent of pop music sales in 1998. "It is the best figure for French production since 1994, when the [airplay] quota law was passed," comments SNEP general manager Hervé Rony.



"The whole market benefits from the sales rise of local repertoire," says Albertini, who notes that there are more and more albums from local acts passing the two million units sales mark, and of the 10 best selling albums in 1998, seven are from local repertoire.

According to Albertini, the growth of local repertoire is also linked to the development of urban/rap music in France. "There are at least 15 albums in this genre that have sold between 80 to 200,000 units last year," he reveals.

Ratings slide prompts 'safer' Energy strategy

STOCKHOLM — NRJ is performing major surgery on its Swedish CHR network Energy following latest ratings figures from RUAB, which show that it has lost its position as the country's number one commercial radio station.

In the official audience figures for October-December, Energy has been overtaken by the Hot AC formatted Rix network. Owned by the Modern Times Group (MTG), Rix now has a daily reach of 9.0 percent—up 0.5 percent on the previous survey spanning July-October.

"We haven't focused on the right songs and we played too much dance music," admits NRJ Sweden managing director Jacob Laurin. "At the same time, the other stations have introduced more modern formats with more new music, sharpening the competition. Mix Megapol started the trend, then MTG re-formatted Power as a direct competitor to us and also dropped the '80s music on Rix. Recently Bandit [now Wow! 105.5] has also taken steps in the same direction."

In response to the ratings reverse, Energy's programming is now being skewed more towards pop and rock, with less dance music. "Safer hits more often" is how Laurin describes the new music policy, which echoes the recent changes to the music format at NRJ France (see story, page 5). Indeed, NRJ group programming director Christophe Sabot has been heavily involved in the Swedish changes.

In a renewed marketing push, Energy will also more than double its

marketing budget to Skr8-10 million (euro 1 million) for 1999. "We haven't done enough marketing, both nationally and in the local markets," acknowledges Laurin.

Byte moves Benelux releases to Rough Trade

BRUSSELS — All Byte releases in Belgium and the Netherlands will now be handled by Rough Trade following the expiry of the Belgiumbased indie dance label's five-year distribution deal with Sony Music.

"We had a good working relationship with Sony in Belgium, but in Holland we had some difficulties on the singles market," says Byte marketing manager Nee Van den Eynde.

"A number of new signings get access to the market through the club circuit, followed by crossover to small retailers and commercial radio stations," explains Van den Eynde. "I have the impression that major record companies like Sony have problems with this strategy—they prefer to service the major retail chains first."

Byte opted for Rough Trade because "just like Byte, they are a singles-driven company. Their success with artists such as Venga Boys proves that they know how to take on distribution of popular crossover dance," says Van den Eynde. Comments Peter Raasveld, MD of Rough Trade in the Netherlands: "Since Zomba took over Rough Trade two years ago, our company has built a specific profile—we're very selective in signing new labels. Byte is more than welcome aboard, not only as a distribution partner but also because both companies think alike."

The new deal will cover the Benelux territories for a two-year term.

Websites: the new radio moneyspinners?

Currently, there are more than six thousand radio stations worldwide which have staked their claims on the Internet and are offering services ranging in scope from promotions to full "ecommerce," according to U.S. trade organisation the National Association of Broadcasters (NAB). The list of stations going on-line grows every week.

Information for profit

An in-depth study of how radio listeners use the Internet, conducted last year in the U.S. by leading radio ratings company Arbitron in conjunction with Edison Media Research, comes to the conclusion that the radio industry "sits at a unique moment in history." The results, culled from three thousand respondents across the U.S., reveal some compelling information which radio stations can work from to create revenue via their websites. For example:

• The majority of respondents say their favourite radio station is what they most want to listen to when on-line.

• Half those surveyed are interested in buying products and services from a station's website.

• Half those surveyed want to be able to go to a website to see the products and services offered by the station's advertisers.

The study also points out that advertisers are realising that radio—compared to other media—is more successful in driving people to visit a website.

Going for the dollars

Creating, maintaining and expanding websites as a new source of revenue is based on a principle which has always applied to radio, according to Rick Ducey, NAB senior vice president, research and information. "In radio, we are familiar with the idea that where the audience goes, the dollar (hopefully) goes," he says. "Once this hook is set, stations have a tremendous opportunity to provide an extended range of services to both advertisers and audience with web offerings. Getting people into the shop is half the battle with retail advertisers.

"There is a lot of interesting work by European radio stations on the web," Ducey continues. "As radio stations have done a great job building websites and attracting audiences to them, we are going to start seeing stations earn more of a revenue stream from this activity over the next year," he predicts. "This will work best when radio stations partner with other companies to provide more services. Most stations can't afford to have a huge, dedicated Internet staff, but with partners, they can offer a full range of personalised services."

Small or large can benefit

Irish CHR station FM 104/Dublin decided to totally rebuild its website in an effort to reflect the culture of the station more accurately, and to attempt to build revenue. "Our radio station must be seen to be at the top of the trends, or setting the trends," says programme director Colm Hayes. "That includes the Internet. If you are going to do these things, you have to do them 100 percent right."

According to Hayes, FM 104's former website had a reputation for not changing, which risked causing serious damage to the station's on-the-ball branding. The new site, set to launch at presstime, will be managed by a full-time "webmaster" to put it "an extra rung up the ladder" in its aim of being perceived as fashionable while being a business tool, says Hayes.

On a different scale U.K. entertainment group Capital Radio, realising the potential of Internet revenue, has set up an Internet business, Capital Interactive (CI), separate from its broadcasting operations. CI was launched less than three years ago with the 95.8 Capital FM website. The company is now involved with several sites, including Capital-owned stations across the U.K. and links to many others. During its last financial year, CI had a turnover of more than £1 million (euros 710,000) and boasts a staff of nearly 30

employees. During 1999, CI will expand further in online music retailing activities. The company's roster of clients includes Microsoft, Carphone Warehouse, Compaq and Twix.

CI marketing director Stuart Ledden comments: "When our first website launched, it primarily offered our listeners the chance to interact more easily with the station. Over the course of development of our sites, we found our users becoming more and more interested in the exclusive interactive and multimedia elements."

Selling opportunities

Ledden points out that "CI has a very important role to play in offering advertising clients well developed crossmedia promotional opportunities. Clients have linked on-air and online campaigns to great effect."

Other major European radio players are looking to the Internet for new business. For example Jean-Paul Baudecroux, president of French broadcaster NRJ, confirmed recently that his company is looking to establish a revenuedriven website which will include virtual retail shopping.

NAB's Ducey concludes: "As stations begin developing [website] content that is fresh, compelling and useful, audiences are attracted to the sites. After they have sampled the site, probably driven there by cross-promotion from the station's own airtime, they come back—if they like it."

National U.K. rock station Virgin Radio was the first European broadcaster to provide permanent real time audio of its output when its website was launched in 1996. John Ousby, director of Ginger Online (a division of Virgin's parent company, Ginger Media Group), which operates the station's website, says stations must keep pace with the developments of radio and the Internet. "The transition from websites being a promotional tool to a profit centre is not surprising, given the amazing growth we have seen in the [Internet] connected population. Three years ago the corporate attitude to the web was very different to today. We have moved from 'what is it?' through 'it will never last' to 'shit, we'd better do something.''

Rick Ducey, NAB senior vice president, research and information group, gives M&M some basic advice on generating Internet revenue

1. Money from Internet activities comes from audiences, partners and advertisers. Be careful to keep the mix of services and content on your site tightly integrated and relevant to your audience.

2. Some basic ways to develop revenue streams from Internet business:

- Internet Service Provision (literally selling bandwidth and access to the web).
- Website hosting and development for advertisers.
- Value added applications, such as site traffic analysis and reports for advertisers on your site.
 E-commerce. Selling things your-
- E-commerce. Selling things yourself, or having partners who offer you a percentage of their revenue based on leads from your site.
- Selling advertising on your site including: banners, interactive, classified and display.

3. To build brand and audience loyalty, make it easy for listeners to do what they want to do. The ability to "personalise" a web visit, based on users' profiles, lets the listeners do what they want or get what they want from your site with the minimum effort. This dramatically increases the value of their visit to your site.

4. Drive traffic to your site from on-air activity. Distribute an electronic newsletter via e-mail sign-ups. Maintain a listener/site-user data base and use it to mine the rich possibilities inherent in the targeting and segmentation prospects which such a database enables.

5. Let the users feel they have a hand in the station through e-mail and chat rooms. They (and you) have a vested interest in making "their" station better. Open up the avenues for them. ATOLL MUSIC

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
Midem '99: concerts, conferences & consensus

More than 9,000 deleconverge. aates on Cannes for the 33rd Midem trade fair. Music & Media previews the event.

idem is usually the right place to be to monitor the state of the music business. The trade fair on the French Riviera has for 33 years reflected the mood of the music market, and judging by the scope of this year's event, rumours that the \$40 billion industry is in danger of disappearing are greatly exaggerated.

One week before Midem, overall attendance looked set to be up 5 percent on last year, with the same number of stands taken but a 10 percent increase in the number of companies participating. Christophe Blum, music division director of organisers the Reed Midem Organisation (RMO), says the higher attendances show Midem remains the premier gathering for the international music community, and that "more than ever, Midem answers a need."

Attendance is particularly rising from regions such as North and South America, the U.K. and Germany. The impact of the Midem Latin America & Caribbean fair, held for the past two years in Miami, is a factor in growing American interest, according to Blum. "We made a breakthrough there, and many North and South American companies discovered the value of Midem. Besides, the situation of the US market is quite good

these days." Blum confirms that next year's Miami gathering will take place in June (22-25), under the new name Midem Americas.

Industry trends are reflected this year during Midem's conferences, which emphasise three main topics: the Internet and its implications for the industry; new musical trends; and the situation in Eastern Europe.

"We are going to tackle many issues crucial to the future of the music industry," says Blum, "especially how the Internet will change the landscape." He is convinced the Net offers "new development opportunities for Midem." Next year, RMO will be organising a new initiative, MIDNET, on the eve of Midem, which will focus on all Internet- and on-linerelated activities and offer a platform for both the music and the Internet industries.

Midem's response to new musical trends is highlighted in the artists lineup for Midem's showcases and concerts (see story below), with continuing efforts to present electronic music, adding a second evening dedicated to it and renewing the Electronic Village experience, which gathers under one umbrella new up-and-coming labels in the dance/Techno/electronica field. 'This initiative has attracted new labels and a new generation of professionals to Midem," says Blum. "This is our future."

The formal sessions

More than 100 international speakers will cross swords in 18 different discussion panels at Midem '99. Copyrights set the agenda's keynote: from piracy to Bowie Bonds, seven sessions will home in on the key issues which face authors, publishers and collecting societies at the turn of the millennium.

Opening the conference on Sunday, Jan 24 is a panel on music used in film, TV and advertising. The second day is dedicated to four separate panels on current developments in international copyright law, followed by a panel on new ways of copyright exploitation on January 26, and a seminar on new technologies to detect music pirates on the Internet will close the programme on January 27.

The two opening panels of the Eastern European session on January 26 will give an overview of current talent and the development of individual markets in the region.

Building on this, three more panels on Eastern Europe and the CIS countries will deal with issues of intellectual property rights. Current developments in copyright legislation are on the agenda on January 26, and the fight against copyright infringement and the pitfalls of managing authors' rights and neighbouring rights in the region will be scrutinised in two separate panels on January 27.

Two rather unusually "hands-on" panels bring music to the fore. Top songwriters such as Per Gessle



(Roxette), Peter Sevensson (the Cardigans) and Björn Ulvaeus (ex-ABBA) will unveil the secrets of writing hits "the Swedish way" during The Swede Sound Of Success, on January 24.

The concerts

Midem's concert programme celebrates three major achievements this year: the success of Swedish artists all over the world; the 100th birthday of Spanish authors' rights society SGAE; and the diversity and innovative power of dance music.


The opening night at the Palais des Festivals on January 23 sees top Swedish artists such as the Cardigans, Meja, Jennifer Brown, Robyn and M&M chart topper Emilia perform live on the same night-the highest ever concentration of international hit artists at Midem.

Spanish artists Enrique and Estrella Morente, Antonio Canales and Lagartija Nick celebrate SGAE's 100th. anniversary in a gala concert at the Palais des Festivals on January 27. Other events with a Latin touch include The Punta Brazil—New Explosion and Generation, both on January 24 at the Palm Beach.

"This year electronic dance music will explode out of the clubs straight onto radio and into the charts," predicts Midem artistic director Dominique Leguern. "What I am trying to do is present the sounds which will become important over the next few months."

Dance music confirms its strongest ever Midem presence with three major nights at the Palm Beach, the Dance D'Or awards on January 24-based on Music & Media's Eurochart Hot 100 Singles-Midem Electronic Night on January 26 and Palm Beach Beats II on January 27. These events bring a star-studded lineup to Cannes, with live performances by acts such as Cher, The Tamperer and Alliance Ethnik at the Dance D'Or awards.

Leguern predicts that "[North African] Rai music and African music in general have the potential to become very influential for the development of pop and dance." Both genres will be reflected during the Oriental Dream concert at the Martinez on January 24 and a special African night. at the Palm Beach on January 25. "I believe in [musical] discoveries that can work," Leguern concludes. Christian Lorenz





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

DANCE GROOVES GOES TO MIDEM '99

Now in its second year, and renamed Electronic Village, Midem's dance forum seems to have clicked with the international dance community.

Last year's event, the somewhat less-than-all-embracingly named "Techno Midem" drew 170 participants from 110 companies. This year, around 250 individuals or companies from 19 countries have registered, an increase of more than 40 percent.

Alongside the Electronic Village, a further 1,000 individuals and companies describing themselves as dance music-oriented have registered for Midem. That adds up to a total of more than 1,200 dance participants-or 10 percent-at the event.

"The big change is in the number of important labels that are coming this year," says Olivier Aillery, coordina-tor of the Electronic Village. "With companies like Cup of Tea, Axis, Good Looking, Ultra, Cargo, Guidance, Ministry of Sound and Fiat Lux attending, the event is truly on the map."

Apart from the networking possibilities offered by the Electronic Village, there are daily demo sessions at Jimmy'z, featuring three acts each day between 17.00-19.00, and the panel titled "Live vs. DJ" on Wednesday, January 27 at 15:00. The panel features Deep Dish/Carl Craig lawyer Kurosh Naseeri, DJs Jeff Mills, John Acquaviva and Richie Hawtin, Leo Pasken of Londonbased club The End and Maurice Spijker.

Tuesday, January 26 at the Palm Beach promises to be an excellent night, with French duo Les Kojaks returning to the stage after their highly acclaimed performance at Paris street rave Technoparade last September.

Following two superb 12-inch singles on French indie Pro-Zak Trax, the duo are currently adding the finishing touches to their debut album, Crime In The City. "The response both here and abroad to the maxis was very strong," says Pro-Zak Trax's Cyrille Lascaud. "Exports have been good and the track Hold Me, from the group's debut single, is on several compilations.




The presence of some 60+ UK labels in the Electronic Village, nearly twice as many as those from France, promises to provide more variety and innovation than ever. Cleveland City's Rob James will be there with one of this month's hottest tracks. Love My Brother Love My Sister by The Family featuring Alexander Hope is a storming house with a French touch. track "Reactions from the clubs have been great," says James, "and UK radio is

also supporting the track." U.K. national public CHR network BBC Radio 1 DJs Pete Tong and Judge Jules are giving the track airtime, as are all three dance-formatted Galaxy stations and east of England regional dance outlet Vibe FM. "We've already had interest from Spain, France and the G/S/A territories," James adds, "so we'll be at Midem with the intention of sorting out deals for mainland Europe.

One other re-release from Cleveland City which should create a stir is Chubby Chunks by Kentish Man. The original 1993 track, widely regarded as a classic, is still played in sets by top DJs including Brandon Block and Alex P. The new version, with a re-worked backing track, also now features a vocal by Kim Ruffin.

Cool Sweden planning hot night for Midem '9

wedish artists prepare to celebrate the outstanding success of their music at Midem '99, buoyed by the country's record-breaking music exports in 1998—estimated at Skr 2 billion (euro 210 million).

"There is something very significant about doing this on the threshold of the new millennium," adds Export Music Sweden (ExMS) MD Stuart Ward. "With our Cool Sweden showcase we want to say that this is the place to turn to for new talent." The Cardigans, Meja, Emilia, Jennifer Brown and Robyn are confirmed to play during the ExMS-organised Cool Sweden gala at the Palm Beach on January 24, Midem's prestigious opening night.

From the Cardigans' beefy rock-they definitely shed their twee '60s retro image with their 1998 album Gran Turismo (Stockholm)-and the upbeat pop songs of Meja and Emilia, to the sophisticated R&B of Brown and Robyn, Cool Sweden bears lively testimony, to the country's diverse and highly accomplished music scene.

All the artists involved are strongly committed to the event: the Cardigans fly in especially for the Cool Sweden gig on the eve of their biggest U.S. tour to date; Robyn is flown in by Concorde from New York, where she is currently recording her new album.

ExMS also aims to offer a glimpse at the way top songwriters such as Max Martin (Backstreet Boys), Per Gessle (Roxette), Peter Sevensson (the Cardigans), Meja and Björn Ulvæus (ABBA) string together hits "the Swedish way," at a panel titled The Swede Sound Of Success at the Palais Des Festivals on January 24.

The Swedish government supports ExMS' Midem events with Skr 500,000 (euro 53,000). Minister of Trade Leif Pagrotsky will attend Midem for the first time and is expected to deliver a keynote speech at the beginning of the Swedish panel.

"[Midem] used to be seen as an event with significance for the [music] industry only," observes public network Swedish Television (SVT) music editor Tommy Ledin. "This has changed, partly because of the heavy involvement of the Swedish industry this year. Now we expect it to be an excellent occasion to pick up on new trends."

Production company Barracuda Television will provide footage of the Cool Sweden concert and the seminar The Swede Sound Of Success, and a programme with highlights from both events is scheduled to be broadcast on SVT on February 9.

Per Alexandersson, head of events at public broadcaster Swedish Broadcasting Corporation (SBC), says there will be an extraordinarily large amount of radio coverage from this year's Midem on SBC, which has reporters in Cannes to file daily news bulletins. Negotiations are under way with Radio France to secure the rights to record the Cool Sweden concert and broadcast it on January 25.

Italy is Europe's "sleeping giant" in terms of per capita CD sales, but the upheavals of European Union and new technology appear to have galvanised the country's music industry into a new vitality.

In this 12-page Italy Spotlight, M&M gives an overview of the music industry in the wake of the recent indie shakeout, examines the fresh air of confidence and adventure in domestic A&R which is leading the drive for home-grown acts to achieve international success, and highlights some of the Italian talent which will spearhead Italy's drive into Europe.

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Italy's music industry revitalised

Consolidation, adaptation and progress are the themes in the music business across Europe, and Italy is looking forward to the challenges of the new millennium, new technology and the development of domestic talent with a measure of confidence, as Mark Dezzani reports.

Gerolamo Caccia Dominioni, president, Warner Music Southern Europe he fin-de-siècle ferment affecting the global music industry is having a vitalising effect on Italy's

music business, as it runs to catch up with its European neighbours. But with Italian domestic music sales still averaging around one CD per capita per year, against an average of, for example, 3.9 per capita in the UK, there is still some way to go.

The twin trends of global consolidation at company level, and increasing segmentation at market level, have made reform more urgent and stimulated a rush to discover, develop and distribute new local talent. There is also a third factor: technology. With electronic distribution of music no longer the figment of a sci-fi writer's imagination, record company executives are counting in months, rather than years, the advent of downloads as a vital factor in charting music sales.

European Union a major force Warner Music Southern Europe president Gerolamo Caccia Dominioni, who is also president of Warner Music Italy and of the CGD-East West label in Italy, says that apart from consolidation at company level, European Union is now the major factor in influencing musical trends. Whilst the Italian market may not make up ground on its European neighbours overnight in terms of domestic sales, he believes that the export of music within Europe is a reality which has only just begun to realise its potential. "Warner Music's restructuring of European operations into regional divisions is designed to exploit the challenges that the European Union is creating," says Caccia Dominioni. "The barriers of the past no longer exist, with each territory having a potential to export artists."

Italy has continued its recent trend of exporting artists. Eros Ramazzotti, Zucchero and Laura Pausini have sustained and consolidated their international success with new albums. Andrea Bocelli and Gala are releasing new albums this year. In 1998 Nek (WEA), Alexia (DWA/Sony Dance Pool) and The Tamperer (Time) scored abroad with significant international sales.

In addition organisations such as RTI, Italy's largest independent label, have been focusing on Spain as a gateway to Latin American and other Hispanic markets. RTI artist Michelle Zarillo is being followed into Spain and Portugal by another singer/songwriter, Stefano Zarfati. "Zarillo scored over 25,000 sales in Spain, which means this will open the door for us to market him in Latin America this year, as well as other European territories," says RTI president Roberto Magrini.

New and established blend

Established Italian artists provided the best selling albums in 1998, with Vasco Rossi's classy album Canzoni Per Me (Songs For Me) (EMI), Renato Zero's Amore Dopo (Love After Love) Amore (Fonopoli/Sony) and the teaming of two veteran stars, Mina and Adriano Celentano on Mina/ Celentano (PDU/Clan/RTI) all topping 800,000 sales (8 times platinum), and all still in the FIMI/Nielsen Top 25 album charts in early 1999 after more than 30 consecutive weeks.

FIMI did not publish interim market figures during 1998, but the prevailing opinion in the industry is that 1998 was a flat year, saved by stronger sales during the traditionally busy pre-Christmas period. "It has been a difficult year for almost everyone," observes RTI Music's Roberto Magrini, adding that "no-one is lamenting the strong end-of-year upturn. Almost everyone benefited from a strong Christmas sales season."


Magrini believes that the key to stimulating the market is the



development of new artists, and 1998 saw a scramble to sign new pop acts similar to the A&R rush of several years ago. Emergent artists from that period such as Biagio Antonacci (Mercury), Carmen Consoli (Cyclope/Polydor), Marina Rei (Virgin), Giorgia (BMG) and Sottotono (WEA) are registering multi-platinum sales. A flood of new trend acts is also breaking through faster.

Era of cooperation and growth

"I can say with confidence that a new era for the Italian music industry has begun," comments Caccia Dominioni, reflecting a general optimism that 1999 will bring



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market growth and concerted action to confront future challenges. objectives to improve Italy's music market," Caccia Dominioni asserts. An effective reunification of Italy's independent and major labels last December was Caccia Dominioni's parting achievement as outgoing president of Italy's IFPI-sponsored industry federation, FIMI. The Warner Music Italy president resigned from an extended mandate as FIMI president on January 1st 1999 to focus on his new role as Warner Music Southern Europe president.

The exodus of 25 labels from indie music association AFI including nearly all of the remaining significant independent players—to join FIMI, is viewed as giving added political clout to the country's music industry. This will add force to the their lobby for new legislation to confront a future in which electronic distribution of music via the Internet is fast becoming a reality. With FIMI's membership at more than 100 companies, the 160 remaining mem-



bers in AFI are spread between music publishers, artist managers and specialist producers, including many which account for Italy's socalled "submerged market." These are companies which distribute their product through alternative channels, including news-stand sales of CDs together with magazines, an area also being taken seriously by major labels for specialist catalogue product such as classical and jazz.

These sales are not easy to quantify through the official FIMI methodology, hence the "submerged" label. But according to figures released by Italy's authors' rights society SIAE—based on their "ticket" system which labels all releases and is therefore a reliable indicator of all music sales in Italy—total music sales in the country are almost double the 669.8 billion lire (euro 212 million) reported by FIMI.

New legislation imminent

AFI's new president, Franco Bixio, who is also president of the Bixio Music Publishing Group, says that whilst the exodus of leading indies has hurt his association, AFI remains a potent representative force. "The departing companies criticised AFI for being too disparate, with members including publishers and managers," explains Bixio. "However," he adds, "the reality is that with the Internet and electronic distribution, record companies will become more directly involved with copyrights management, and our members represent all aspects of the music industry, including publishing."

FIMI managing director Enzo Mazza says he expects rapid progress on new legislation to protect the country's music industry in 1999. "The longawaited new law introducing tougher sanctions against music pirates should be ratified in early 1999, and then our next main priority will be to lobby the govern-



ment to implement new directives regulating the distribution of music on the Internet," says Mazza.

Roberto Magrini, president of RTI Music, Italy's largest independent company, says he campaigned from within FIMI to reunite the industry, advocating the introduction of new statutes to give the smaller indie labels fair representation alongside the majors and medium-sized companies. "This has been a very positive development," comments Magrini. "It has been very important to achieve a united voice, so that we can focus on our core business of producing new music to stimulate the market."

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A&R takes the adventurous route

Bold and innovative A&R is at the heart of labels' ability to compete both at home and internationally. *Mark Dezzani* notes the new air of adventurous confidence which pervades Italy's A&R activities.

fresh breeze of optimism is blowing through the Italian music industry. The A&R departments of major record labels are taking risks on signing acts once regarded as niche and alternative.

In the past two years the breakthrough of domestic rock, punk, hip-hop, techno, big beat and world music artists into mainstream sales has encouraged record labels to seek out innovative artists.

Italy's independent sector, although decimated over the past few years, remains at the forefront of new talent discovery with labels such as Cyclope in Palermo supplying Polygram (now UniversalMusic Group) with artists of the calibre of rocker Carmen Consoli, and indie label Mescal Records licensing acts such as techno-rockers Bluvertigo to Columbia/Sony.

Fresh new artists

Major label A&R executives are now seeking to sign new indie-style acts directly.


acts directly. "The game is really taking off, there is a real cultural vibe here in Italy," enthuses EMI President and Virgin MD Riccardo Clary. Having taken risks himself, signing nontraditional new talent at Virgin, Clary was rewarded last year with his appointment as chief executive for all of EMI's Italian operations.




"The music industry here in Italy was a comfortable clique," he says, "but recently things have been changing very fast, there is a new positive attitude and things are really starting to move."

Clary's first move when he took over at EMI was to re-motivate his staff and strip down the old artist roster. "In Italy there's been a dire need for fresh new artists." he explains. "For a long time labels kept pinning their hopes on the same old-fashioned style of traditional artists, but now exciting innovators such as Carmen Consoli (Cyclope/Polydor) are breaking through. Just a few years ago," he

Riccardo Clary, EMI president, Virgin MD adds, "an innovative artist such as Max Gazzè (Virgin/EMI) gaining significant sales so quickly would have been regarded here as an absurd proposition."

Italy has had its fair share of innovators in the past, such as the now veteran artist Franco Battiato (Mercury), but the market has until recently remained predominantly conservative. This year, even the Sanremo Song Festival in February is moving away from selecting young artists in the traditional mould, and will represent the new diversity with trend-setting new acts selected to participate.

Market shakeup under way Carlo Albertoli, head of A&R at V2's Italian affiliate, was at the forefront of Italy's music revolution when, five years ago, his now defunct Vox Pop label signed a string of successful new alternative acts and licensed them to the majors. They included punk band Prozac+ (EMI), hip-hoppers Sottotono (WEA), world music act Mau Mau (EMI), reggae band Africa Unite (Blackout/Polygram) and alternative rockers La Crus (WEA).

"The market in Italy had atrophied and has been in dire need of a shake up," says Albertoli, "but I see that as an opportunity to fulfil a market demand." Albertoli adds, however, that he still uses the traditional approach to discovering new talent. "I receive a flood of demo tapes all the time. I discard the traditional-style artists where there is a lot of competition from other labels, and listen out for anything new. After identifying the talent, it's down to promotion and marketing. I give artists maximum freedom to develop their music and image, and just lend them the professional support they need."

Albertoli's first domestic signings for V2 Italy are modern pop band SuperB, hip hop duo ATPC and the "Fellini-esque" lounge act Puertorico.

The majors' approach

According to WEA Italy's A&R director Tino Silvestri, the approach to signing new talent at a major label is necessarily different. "It's all about understanding the market demand, and you therefore have to study carefully the market positioning of the label," he explains. "When I started in 1994, WEA Italy needed to build up a brand new roster of local artists and cover the various market segments, so we signed artists with diverse styles such as rocker Ligabue and the more traditional singer Paola Turci. Then, when you have built a roster, you have to review the positioning of your company in the market and adapt your new signings policy accordingly."

Silvestri says there are no golden rules to A&R scouting, and chance has to be given room to come into play. "When everyone was actively looking for the new Eros Ramazzotti, I just came across Laura Pausini for CGD-East West in a piano bar. The same when I discovered Nek. I was looking for a rock band at the time."

Media more receptive

A major part of realising market demand is understanding the media opportunities available, says Epic Italy label MD Massimo Bonelli. "Until recently there was very little space on TV and radio in Italy for what were regarded as niche artists," says Bonelli. "Alternative-style acts tended to be ghettoised in minority media and off-peak hours. Now there is adequate space to be able to break most types of artists, and the expansion of music TV in Italy has been a major factor in changing media attitudes." Bonelli's colleague at Sony Music Italy,

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Fabrizio Intra, MD of the Columbia Italy "We label, agrees. adopted have a research-led strategy and invested a lot in market research over the past two years, and whilst a change in attitude from the media has helped, it's the quality of the artists that really counts. We don't seek to identify holes in the market, but to search out quality new talent



(Columbia), a pop girl duo, and techno rock band Bluvertigo (Mescal/Columbia), have both benefited from a coordinated promotion strategy based around MTV Italy. The music station has made a greater impact as a promotional vehicle for new trend acts in Italy during the past 18 months, since it became available nationwide on a free-to-air terrestrial network 24 hours a day. Previously, MTV had only been available for a restricted number of hours a day in Italy.

Luca Fantaconi, MD of Universal-Polygram's trend imprint Blackout, says that MTV has had a significant impact. "MTV is far more open to the type of alternative acts signed to Blackout than towards a traditional singer/songwriter type of artist, but we have also been able to work our artists on radio much more in the past three years," says Fantaconi, adding that hip hop artist Neffa sold 60,000 copies of his first album on the back of radio exposure. 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

Radio still the key

Roberto Grillo, A&R director at EMI Music Italy, says that while MTV Italy has played a crucial role in changing media attitudes to new music, radio has responded and remains the vital tool for selling in large quantities. "Radio undoubtedly remains important for accelerating the establishment of new artists. Radio is keen on hip hop but is still a little too reluctant to give airplay to rock music. A band like punk act Prozac+ (EMI) had to build their base on live shows and videos before radio picked up on them, but they couldn't have sold 160,000 copies of their debut album without radio support.

BMG Italy label MD Adrian Berwick says that, while they anticipated an opening for trend



acts on MTV Italy and on radio, it is still important for a major to cast its A&R nets wide. "When I joined BMG three years ago we had the mega-artists such as Eros Ramazzotti and Luca Carboni, but very few medium-weight or new artists. We anticipated the opening up of the media-especially MTV and CHR radio-to trend artists, and signed trip-hop band Almamegretta and rap act 99 Posse, but also realised it was important not to limit our new signings to these genres.

Berwick adds that "at the other end of the A&R spectrum, we have signed Gigi D'Alessio who is a traditional Italian singer/songwriter with a strong local following in Naples, and have sold 35,000 copies of his debut album since November. We expect it to go gold [50,000 copies] very soon."

Surviving indies focus


Italy's independent sector has also responded to the rapid changes in the domestic music market. A shake-out in the indie label sector has seen a demise of several important labels-such as Flying Records-and smaller indies who relied on producer-based transient dance music projects. Giacomo Maiolini, MD of Brescia-based indie Time Records, says they are still producer-based, but there is now much more focus on artist development. "Our producers create the records and are also our talent scouts. They find the artists to work with, and we concentrate on developing the image and career of the artist in collaboration with our producers." Time Records' latest international success is The Tamperer featuring Maya, based on the producer/artist team of Fargetta and Maya.

Pippo Landro, MD of Milan-based indie New Music, says they survived the recent crisis in Italy's indie sector through their policy of focussing on artist development and diversifying from dance music, adding Latin dance, local hip hop artists and Italian pop acts to their repertoire. In 1998, New Music scored international success with Neja's pop dance single Restless. "Dance pop is dead, but pop dance is alive and well," says Landro, highlighting the shift from producer-based acts to artist-led projects. "When the dance scene in Italy virtually disappeared, we survived because we have always focused on artists backed up with high producvalues—such as tion Black Machine, Cecilia Gayle, Ti.Pi.Cal. and Neja," says Landro, adding that it is important for indies to build a tight repertoire of artists instead of relying on one act.

Riding the trends

Milan-based indie Do It Yourself






developing a small roster of artists including dance queen Regina and pop dance duo Soundlovers, backed up by Gala's producer Molella. DIY still recognises its need, as an indie, to cash in on transient trends. In response to the '80s pop revival the company has remixed and rereleased the '80s Europop icon Den Harrow.

"After the shakeup in the global music industry last year following the Seagram buyout of Polygram, I predict further big changes in 1999," says DIY MD Max Mozoldo. "The forces of the market are changing, which has led to the demise of what only two years ago were powerful indie labels. The survivors are those independent labels with the quality of artists who can sell internationally. In Italy, we can sell maybe tens of thousands of a strong release, whereas in the UK we can sell a million copies."

"It is no longer possible to survive with just two hits a year," he adds. "We have to develop several quality artists to maintain a constant market presence. 1999 will see an upturn in the fortunes of the surviving indie labels in Italy, and they have survived because they have understood this. We look towards the international market, but without ignoring our roots. The domestic market is our bread and butter, but the successful indies work like the majors, internationally."



New millennium, new talent: Italy's rising stars

The success of the Italian music business at home and internationally rests on the industry's ability to find and nurture new home-arown talent with the quality and longevity to fill the shoes of the previous generation's superstars. Mark Dezzani reviews some of the acts who are showing potential, and who enjoy the commitment and support of their labels.

Daniele Groff: Class and originality

Daniele Groff's classy, catchy pop music has been compared to The Beatles, Oasis and Blur but must also acknowledge the influence of Italian singer/songwriter Edoardo Bennato, who pioneered the pure pop sound in Italy. Like Bennato, newcomer Groff embellishes his orchestrated pop sounds with clever lyrics and an originality which stops comparisons with his musical idols short of any copy-cat accusations. Groff's debut album, Variato 22 (22nd Variation), released last November, has already racked up significant sales on the back of the singles Daisy and Io Sono Io (I Am Me). Groff is an accomplished classical musician who has won accolades as a pianist and cellist. Romano Musumarra, who has worked with Celine Dion, Ray Charles and the London Symphony Orchestra, arranges the lush strings on Groff's impressive first album.

Elisa: Aiming for Europe

Elisa's accomplished debut album *Pipes & Flowers*, released in 1997, has achieved double platinum (more than 200,000 copies sold) in Italy on the back of a string of strong singles such as *Labyrinth*,



Sleeping In Your Hand, Shadowzone and Mr. Want. Her last single, Cure Me, a powerful song produced by Skunk Anansie's Darren Allison, proved that her initial releases were no fluke. With a second album scheduled for release this year, Elisa will continue to focus on European promotion in the meantime, following up on her support sets for Eros Ramazzotti during the European leg of his live tour in 1998. Discovered by Caterina Caselli Sugar, who also bought Andrea Bocelli to worldwide success, Elisa writes and performs her rock ballads in very natural English and is produced by Corrado Rustici, Zucchero's arranger. Elisa is an accomplished live performer and suitable radio and TV exposure should guarantee that she joins

Leda Battisti: Radio success

Leda Battisti shares the same name and home town (Poggio Bustone, near Rieti) as Italy's greatest contemporary singer/ songwriter, Lucio Battisti, who passed away last October. Whilst only a distant relative, Leda shares some of the musical genius of her namesake. Classical Mediterranean pop with Latin and oriental undertones, the lead single L'Acqua Al Deserto (Water In The Desert) off her eponymous debut album was an immediate radio hit.




SuperB: Manifestations of "It Pop"





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


BROOKE RUSSELL THAT FLY LADY Black Tools/Edel

International release date: March 22 Is this the first German R&B production which

could break out of its domestic market? All the signs say "go" for Brooke Russell, the bubbly San Francisco-born U.S. expatriate who, up till now, has earned her living as a backing vocalist for German MOR artists. On her solo debut, Russell's qualities as a passionate soul shouter and accomplished songwriter are set to the beat by a production team with a strong background in hip hop and house. On Fly Lady, Stuttgart's DJ Thomilla and

Cologne-based Whirlpool Productions create solid mid-to uptempo R&B which owes more to the preferred pace at European clubs than to U.S. slow jams. Arrangements are tight as a pair of lycra hot pants, and the rhythms swing like a good party after a case of Moët. Thomilla and Whirlpool have both straddled the divide between street cred and charts success before. Thomilla is



The first single from the album, So Sweet, is scheduled for release on February 22. So Sweet features guest vocals by Mr. Gentleman, the ragga toaster featured on last year's Top 15 hit Tabula Rasa by Freundeskreis & Mellowbag. The ragga overtones fit surprisingly well into this straightforward, upbeat R&B theme. More street are tracks such as Theme Song, featuring rapper

KC Da Rookee, and Turn It Up. Production on these two tracks is definitely on a par with New York's finest, and the rhythms flow like hot peanut butter. Not on the album but worth checking out is the Headrush remix of So Sweet, which almost halves the BPMs of the original, injects a super cool bass line and adds scratches by Plattenpapst Jöak. Finally, for a bit of authentic U.S. flava two-step, skip to The

Life I've Been Looking For. Overall, Fly Lady is an impressive debut album which shows how fast European producers are catching up with the big boys on the U.S. R&B scene.





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AIRPLAY—



Next time a record company or promotions exec says "radio doesn't take chances with new acts or new music," just mention Virgin Norway singer/songwriter Lene Marlin.

Her single, Unforgivable Sinner, (Music & Media Jan. 16) recently

entered the Norwegian sales chart in the top spot and is enjoying a growth in crossborder airplay, thanks mostly to early attention from Norwegian programmers at stations such as P3 and Kiss FM, and subsequent faith in the track from heads of music such as Morten Rindholt, across the Skagerrak at Denmark's P3, where the song is getting 23 spins a week.

According to Norway's daily newspapers "Verdens Gang" and "Dagbladet," which noted (and credited) Music & Media's coverage of Marlin, Virgin Norway boss Per Erik Johansen was pleasantly "caught out" by the attention radio-and notably the heavy rotation on Danish stations-is paying Marlin, particularly since the album release is months off. Johansen told the newspapers it was: "A situation we could only wish for."

A situation such as this can set the stage for a win-win scenario for the artist, the record label and the broadcaster. A new act is getting the exposure/airplay they arguably deserve. The label can take advantage of radio's enthusiasm. The radio stations can be viewed as "cool" by being instrumental in breaking a new act. Also, such a situation presents an opportunity for radio and the label to work in concert to promote and develop the artist in the (preferably) longer term, for a change.

The emerging airplay prominence of Unforgivable Sinner is happening while Marlin is still in the studio working on her debut album, set for release March 15 in Norway and April 12 in the rest of Europe. Rindholt's eye on music outside his own territory is encouraging, and seems to be a practice which programmers across Europe-even in xenophobic markets such as the U.K.-are conducting more regularly. For example, French house act Cassius is finding a comfortable home on U.K. stations such as BBC Radio 1.

In the mid '90s most Swedish acts couldn't get airplay outside Sweden if their lives depended on it. But looking at this week's M&M airplay Border Breakers chart, nine of the 25 entries are Swedish. Of course, it has to be acknowledged that there is music coming out of Sweden now which is more friendly to radio formats than a few years ago. But there has also been great music which was perfect for several radio formats, but was ignored by programmers because it was not domestically produced or Anglo-American material.

I'm not suggesting programmers playlist every foreign track which crosses their desks. However, there are opportunities to investigate what is happening in other markets, and every once in a while to apply it to one's own. There's a "big, big" world outside your backyard. Have a look.



M&M's weekly airplay analysis column

While Emilia secures her pole position, fresh breezes from the U.K. and Scandinavia waft many new entries into the European Radio Top 50 this week

As the Major Market section indicates, Emilia's Big Big World (Universal) is currently the most played record in Italy and the G/S/A countries, while her new single, Good Sign (Universal), has already risen to number 6 in the regional chart for Scandinavia.

Because of the completely different pictures in the regional listings for the U.K. and Scandinavia, we welcome no less than eight new entries this week.

The highest of those eight newcomers is in at 32: Baby One More Time by the 16-year-old Britney Spears (Jive). Programmers in the U.K. and Scandinavia are the first in Europe to pick up this big U.S. hit. Among them is Lars Trillingsgaard,



head of music at Danish regional CHR station ANR/Aalborg. He comments: "It's an instant winner: it has the beat. the energy and the melody. I agree with the record company, who are promoting it as sounding like the lovechild of The Backstreet Boys and Robyn." Comparing her with the similarly-aged Billie, Trillingsgaard con-

siders "Britney has a bigger crossover appeal, because her lyrics are not as juvenile as Billie's.

ANR is one of the commercial stations which will participate in a competition for Denmark's Grammy Awards. Listeners can vote for the "Danish radio hit '99." Trillingsgaard expects Den Gale Posse to win, "because Danish hip-hop is very popular at the moment.'

Other new entries include, at 37, Armand Van Helden's soulful dance track You Don't Know Me (ffrr), which is receiving early support in the U.K. and on dance stations across Europe. The latter are also the first to schedule Whitney Houston's new R&B-flavoured single, It's Not Right But It's OK (Arista), a new entry at 38. More R&B comes from the female trio Honeyz, whose End Of The Line (1st Avenue/Mercury) is garnering plays in the UK and Denmark.

Further down the list, at 44, French dance duo Cassius comes in with Cassius 1999 (Virgin). Their much-hyped single, currently the biggest climber in the Border Breakers chart, is at the moment more successful on radio in the U.K., Switzerland and Denmark than in France. One place lower, we find British TV star Emmie's dance take on Roxy Music's More Than This (Manifesto), which is already number two in the regional listing for the U.K., but is also spreading to Switzerland and Denmark. At 46, Garbage enters with the rocky When I Grow Up (Mushroom), due to support at U.K. radio. This is actually the first split-release in Europe for Garbage.

In Germany, for instance, the choice for their new single is the more laid back *The Trick Is To* Keep Breathing (Mushroom). And at 49 there's a first chart appearance for the most played record in the U.K., I Want You For Myself (Northwestside) from R&B boy-band Another Level, with a guest appearance from Wu-Tang Clan's Ghostface Killah.

Finally, bubbling under this week are Enjoy Yourself by A+ (Kedar/Universal), Bad Girls by Juliet Roberts (Delirious), Have You Ever? by Brandy (Atlantic), 1999 by Prince (Warner Bros.) and Tuesday Afternoon by Jennifer Brown (Arista). Menno Visser

LONDON — Two key slots in EMI Music's European structure have been filled on the same day, with the appointments on January 18 of Heinz Canibol and Marc Lumbroso.

Canibol, who departed in December from Universal Music Germany as it merged with PolyGram, becomes president of EMI Germany, Austria and Switzerland. Former Polydor U.K. MD Lumbroso joins as president of EMI France, Benelux



The new EMI France president confirms that he was in talks with another company-Sony Music, according to sources-to develop a label, but that project has been called off. However, it is understood that he will continue to pursue his TV and film production businesses alongside his EMI France duties.

Portugal and the Netherlands; Sony in France; Warner in Spain; and BMG in Germany.

The chart shares do not necessarily match a company's overall market share, as they exclude singles, catalogue sales and multipleartist compilations. However, the figures are a good indication of the strength of an affiliate's current repertoire, and allow for the identification of trends, evolution and changes in the marketplace.

Says Sony Music Europe chairman Paul Russell: "Chart shares are a significant management tool-we highly regard that information. In a way, chart shares are more significant than market shares, because you compare apples with apples. And if you do well in charts, it automatically shows in your numbers.'

To simplify the calculations, figures for Universal have not been included, since the company has changed over the years from being a licensed company to a standalone company in most territories, with distribution and shipping handled by BMG.

To appreciate the performance of each local company, the figures can be compared to each major's overall album chart share in Europe for 1998, published by M&M in our December 19 issue. Those figures were: Sony Music (23 percent); PolyGram (20 percent); EMI (including Virgin, 19.2 percent); Warner (16 percent); and BMG (11.4 percent).

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Giorgio Perris has left his position as managing director of BMG Ricordi's Milan-based Ricordi imprint after four years: The label will be headed by BMG Ricordi president Franco Reali until a new MD is appointed. A major artist signing is also likely to be announced by BMG Ricordi shortly, with Neapolitan singer/songwriter Pino Daniele tipped to join the company from Warner Music Italy's CGD-East West imprint.

Just as M&M was going to press, more new local Universal Music Group (UMG) structures were being announced, following news of the U.K., German and Dutch operations (see story, page 4). In France, UMG will be divided into three labels: Barclay, Mercury Island and Polydor. Barclay keeps its managing director Olivier Caillart and welcomes Motown, Def Jam, MCA, all of the former Universal France acts, plus the rap and R&B acts from the local Island France roster. Mercury Island (managed by Yann-Phillippe Blanc) loses the Remark label name but keeps its catalogue. Polydor (managed by Jean-Philippe Allard) loses the Motown imprint but gains Geffen and Interscope. UMG France has also created a position overseeing the company's Internet activities, which will be filled by former Barclay local marketing manager Sophie Bramly.

Meanwhile, UMG Norway has also announced a number of senior appointments. Eddie Nygren becomes finance director, Morten Jensen marketing director, Harald Tømte sales director, Kjell Petter Askersrud special marketing manager, and Tone Johnsen head of classical/jazz. The local A&R department will be run jointly by former PolyGram A&R director Erik Næss and UMG Norway MD Petter Singsaas. Merger casualty Jørn Johnsen (formerly PolyGram Norway MD) is setting up his own offices in Oslo. The precise nature of his company isn't yet clear.

In other UMG developments, **Costa Pilavachi** has been appointed president of classical label **Decca**. He will retain his current post as president of the **Philips Music Group**, dividing his time between Philips Music Group's office in Amsterdam and Decca's London base, reporting to UMG president of classics & jazz, **Chris Roberts**. The latter has been overseeing Decca following **Roger Lewis**' departure last September.

English-language Blue Danube Radio/ Vienna, threatened with possible closure by its public broadcaster owners ORF, has been handed a possible lifeline. Following pressure from the U.S. and French chambers of commerce in Vienna, ORF has agreed to set up a working party (expected to report in the autumn) to look into the best uses for Blue Danube's frequency, which also transmits ORF's alternative station FM4 in the evenings.

Following the company's highly successful flotation, edel Music chairman Michael Haentjes has appointed a head of business and legal affairs at the company's German label, edel Records. Hans-Martin Gutsch will also sit on edel Music's board.

In the U.K., Virgin Radio's owners the Ginger Media Group has teamed with syndication/production company Unique Broadcasting to create a new production company, G One. The new venture will take over Ginger's production contract with national station Talk Radio.

Finally, in Spain, presenter Federico Volpini is set to be the new director of national public station **RNE Radio 3**, following the sudden resignation of **Paco Pérez-Bryan** (M&M, January 23). Volpini has worked at the alternative music outlet for 20 years. Hotline also hears that, despite his resignation as the station's director, Pérez-Bryan will stay on at Radio 3 to manage the station's live music coverage.
